VIJAY DIWAS

Vijay Diwas is commemorated every 16th December in Bangladesh and India to observe India and Bangladesh's victory over Pakistan in War of 1971 for the liberation of Bangladesh from Pakistan. The end of the war also resulted in the unilateral and unconstitutional surrender of the Pakistan Army and subsequent secession of East Pakistan into Bangladesh. On this day in 1971, the chief of the Pakistani forces, General Amir Abdullah Khan Niazi, along with 93,000 troops, surrendered to the allied forces consists of Mukti Bahini and Indian Army, led by General Jagjit Singh Aurora, of India in the Ramna Race Course, now Suhrawardy Udyan, in Dhaka after their defeat in the war. The then Prime Minister of India, Indira Gandhi, extended her full support to the liberation struggle of (East Pakistan) Bangladesh that helped it to become a free nation.

While it was a big day for Bangladesh, as it meant the secession of East Pakistan into the country, this win was also a proud moment for the Indian Army. After a 14 day war, Pakistani troops in East Pakistan under Lt. Gen AAK Niyazi, Cdr Pakistan Army Eastern Command Surrendered to the Indian Army. A new nation was born and India's commitment to Bangladesh was fulfilled.

On 16th December every year, Citizens, Senior official Students and war veterans lay wreaths and remember the sacrifice of the soldiers. In Bangladesh, this day is observed on 16th December. Every year on this day people of Bangladesh shower their respect to freedom fighters, Martyrs and Brangonas.

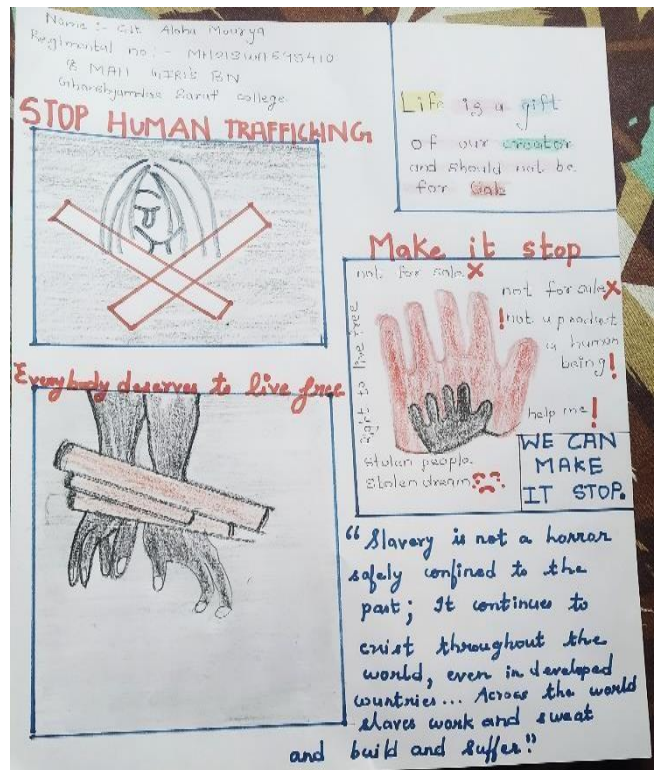

12 जनवरी को राष्ट्रीय युवा दिवस है। राष्ट्रीय युवा दिवस भारत के उन युवाओं व नौजवानों को समर्पित एक खास दिन है, जो देश के भविष्य को बेहतर और स्वस्थ बनाने का दायरता रखते हैं। भारतीय युवा दिवस को 12 जनवरी को मनाने की एक खास कहानी है। इस दिन स्वामी विवेकानंद का जन्म हुआ था।

इसे मनाने का मुख्य समय भारत के युवाओं के बीच स्वामी विवेकानंद के आदर्शों और विचारों के मद्दत को फैलाना है। भारत को विकसित देश बनाने के लिये उनके बड़े प्रयासों के साथ ही युवाओं के अन्दर उन्नी को जागृत करने के लिये यह बहुत अच्छा तरीका है।

भारत की युवा शक्ति "आँसों में वैभव के सपने, मन में तूफानी ली गति हो" ऐसे ही हृदय में उठते हुए ज्वार, परिवर्तन की लसक, अदृश्य साहस, स्पष्ट संकल्प लेने की चाहत का नाम है युवावस्था। दुनिया का कोई भी आन्दोलन, दुनिया की कोई भी विचारधारा युवाशक्ति के बिना सफल नहीं बन सकती। भारत में यह युवा शक्ति ही है जिसके दम पर किसी विरोध या विपक्ष की जीव राखी जाती है। विश्व में भारत सबसे ज्यादा युवा जनता वाला देश है। सन 2020 तक भारत की औसत आयु 29 वर्ष होगी। जबकि चीन की 39, अमेरिका की 39 और यूरोप और जपान की औसत आयु 42 वर्ष होगी। जनसंख्या के आंकड़ों के अनुसार भारत में 14 करोड़ 13 ली 39 वर्ष की आयु के युवा हैं। इन आंकड़ों से स्पष्ट है कि भारत में कमजोरी की स्थिति नहीं है। सच्चा सबूत उर्ध्व है। विश्व भर के साथ-साथी विश्व के लिए महामाजी व्यक्तियों की विरासत जनसंख्या की आयुवक्रता होगी। अतः भारत को एक युवा राष्ट्र बना जा सकता है।

यह यह है कि कोई राष्ट्र अपनी युवा शक्ति का विकास कैसे करता है, क्या वह विकास युवा जनसंख्या को राष्ट्र पर संपन्न बनाने से राष्ट्र को कमजोरी के रूप में विकसित करता है अथवा सशक्त, समृद्ध, शक्तिशाली और आत्मनिर्भर भारत के निर्माण में उसका समुचित उपयोग करने के साधन उपलब्ध करता है।

BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR JAYANTI

Every year 14th April is celebrated as Babasaheb Ambedkar Jayanti or Bhim Jayanti to recognise the contribution of Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar in our constitution and Indian Legal system. He is regarded as the founder of the biggest constitution in the world which is The Indian Constitution. In the Canadian province of British this day is known as 'Ambedkar equality day'. This day is not only celebrated in India but all over the world.

Babasaheb Ambedkar was a philosopher, a jurist, politician and historian. He fought to bring justice to the underprivileged, women's, laborers and untouchables. He was strictly against the caste system. His vision of India was of a country without inequality and rights for everyone. He was an advocate for India's independence from the British rule. Public holiday is declared on this day, people celebrate this day by paying homage to his statue. Ambedkar Jayanti processions are carried out in Mumbai and Deeksha Bhoomi in Nagpur. The President, Prime minister and other major leaders pay homage to Ambedkar Jayanti at the Parliament of India in New Delhi.

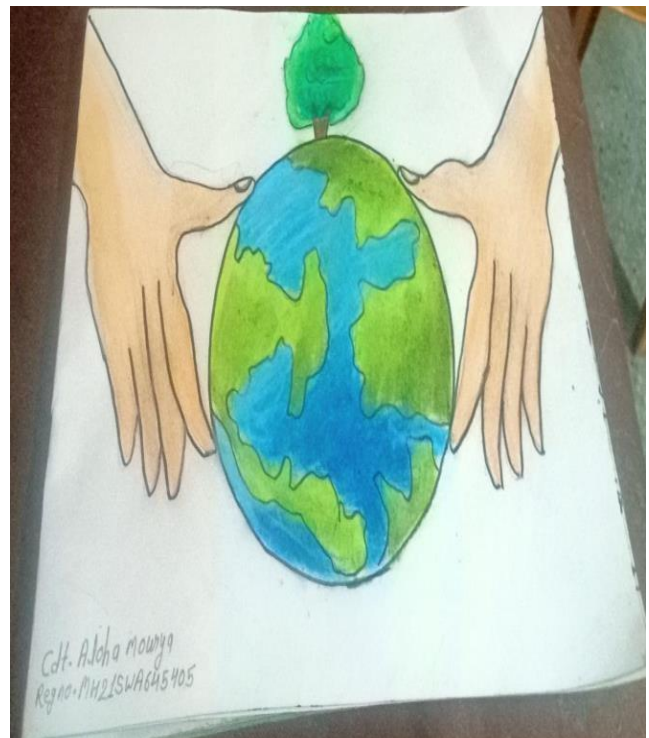
