# Report On Multi-Disciplinary One-Day National Conference On 

Survival, Resurgence and Sustainability in Digitalisation: A Global Perspective

## Introduction

Digitalisation is booming in recent times. Digital technologies have the potential to boost more inclusive and sustainable growth by spurring innovation, generating efficiencies and improving services. They are also an important tool in helping countries to confront and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic that has disrupted economies and societies globally. The mass adoption of connected digital services by consumers' enterprises, and governments has emerged in recent years as a key economic driver that accelerates growth and facilitates job creation. In view of these changes the conference aimed to seek out Survival strategies, Resurgence of sectors if any and means of Sustainable development.

## The Program

Ghanshyamdas Saraf College held a One Day Multidisciplinary National Conference on "Survival, Resurgence and Sustainibility in Digitalisation: A Global Perspective" on Wednesday, 15th February 2023 in Durgadevi Saraf Auditorium. The Objective of the Conference was:

* To provide a platform to academicians, researchers, experts from Industry, policy makers and students for constructive deliberation and discussion with the purpose of creating substantial positive change in the outlook and to understand the various perspectives on digitalisation
4 To find out the strengths, weaknesses, opportunitics and challenges in the new normal in all sectors
* Quality Assurance and progress in future endeavours of all, by right use of technology for right purpose.


## Participation

The Chief Guest for the conference was Dr. Rajanish K. Kamat, Vice Chaneellor, Dr. Homi Bhabha State University. The Guest of Honours were Dr. Anthony Patrick, Professor at Osmania University \& Mr. Ajay Bhagwat, Director Inpods, India. The Chairperson of the Conference was the Principal Dr. Ashwat Desai, Conference Convenor- Vice - Principal (SFD) Dr. Lipi Mukherjee, Conference Secretary- Dr. Rupa Shah while it was anchored by Prof. Prajna Shetty,

The conference witnessed a participation of nearly 270 delegates including academicians from various Institutions and GSCC students The Conference created a lot of excitement in the research

fraternity which was reflected in the form of 81 full-length research papers received from all over India. During the One day conference there were 2 sessions and 26 papers were presented.

## Inaugural Ceremony

The programme commenced on an auspicious note by paying respect to Goddess Saraswati with the dignitaries lighting the lamp \& Ms. Kajal Sharma reciting the Saraswati Vandana. Dr. Ashwat Desai, Conference Chairman, welcomed the dignitaries on dais and greeted one and all to the One-Day National Conference. He enlightened the august gathering about the college, the need of the hour to adapt to digitisation amongst other things. He then officially declared the conference open.

The Chief Guest Dr. Rajanish K. Kamat, was felicitated by the Education Director Dr. Jayant Apte and the Guest of Honours Dr. Anthony Patrick and Mr, Ajay Bhagwat were felicitated by the Principal Dr. Ashwat Desai with a floral Bouquet, Gift \& Memento.

Further, the Conference Convener Dr. Lipi Mukherjee welcomed the delegates for the conference and gave a brief overview about the concept of digitalisation and enlightened the gathering about its significance in today's world especially post demonetisation and post pandemic. She then invited the Chief Guest Dr. Rajanish Kamat to deliver his keynote address.

## Keynote Address-

Soon after the Inaugural session, we began with the Key note address on "Survival, Resurgence and Sustainability in Digitalisation: A Global Perspective." The Keynote Speaker for this session Dr. Rajanish Kamat gave a brief overview about the concept of digitalisation and mentioned the advantages, scope, current global trends and current digitalisation perspectives. The keynote address provided valuable insights on the theme of the conference highlighting the future of the digital world and the ample opportunities that it provides. His presentation rightly reflected how digitalisation and sustainability go in tandem if used judiciously. He emphasized that one should also be communicating on one-to one basis rather than only virtually which will help in striking a right batance in people's lives.

## Releasing the Journal

After the Key note address was the proud moment of releasing the Journal. The dignitaries on the dais did the honours. Two volumes of the journals were released in a peer review refereed journal bearing ISSN-2277-8721 with an impact factor of 8.095 . One volume was published with ISBN -978-93-91999-12-8 book, 4 papers were published in UGC care listed journaI.

## Technical Session 1\&2

The Guest of Honour Dr. Anthony Patrick was the Resource Person for the first technical session on "Sustainability and Digitalization of Business: A Way Forward." His seamless presentation and views on how sustainability \& digitization in business is a key to progress was very well explained with apt examples. He emphasized on how reputed companies and role models are endorsing brands by using and promoting sustainable products. His presentation touched upon important aspects of digital transformation and how digitalization and sustainability support one another thereby ensuring the survival and success in any industry.

In between the technical sessions, Prof. Mamta Chhajer read out encouraging and inspiring messages sent by the Advisory Committee wherein they shared their views, thoughts and best wishes for the Conference. This was followed by the second technical session.


The Second Guest of Honour Mr. Ajay Bhagwat was the Resource Person for the second technical session on "How future challenges of New gen students could be effectively addressed by Education Technology." His presentation touched upon the challenges being faced by the teaching fraternity owing to changing trends and technological advancements in the education field. He rightly said that teachers need to follow the 3 R's - be resilient, build professional relationships with students and reflect on their teachings, all of which will help them adapt to digital technology. He emphasized that there needs to be a shift from traditional teaching methodology to experiential learning. He highlighted on how personalization and global sourcing can be key aspects of innovation in teaching. He stated that by using technology, we can offer personalized experience to students and by using tools like chatgpt, teachers can source data from experts all over the globe.

Dr. Rupa Shah, Conference Secretary extended the vote of thanks to the Key note speaker and Resource persons for conducting the morning sessions so effectively. She also expressed her gratitude to one and all for gracing the occasion.

## Presentations

The Judges then gave their observations. The reviews were positive and reassuring. They gave certain suggestions to the paper presenters on how they could excel in presenting the papers more effectively. The Prize winners were then felicitated with the Best Paper Presentation Certificate.

At the close of the valedictory function, Dr. Lipi Mukherjee, the Conference Convener proposed the vote of thanks.

The programme ended with the playing of the National Anthem.
