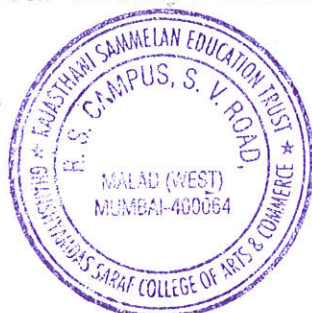

Ghanshyamdas Saraf College's Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized a One Day Inter-Disciplinary National Conference on 'ICT and AI in Business, Accounting and Finance: The Game Changers for Economic Growth' on 15th February 2020 in association with Financial Planning Academy at Durgadevi Saraf Hall, from 10:00 am.

The Conference started with Principal, CA Dr. Jayant Apte's welcome address, emphasizing on quality education provided by RSET, followed by a short introduction of the IQAC of College and its role in maintaining quality in education and management given by IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Ashwat Desai. This was followed by welcoming the Chief Guest, Mr. Manoj Sathe, Vice President, NSDL by Shri. Kailash Parasrampur, Trustee, RSET. Dr. Apte felicitated the resource persons, Mr. Nidhish Singh, Mr. Tanuj Peddar, and Mr. Vishal Gada. The event was compered by Prof. Mamta Chajjer.

This was followed by the Keynote Address given by Mr. Manoj Sathe, Vice-president, NSDL on 'Future of Indian Financial Market and NSDL's Digital Role in It'. Mr. Sathe started by showing a comparative study of GDP of India and the world. He then emphasized on the growth of banking sector highlighting it as the pillar of our country's economy. Mr. Sathe also threw light on various



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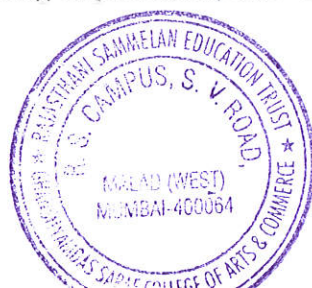
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government initiatives like 'Jan Dhan' to boost the banking sector. He then focused on the steps adopted by the government and NSDL's role in digitalizing India. He started by explaining various digital payment methods like banking cards, internet banking, etc with added emphasis on capacity building and awareness- online educational courses for people to learn to use these services. Mr. Sathe also presented the challenges to Digital India faced currently, like lack of financial literacy, lack of knowledge in digital literacy, cyber security, lack of proper infrastructure, and a diverse population. He also discussed case studies and the government's role in making technology accessible to the rural population of India. Mr. Sathe concluded his address by highlighting NSDL as the backbone of Indian Economy and its role in supporting and making government schemes accessible to the people of India.

The address was followed by the technical sessions, for which the first speaker was Mr. Nidhish Singh, Vice-President, J.P. Morgan on 'Strategies to Address Challenges in the Adoption and Implementation of Artificial Intelligence in Business'. He began by addressing the various challenges of artificial Intelligence- lack of skilled human resource with expertise and experience in using technology, and the resistance to use artificial intelligence in day today activities. He then highlighted the importance of technology to be backed up by ethics, and to be run according to market requirements. He highlighted effective implementation of artificial intelligence by having good human-machine collaboration by merging ethics, human science with artificial intelligence.

It was succeeded by another technical session on 'Changing dynamics of Career Opportunities Due to Technological Advancements in Banking Sector' by Mr. Tanuj Poddar, CEO, Banking Programs, Financial Planning Academy. He began by orienting about the banking structure in India emphasizing on the shift in the industry from employee-centered to customer-centered. He highlighted the role of ICT and artificial intelligence that help in enriching the customer's banking experience, like e-lobby, net banking, mobile banking, and



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ATMs. Mr. Poddar also discussed case studies where artificial intelligence together with technology (robots) in the banks has proved very useful in extending good customer service. Mr. Poddar presented a brief study of the change in banking trends, and the lending-borrowing system of banks. He also presented the various career opportunities in banking sector, and the required qualifications and skills for the same. He concluded his session by proposing open-mindedness as the most important employability skill.

Subsequently, Mr. Vishal Gada, Executive Director, Sykes and Ray, Edupro Pvt. Ltd. gave a brief talk on the importance of industry-academy collaboration. He emphasized on FPA's role in bridging the gap between the two.

The vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Lipi Mukherjee, Vice-Principal, Self-Finance Department in which she thanked the keynote speaker and all the resource persons for their valuable insights on the role of Information and Communication Technology and artificial intelligence in the emerging scenario.

The conference assembly then proceeded for a post-lunch session of paper presentations in the field of commerce and accountancy on various topics. The papers in accountancy were presented on the role of artificial intelligence in financial services, the limitations of using the same in banking sectors. The paper presentation round was judged by CA Dr. S.P. Das. The papers in commerce were presented on the role of ICT and AI in Education, construction industry, and creative industry and new media. The paper presentation round was judged by Dr. Kailash Anekar, Advocate Deshpande Night College of Commerce, Mumbai.

This was followed by the valedictory function, compered by Prof. Prajna Shetty. It started with the felicitation of the judges of paper presentation by Dr. Jayant Apte. The judges appreciated the paper presenters and gave them valuable feedback. The best paper presenter prize in accountancy was awarded to Dr.



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Shraddha Bhome, Dyansadhana College, and the best paper presenter in commerce was awarded to Mr. Jainin Shah, ex-student, Ghanshyamdas Saraf College of Commerce. The vote of thanks was proposed by IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Ashwat Desai in which he expressed gratitude to all the delegates, paper presenters, management members, staff members, and student volunteers for their assistance in organizing the conference.

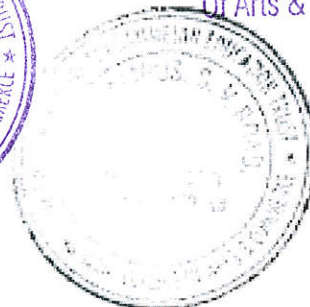
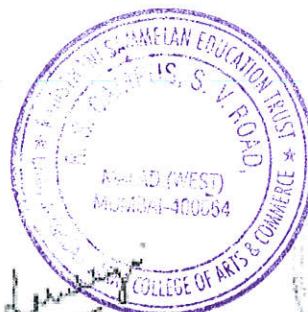

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A STATE LEVEL SEMINAR ORGANISED BY WOMEN DEVELOPMENT CELL

The Women's Development Cell of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College had organized a State Level Seminar in association with Maharashtra State Commission for Women, and University of Mumbai Women's Development Cell, on 'Challenges to Women's Development, Empowerment and Liberation in Contemporary India' at Bajaj Hall, Malad (West), from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm on Wednesday, July 31, 2019.

The seminar started with the lamp lighting ceremony and invocation, followed by felicitation of the guests. It was shortly followed by a welcome address by Principal, Dr. (CA) Jayant Apte, who expressed the need for forums for women in the current times as the first step towards women empowerment. The tone of the seminar was set by the Convener of Women's Development Cell of the College, Dr. Shagun Srivastava who highlighted the objectives of the Cell, and the various activities conducted to spread awareness about issues related to gender.

Prof. Charmie Dajal, Member, Women's Development Cell of the College provided the audience with a brief introduction of the guests, highlighting their respective areas of expertise. Dr. Gita Chadha, Chairperson of the University of Mumbai Women's Development Cell, presided as the Chief Guest and the Keynote Speaker. Dr. Chadha who is an academician, researcher, and a writer herself, addressed the audience on 'Gender and Patriarchy', focusing on gender stereotypes created and reinforced by the society and media. The talk started with an overview of gender discrimination, the way it is perpetrated in both domestic, as well as public spheres. She elucidated the manner in which psychological constructs of masculinity and femininity pose a hindrance to women empowerment, and one's need to break free from these. She also highlighted the need to deconstruct gender-restrictive roles.



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subvert domestic work as economically unproductive. Through her address Dr. Chadha also brought to the notice the acceptance of violence as their rights, and urged to deconstruct the same. Dr. Chadha called for the role of educational institutions, women's forums, politics, and media to participate in this regard. The address concluded with a message of the need for women to stand up against their exploitation, solidarity between women regardless of their socio-cultural and economic stature, and an active participation of men in feminist movements against the various forms of violence and exploitation.

Smt. Vyava Rahalkar, Chairperson of Maharashtra State Commission for Women expressed her concern over the rising need to tackle various issues related to women, the role of the Commission, and the many challenges that lie before the government, in a brief audio-visual message.

It was followed by a panel discussion on 'Violence Against Women: Problems and Solutions' by the members that included Dr. Gita Chadha, Chairperson, University Women Development Cell, Mrs. Mangala Marathe, Secretary, Swadhar, (NGO at Goregaon West, Mumbai), Mrs. Pooja Kute Lawyer and Activist, and Mrs. Aruna Jogalekar, Artist, Director, Writer, and Producer, which was moderated by Dr. Lipi Mukherjee, Chief-Coordinator, Self-finance Department of the College. The discussion opened with identifying different forms of violence, and the way it can be traced to the legitimization of violent behaviours that are encoded since childhood.

Dr. Chadha expressed her views on the ways in which systems of power like patriarchy initiate violence against women. She highlighted on the women becoming doubly susceptible to violence due to this, both in the domestic as well as the public domain. Mrs. Kute added the role of judiciary in tackling the concern of violence against women. She elaborated on the significance of having a supportive legal system, and the awareness of the same by the women to assert their rights. She also discussed in detail the 'Manodhanva Scheme', that provides psychological and economic relief to the survivors of sexual assault and acid attack. Mrs. Kute emphasized the role of law and



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order, and society together in making these legal schemes accessible to women. Mrs. Marathe highlighted the role of NGOs as a support system to the survivors of violence, and their families by aiding in legal and medical correspondence. She emphasized the contribution of family, educational institutions, workplaces, and women's forums, as fundamental in curbing violence against women. Mrs. Jogalekar highlighted the role of media-newspaper, social media, and art that reinforce both subtle and overt forms of violence against women. She emphasized on the portrayal of women in media, and the way it operates as a result of culture to create a collective, stereotypical identity.

The discussion was also received enthusiastically by the audience which concluded with questions answered on honour killings, cyber-crime, workplace harassment, role of self-defense workshops, helplines, and counsellors while tackling the same, and an agreement of the need for a free interaction, and sensitization of the society regarding gender-based violence. The discussion was concluded by emphasizing the significance of Internal Committees to be approachable to the women, and to be updated with the knowledge of various laws and legal schemes.

The second part of the seminar comprised of paper presentations by academicians, professionals, and research scholars on the related themes. Prof. Suresh Santani, G. J. Advani Law College, highlighted on the disparity in male-female ratio of the Indian Judiciary, with a focus on gender prejudice in 'Women in the Indian Judiciary: Need of the Time'. Prof. Gopal Mantri, SVKM, Mithibai College spoke on 'Property Rights of Women', the inheritance laws that allow women authority over their property. Prof. Megha Yadav, MPVC College highlighted on the various social challenges that hinder their work, in her paper, 'Travelling Challenges of Women'. Dr. Meghna Basu, Ms. Pizaa Khan, Ms. Vishwa, Ms. Priya, and Ms. Sara Ansari, R. D. National College presented their study of the data collected on 'Work Stress' and 'Impact of Work Life Balance'. Ms. Monisha Bohra, Lions College presented a paper on 'Women in Employment' with focus on workplace harassment.



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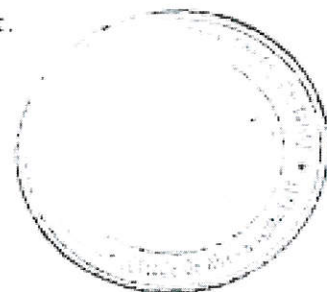
Prof. Rohini Fadte, K.J. Somaiya College highlighting the objectification of women by studying their graphic representation on tourist brochures, in 'Gender, Media, and Tourist Gaze'. Prof. Pankaj Kataria emphasized on the role of Corporate Social Responsibilities in women empowerment, with a focus on the financial independence of rural women. Ms. Varshika Mithani and Ms. Priya Ghiya, Jai Hind College presented a paper on 'Female Foeticide and Gender Based Violence' highlighting misogyny and a sense of power as a primary cause of violence against women. Prof. Samhita Sengupta, KES Shroff College, spoke on the correlation between gender awareness and environmental movements in 'Women in Environmental Protection: The New Era of Women Empowerment'. Prof. Ashwini and Prof. Chitra, Vidyalankar Institute presented a paper on 'A Study of Organizing Women for Change'. Ms. Dhvani Patel, Mr. Shahid Khan, and Ms. Fiza Qureshi, Vivek College emphasized the role of women activists in the fields of education, social service, and women empowerment through their paper, 'Trials and Trivia of Women's Life'. The paper presentation session was concluded by a discussion on the various themes of the papers by Mrs. Mangala Marathe and Prof. Shripad Joshi, who chaired the session.

The Valedictory was conducted by Prof. Mamta Chhajer, who thanked all the paper presenters for their enthusiastic participation in the Seminar.

The Vote of Thanks was proposed by Vice Principal Prof. Gopal Sonar who extended his appreciation to the participants and the paper presenters, and encouraged them for continued hard work. Prof. Sonar also expressed his gratitude to the Management, Academic, Administrative, and Technical Staff, and Student Volunteers for their support. The Seminar concluded with the distribution of certificates and Seminar proceedings to the paper presenters by Mrs. Mangala Marathe and Prof. Sonar. Dr. Shagan Srivastava, Convener of the Women Development Cell of the College, also expressed her immense gratitude to the Committee for their support and hard work.



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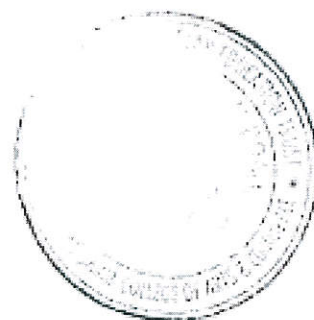

This Two-Day Journey of Advanced Excel was a great success attracting 1136 participants spread across 19 states, 5 Union Territories and representing more than 500 institutes.

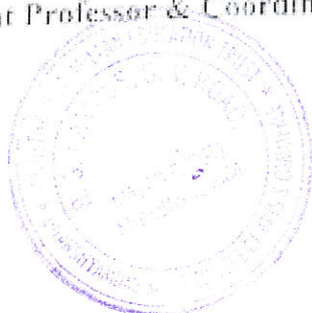

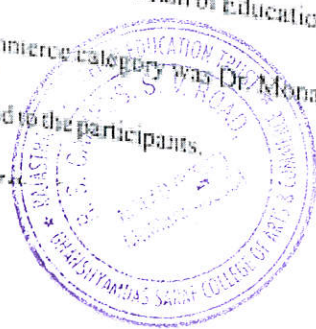
Participants of the conference were invited to give their feedback. The judges were requested to share their views.

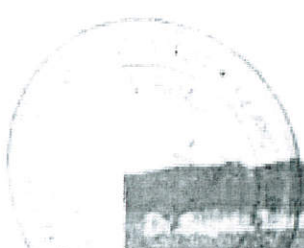
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INTERDISCIPLINARY NATIONAL CONFERENCE

REPORT ON TALK

Title: "UGC Regulations -2015 (Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students)"

Chief Guest - Dr. Anjali Kanitkar

Date - 27th February, 2017

No. of Participants - 320

Dr. Anjali Kanitkar was invited as the guest speaker, at the event organized by Women Development Cell of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College of Arts & Commerce, sponsored by Maharashtra State Commission for Women.

Dr. Kanitkar is a Post-Graduate from Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai. She is a retired Associate Professor from College of Social Work, Nirnala Niketan in 2016, and at present holds the position of Director of Social Audit, Government of Maharashtra.

She informed the participants about the definition, constitutes and provisions under law of SH and the process of redressal. She discussed the case of Bhanwari devi and Vishakha guidelines (1997). She also made students aware of Nirbhaya Act (2013), the Sexual Harassment Act (2013) and the UGC Regulations for Sexual Harassment (2015).

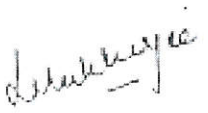
She made students understand that SH is not only any unwelcomed physical assault but also verbal and non-verbal conduct of sexual nature. She said that even creating a hostile environment through an unwanted conduct with sexual undertones such as making sexually coloured remarks, physical contacts and advances and showing pornography also account for SH.

She discussed the importance of ICC at the level of institute and asked students to approach the same in case of any complaints regarding SH. She said that ICC is supposed to be a neutral body, constituted for the addressable of complaints and also it assists the victim in writing complaints, ensures safety of complainant and prevents victimization.

She said that higher educational institutions shall conduct such programmes frequently and should also conduct workshop for all the students on SH. Institutes shall focus on creating a campus which is free from discrimination, harassment, retaliation and sexual assaults at all levels.

Institutes shall treat SH as misconduct and initiate action against the perpetrator.

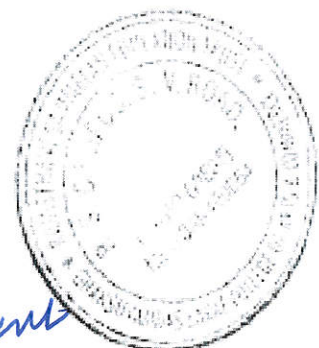
Her guidance on SH helped students understand it better and also helped them recognize the proper channel in order to report any such misconduct on the campus.
