1) **Economic Resurgence of India post Covid 19: Retrospective and Prospective Analysis**

- Dr. Sumana Chaudhuri on 30 June, 2020, conducted a ninety minutes long (2pm- 3.30 pm) FDP for the internal Faculty Colleagues on *Economic Resurgence of India: Post Covid 19- Retrospective and Prospective Analysis*. Twenty participants attended the FDP.

Dr. Chaudhuri discussed the profound impact of Covid 19 on different sectors of Indian economy. She also deliberated on the strategies to be adopted by the policy planners to bring back the economic recovery.
