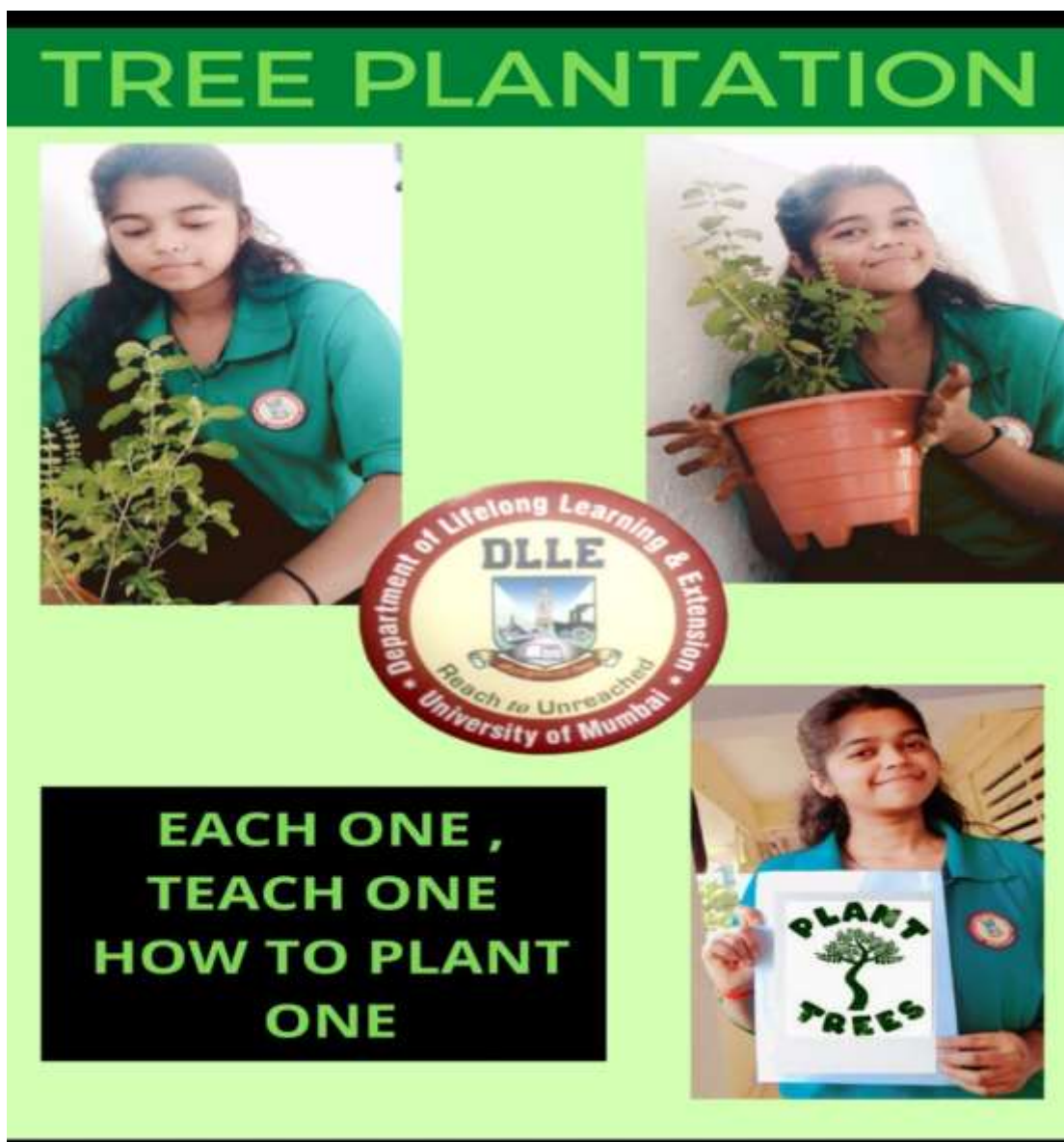
## Old Age Home
