Annual Report 2021-2022

Rotaract Club of Ghanshyamdas Saraf college has kept the theme of RI year 21-22, A new benchmark. We have set few trust areas to focus throughout the year to conduct projects majorly on community welfare. Projects on Swachh Bharat involved cleaning of beaches at two places - Vasai and Malad. Blood donation camps at Malad and Bhayandar, free full body health check up, Hunger Savior Project in collaboration with few international clubs, in this project, we fed poor people on World food day. Wide range of career opportunities given exclusively for the students of our college through our Recruitment Drive. We have opened two podcast streams on various platforms like Spotify and Google Podcast, focusing on Global Current Affairs, Poetry & Storytelling. Following all Covid protocols, conducted an outdoor camp trip to Karjat and witnessed Ganpati Gadad waterfalls after hiking located at Murbad District in Maharashtra & hiking as well enjoyed and cherished by everyone. Rotaractors took part in the Inter Club Youth Exchange conducted at Chennai. E- sports competition as well as on ground cricket, badminton tournaments were held.

We conducted all the projects in the best of our ability, but the BEST PROJECTS conducted by us were -

1. Jeevandan –

Members of Rotaract Club of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College conducted a blood donation drive in association with Rotaract District 3141. The project was done in collaboration with Rotaract Club of Bombay Film City, Rotaract Club of Bombay Northwest-Malad, Rotaract Club of Bombay Kandivali and Rotaract Club of Dahisar Coast. In the project 17 bottles of blood was collected which was given to a blood bank. The project was conducted to help



blood banks, which are in dire need for different components of bloods like plasma, WBCs, etc. but due to shortage of blood can't help the people in need.

2. Water Fall Hike –

During the Covid-19 pandemic, many of the students were bored in their homes and were not able to experience what it is like to be in nature. This project was conducted for members of the club so they could get out of the rut that the pandemic had created and explore nature and waterfall of Ganpati Gadad, Murbad District. The event started at 5 AM in the morning. The excited members hiked the hills and enjoyed the nature and explore the waterfalls after reaching the destination. They experienced for first time in 2 years of the pandemic what it is like to be in nature. The project was conducted jointly with Rotaract Club of Mumbai Sky City and in collaboration with Rotaract Club of Maharshi Dayanand College.

3. Book: A Precious Gift –

Even though education is the birth-right of every child, there are very few who get the gift of education. To facilitate education and help to give precious gift of education to few children, 9 members of the club conducted a book donation drive for the underprivileged children of Ankur Children's Home (Bhayandar), Rajendra Honeycomb Trust (Bhayandar), Daya Vihar Ashram (Malad). Notebooks and pens were donated to children of these institutions, to facilitate their education and help the children in any way members could. Members also played games with the children of the institutions and also conducted various fun activities with them.

4. Muskurayega India –

During the year 2021, it was difficult to celebrate Independence Day with the members of the club. So the Digital Communications team came up with a unique way to celebrate it with our members. It was decided that everyone would make a video of them lip-syncing to the song "muskurayega India". So the lyrics were divided among the directors and members and the videos were collected from everyone participating and was edited together and posted on social media accounts of the club.

5. Mera Bharat –

Like every year, we conducted our flagship project Mera Bharat, where we celebrate Independence Day with underprivileged children, who are not able to celebrate festivals by



themselves. Even though there was a pandemic going on, 4 members from the club went to Desire Society, an orphanage in Malad West to celebrate Independence Day with the children. The event was carried out by following proper covid guidelines in a socially distant manner, and everyone including the children were masked at all times. Flag hoisting was done along with the children in the morning after which fun activities and games were conducted for the children. Snacks were distributed after the activities were over.

6. Trash Free Beaches –

The project was conducted jointly with Rotaract Club of Universal College of Engineering. 7 members of the club conducted a beach cleanup drive at Rojodi beach in Vasai. The members were provided with gloves and different tools for garbage collection. Members of the club along with members of RC Universal College of Engineering cleaned the beach and around at 9:35 AM, the BMC garbage truck arrived to collect the garbage collected by the members. The garbage was loaded onto the truck with the help of BMC workers. The event was covered by local newspapers.

7. Beat the Stumps –

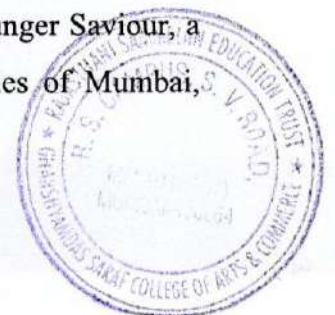
This project was conducted jointly with Rotaract Club of Northern Suburbs. 18 members from Rotaract club of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College and 14 members of Rotaract Club of Northern Suburbs participated in this project. This project was conducted to enjoy the game of cricket along with healthy competitiveness and sportsmanship. The members of the club competed in total of 5 games of cricket and showed their skills on the ground.

8. Izhaar –

This is a year-long project conducted in collaboration with multiple clubs in the Rotaract District 3141. Izhaar is a podcast that provides a platform to members who want to share their creative sides through poetries and story-telling. The audio of poems and stories are shared on multiple platforms like Google podcasts, Spotify, Anchor, etc. Till date more than 15 episodes have been posted on Izhaar.

9. Hunger Saviour –

On World Hunger Day, President of the Club wanted to do something big which was under her vision for a long time. She came up with the idea of Hunger Saviour. Hunger Saviour, a mega food donation drive in which spanned across 5 cities and 2 countries of Mumbai,



Chennai, Chandigarh, Visakhapatnam (India) and Nigeria. Food was donated by various members of multiple clubs in the mentioned cities. A total of 500 packages of food were donated collectively by all the clubs and Rotaract Club of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College donated 110 packages. The project was conducted in collaboration with Rotaract Club of Chennai Central (RID 3232), Rotaract Club of Ojodu Ambassador (Nigeria) (RID 9110), Rotaract Club of HSJ Dental College (RID 3080), Rotaract Club of Vizag City (RID 3020) and Rotaract Club of Mumbai Anchors (RID 3141).

10. Kahani Kirno Ki –

On the occasion of Diwali, a festival that celebrates the victory of lights over darkness, we conducted an events where we wanted members to share stories of their struggles and how were they able to overcome them. In this attempt we wanted to share stories that would inspire other members and also improve public speaking skills of the participants. A total of 14 members participated in the project and shared stories of their struggles. The best public speakers got their stories features on the Izhaar podcast.

11. Global Entrepreneurship Summit –

The project was conducted jointly with Rotaract Club of Athena and Rotaract Club of Hanging Garden. We wanted to inspire the members of the club in the fields of entrepreneurship on a global scale. So for the same we conducted Global Entrepreneurship Summit to bring together visionaries, pioneers and innovators together so that members can learn from the best entrepreneurs and interact with them. Speakers of the event included Uttara Kumar Verma, who is the Co-Creator - Moonpreneur, Aditya Singh, who is the Director – Athena School of Management | Global Advisory Board Member | Chatham House IFCCI | Rotarian and many others. There was a questions and answer session for members to ask questions regarding entrepreneurship.

12. Antarchakshu –

In our day to day life we take many things for granted. One such things being our sense of sight. Regarding the same a project was conducted in association with Xavier's Resource Centre for Visually Challenged (XRCVC), an organisation based in Mumbai that works with visually impaired people called Antarchakshu. Antarchakshu means the sense of sight within. In this project, Mr. Krishna Warriar, a professor and former journalist conducted various



activities with members where members were instructed to blindfold themselves and do a bunch of tasks that we do easily in our daily life, like pouring water in glass, drawing a picture, taking a coin out of wallet and telling which coin it is. Members carried out the activities and after the activities were over shared their experiences. A questions and answer session was conducted with Mr. Ganesh Phalke, a member of XRCVC, who is visually impaired where he answered questions like what role technology plays in his life, how he conducts day to day activities.

13. Aarogyam Health Camp –

13 volunteers of the club conducted a health camp which provided quality health check-up totally free of cost to the masses and the community. The camp included general checkups and also checkups for physiotherapy and dental checkups. The Aarogyam Health Camp was conducted in association with Jain Alert Group of Nala Sopara. A total of 110 people took the benefit of the health camp and 60 people were able to do specialized check-ups.

14. Outdoorooze –

Outdoorooze was a 2-day adventure camp organised for the members of the club at Camp Comfygram, Mohili, Karjat. The camp was conducted for members so that they could get out of the rut of daily life and enjoy their time in nature and doing adventure sports. After reaching the venue, the members got to live in tents. They were able to do various adventure activities like boating, treasure hunt, etc. On the night of the first day, a bonfire with live music was organised where members could relax and enjoy. On the second day rainfall trek started was started in the morning which lasted for 1.5 hours. After returning from the campsite, a video was shared about the event on social media handles of the club. Members thoroughly enjoyed the adventure and a lot of memories were made.

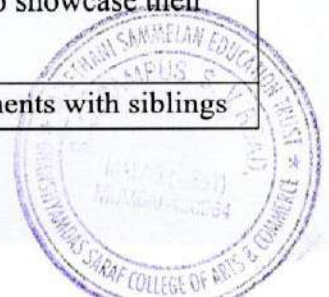
