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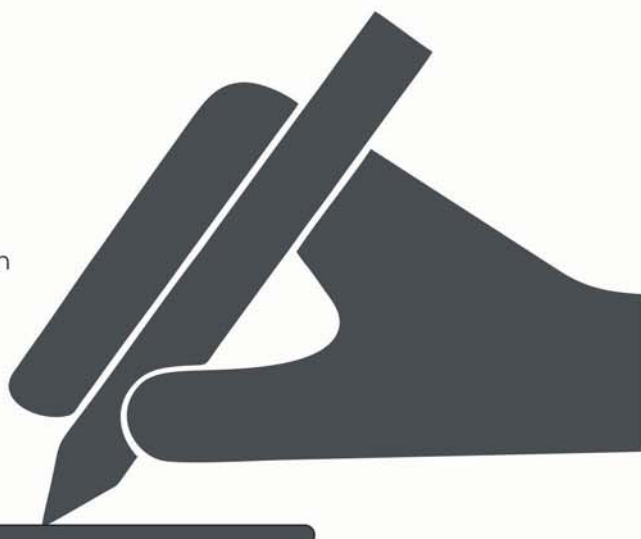

## Annual Report(2019-20)

The academic year 2019-2020 started with the teachers joining the school from 10th June. The Principal took a meeting with all the teaching staff ,welcoming them to the new academic year & instructed them to give more importance on academics, discipline of the school. She wished all of them the best for the new academic year. The class test for the new batch of students of Std- X commenced from 10th to 14th June.

Orientation programme for the pre-primary & primary section was held on 11th June to brief them about the school activities as well as the functioning of the school. As instructed by the Principal, Comprehensive yearly planning of syllabus was done by the teachers for the systematic completion of the

portion. An interactive session was conducted by Ayaksha for the teachers on "Stress & Anxiety Management" on 10th June. A special session was arranged for the teachers by Hindustan Times which was conducted by Heartfulness Organization to make the teachers aware about the impact of meditation on one's body, mind & soul. As per the Department of Education, online submission of log book of the teachers of primary teachers was done by the H. M. Name of the retiring teacher Mrs. Usha Sharma was sent to the department for the felicitation on Honour's Day on 26th June at Pragnya Bodhini High School. Open House for 1st Class test for std- X was conducted on 29th June. A meeting of the parents of all the 3 sections was conducted on 29th June followed by the election of PTA Members of each class. The new committee of the PTA Members was formed on 29th June, 2019.

All the 3 school activities of Martial Arts, Music & Dance began from 1st July. Session on Cyber crime was conducted for the students of Std- V to X on 1st July by the Ayaksha team & P Ward







respectively. Pre-primary section conducted the activity of Campus Visit on 4th July. New PTA Formation was done on 5th July. Child Safety Committee meeting and the 1st PTA meeting with the newly elected committee members was held in the presence of Trustee Mrs Neera Saraf and Director of schools –Shri Nitin Padte on 6th July. The Principal discussed the agenda and ensured complete safety for all the students and sought parents cooperation in the all round development of the students. Class-wise Speech competition was conducted for the secondary section students on 10th July. Raincoat day for pre-primary students was held on 11th July. Mathbee competition was held on 12th July for the students of primary section. Activity of Cooking experience for the pre-primary section was held on 17th July. Dramebaaz (Mono-acting) competition was held on 20th July for the primary section. Investiture Ceremony for the newly elected student council was held on 25th July. The event was graced by Donor Trustee –Mrs Neera Saraf and RSET member – Mrs. Nilima Pahwa. It was a great moment for the student leaders as they were badged and scarved. They took an oath and promised utmost dedication towards the school. Pre-primary section celebrated the Spectrum Day (Colours Day) on 31st July. Mock class test was conducted in std IX & X and the results were shared with the parents in the open house.

1st class test began from 1st August and got over on 9th August. On 2nd August fire evacuation drill was done as per the requirement of P/S ward education department. A session on Kellogg's was organized for the students of primary section on 6th August. A session on Good Manners was organized by the RMCC on 7th August, for the students of Std- III & IV. The school had its 1st School committee and Advisory board meeting on 10th August 2019. Try tri-colour in-house competition was held for the primary students on 13th August. Pre-primary section celebrated Independence Day & Rakhi making competition was held on 14th August. Independence Day Celebration was held at RSET on 15th August. Our school was the host and the students hosted the event with great confidence. The students from all the 3 sections presented their patriotism through a vibrant dance and song. A session for parents of Pre-primary & primary was conducted by RMCC on the topic "Happy Parenting" on 16th August. Best out of



waste competition was organized for the students of secondary section on 19th August. A workshop on "Safe & unsafe touch" was conducted by the Ayaksha team for the students of Std- I & II on 20th August at Nathmal Garodia Hall. Ace Fest inter-school competition was held at Pragnya Bodhini High School on 20th August. The students bagged many prizes in various categories. Pre-primary section celebrated Janmashtami on 22nd August. The Inspection of School records of Primary Section was done on 22nd August by the dept Inspector. She appreciated the functioning and wished well for the academic year ahead. Students of Primary section went for the educational trip to Rani Baug & pre-primary section went to Maharashtra National Park, Dharavi on 23rd August. The secondary section students were taken for an Educational movie to PVR on 27th August. On 31st, our two teachers Mrs. Kumud Naik from secondary section and Mrs. Manpreet Bakshi from Primary section were awarded the Nation Builder award by the Rotary club, West coast. National Sports Day was organized at KGES on 28th August, wherein the students showcased their talent in various sports activities conducted in the school. They were also explained the significance of the day. Ganapati festival was celebrated by the pre-primary section on 29th August. House-wise singing competition was held in the secondary section on 31st July and the winners names were announced.

School resumed back after the Ganapati holidays on 5th September. Students of std X, had an experience of a teachers role by going to the classes and a short programme was arranged by them for the teachers as a mark of Teachers day celebration. To appreciate the sincere efforts of the staff in the lives of students, a one day picnic to Nandanvan resort was arranged for the teachers. Our sincere thanks to the Management for such a special celebration. On 6th September, a session on 'Adolescence' for std IX & X was conducted by Ayaksha. It was a great session wherein the students were explained all the aspects of growing up. On 9th September, the students from std V to VIII participated in the 'Tare Zameen Par' painting contest organized by Rotary Elegant club, Mumbai. The theme was to promote consumer awareness, Indian Journalism, Ethics and values amongst children. The students came out with innovative & creative





captions. All the participants were awarded with participation certificates and the winners were awarded with a trophy and a certificate. The open house for the 1st Unit test was conducted on 13th September, wherein the teachers shared the progress of students with the parents. The Principal and HM, met and addressed the parents of students who had not fared well in the tests. The Principal and clerk attended the SSC online form filling conducted by the Dept. at Sayli International on 16th September. On 21st September, inhouse competition on 'Back to Ancient Period' was held for the students of std I to IV. Workshop on 'Academic Leadership' was attended by HM and Mrs. Manpreet Bakshi at Pradyabodhini High school. In the Interschool competition organized by P/S ward, Ms. Melvina, teacher, bagged the 1st Prize in the 3 D model making and Mrs. Shraddha Parab, Peon, got the 3rd prize in the stationary organizer making. A fancy dress competition was organized in the preprimary section on 17th September with the theme – 'Community helpers' for Nursery, 'Best out of waste' for Jr.kg and 'Retro' for the Sr.kg. On 20th September, the Principal attended the session organized by Gold Academy in association with Topper Learning ( Network 18), regarding the online content for the students. On 23rd the students from secondary section participated in the Poster making competition. The subject wise teachers from std X, attended the training conducted by the Edu dept. students of Secondary section. Art workshop was conducted by Pidilite for the students of Std. V to VIII. Diwali vacation began from 25th October to 10th November for the students & the teaching staff of KGES.

School re-opened after Diwali vacation on 11th November. National science Olympiad was conducted in the school for all the students. Children's Day was celebrated with great zeal & enthusiasm. April was the month of Annual Examination for all the students. It was also the culmination month of the academic year 2019-20. 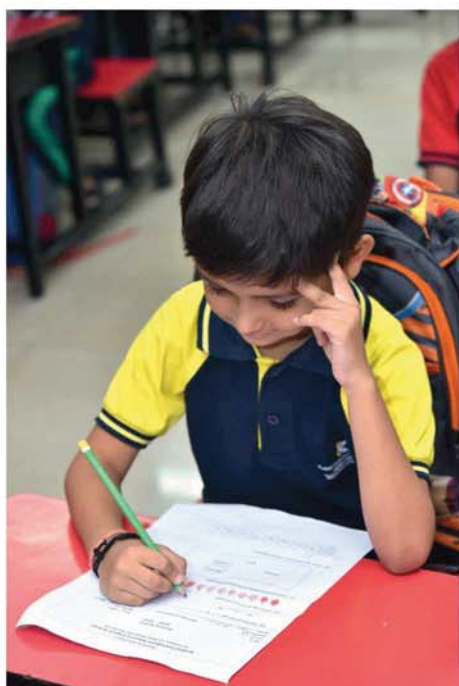

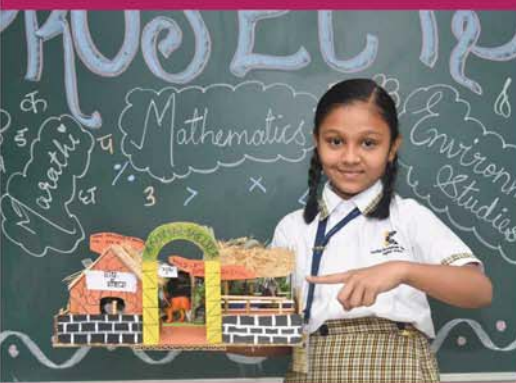

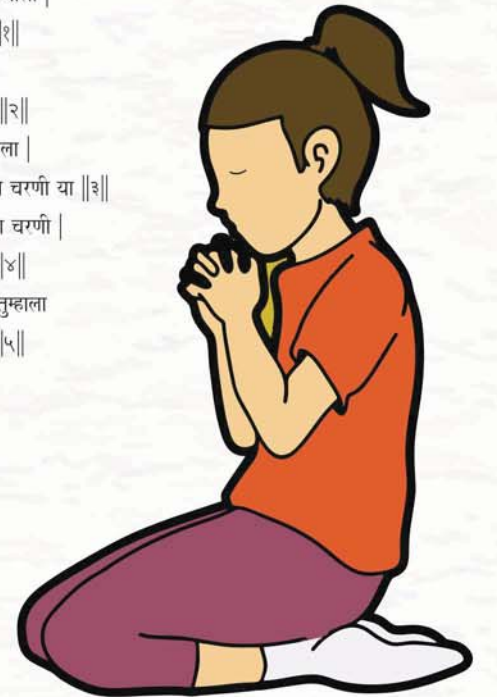

### Sun Block

"Staring is not always a good thing, especially when it comes to getting exposed to the hot ball of gases at the heart of our solar system"

#### What happens when you stare at the sun?

**Normal Visual process-** In a concept like how our vision processes, one can only see something when the object reflects off light. This light then passes through the cornea of our eyes & reaches the retina. Retina is that part of the eye that contains cells that are sensitive to light & pass on this information to the brain for it to perceive.

**Effect of Sun on your eyes-** The light from the sun is nearly 4,000 times that of a light bulb. A short exposure can cause hazy vision for some time due to numbing of the retinocytes. A prolonged exposure can lead to serious issues including burning of the retina, called retinopathy. This may cost you your normal vision.

**No pain receptors in the eye-** Since there are no pain receptors in the eye, one wouldn't realize the impact of the sun rays. UV rays & bright light equally damage your eye, like a suntan. This condition is then called as solar retinitis. A more permanent condition that causes loss of vision is called solar retinopathy. This happens in rare cases of prolonged gazing at the sun during a solar eclipse.

**Eclipse & sunrays-** one might think it is safe to stare at the sun during an eclipse, but you couldn't be more wrong. Although the sun is shadowed out during an eclipse, the more concentrated rays still do affect your vision with the same intensity. The sun is the brightest star of our solar system and it lives up to its reputation. If you are keen on star gazing, try those that are far away from us & keep twinkling away in the night.

- **Power** – The ability to perform with strength at a rapid pace. Strength and speed are both involved in power.
- **Reaction Time** – The amount of time it takes to start a movement once your senses signal the need to move. People with good reaction time can usually start quickly in track and swimming or react quickly in ping pong or karate.
- **Coordination** – It is the integration of eye, hand, and foot movements. This component is necessary for success in such sports as baseball, softball, tennis, golf, and basketball.
- **Speed** – It is the ability to cover a distance in a short amount of time. Speed is a very important factor in many sports and activities. Short runs are used to evaluate speed.
