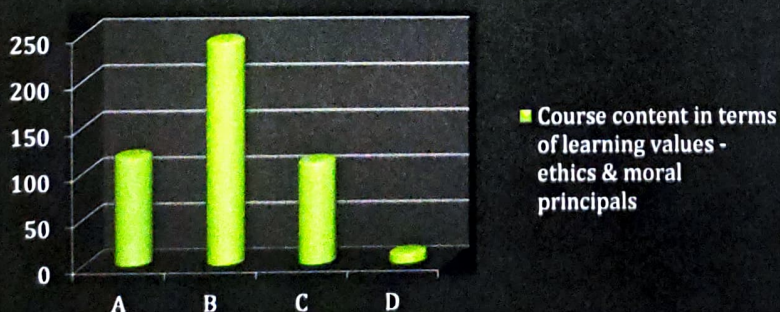

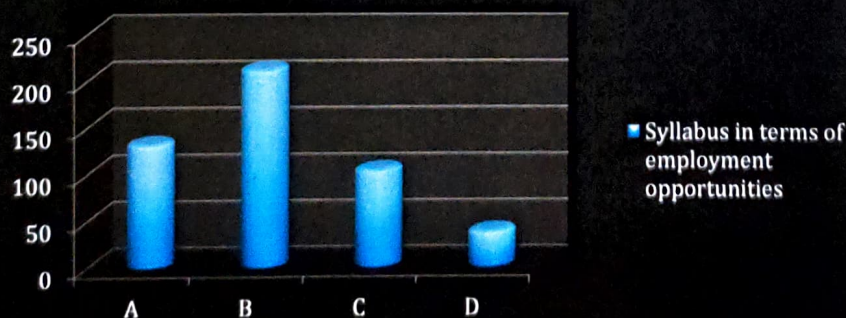

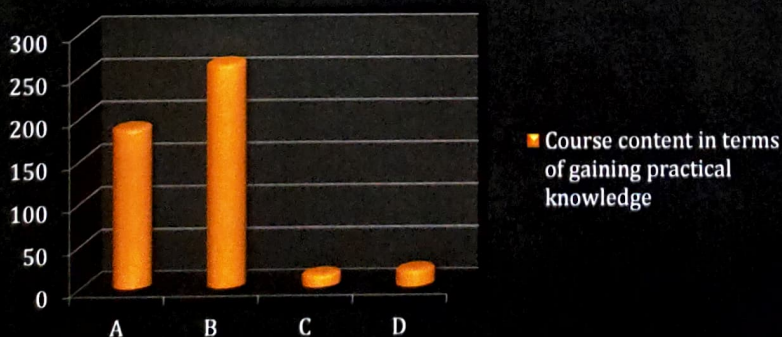

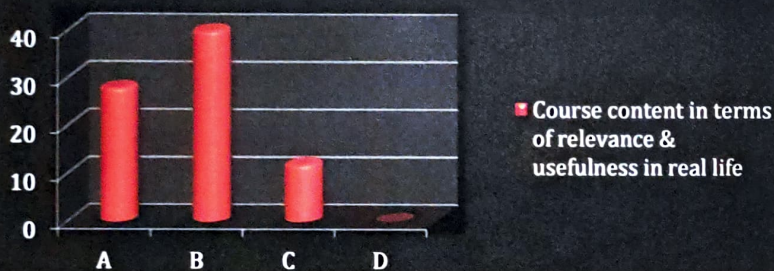

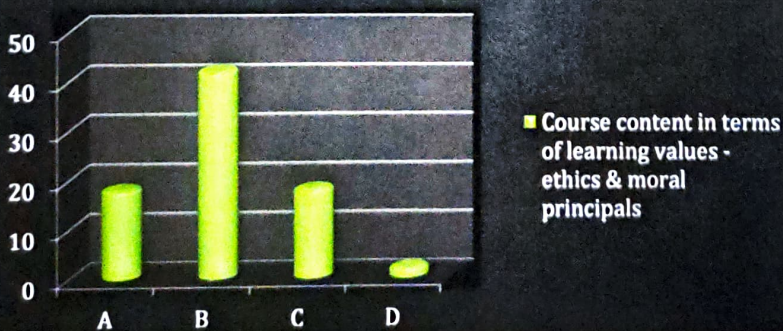

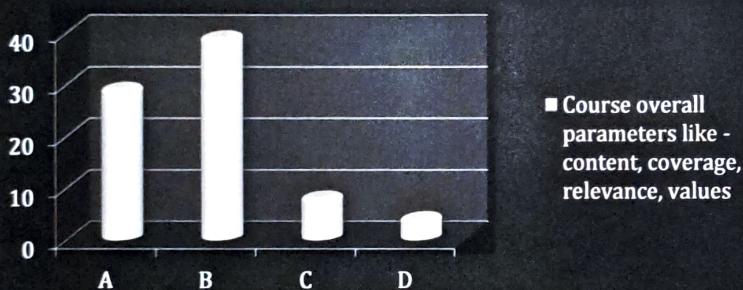


Quality of learning material in terms of clarity (prescribed books, supplementary reading list)



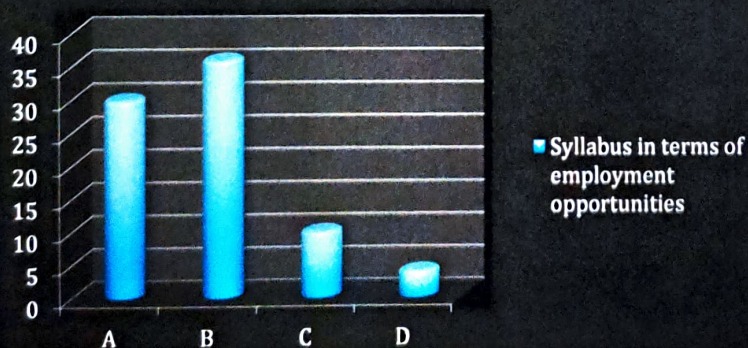

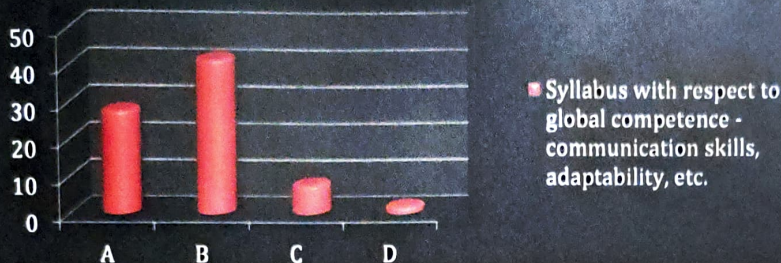

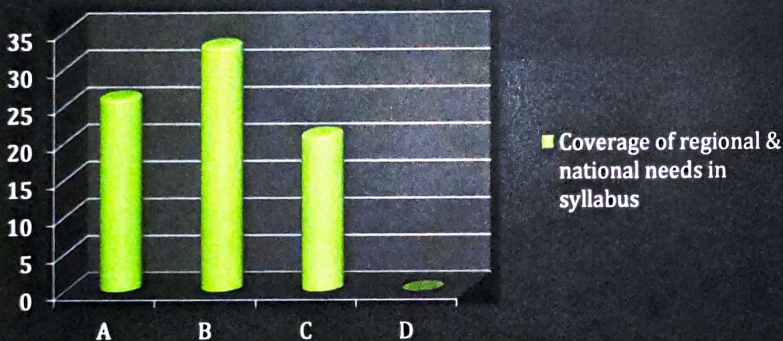


Syllabus with respect to global competence - communication skills, adaptability, etc.



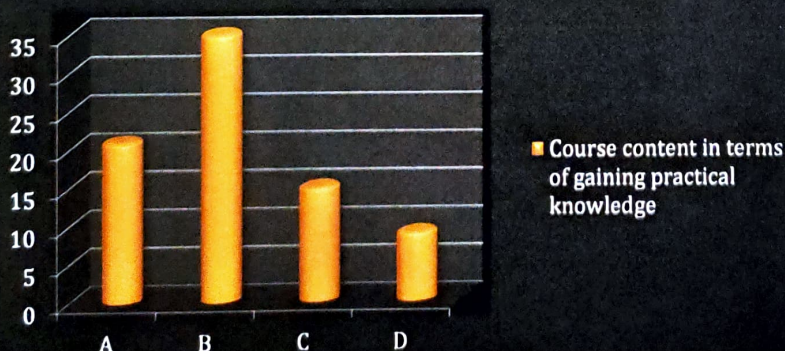

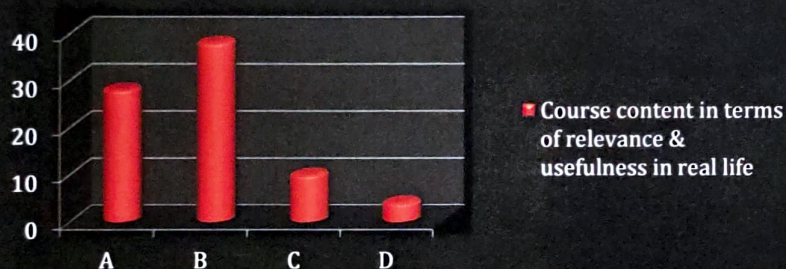

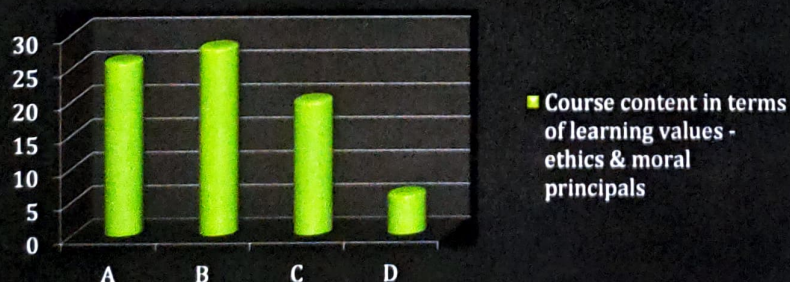

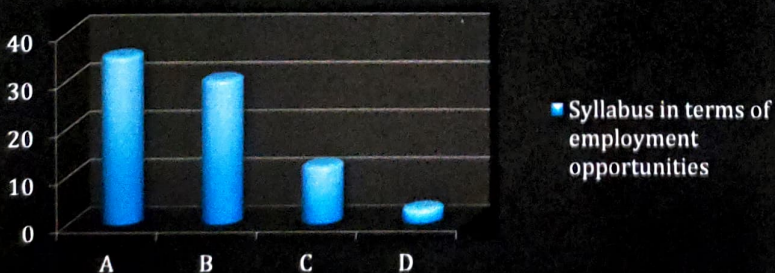

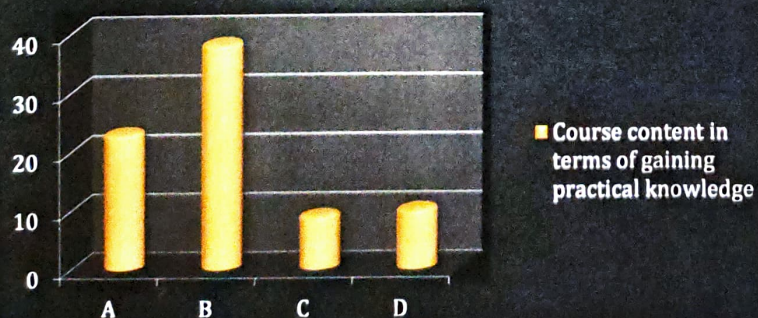

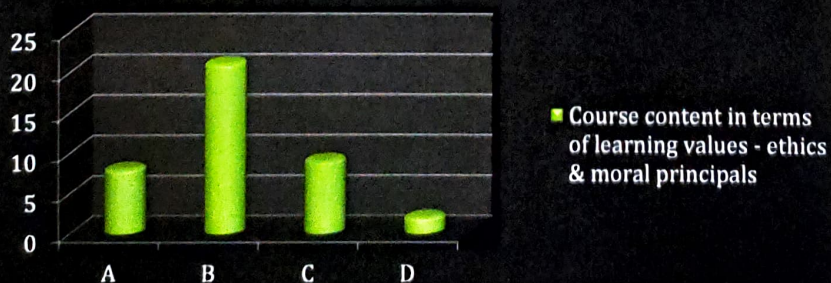

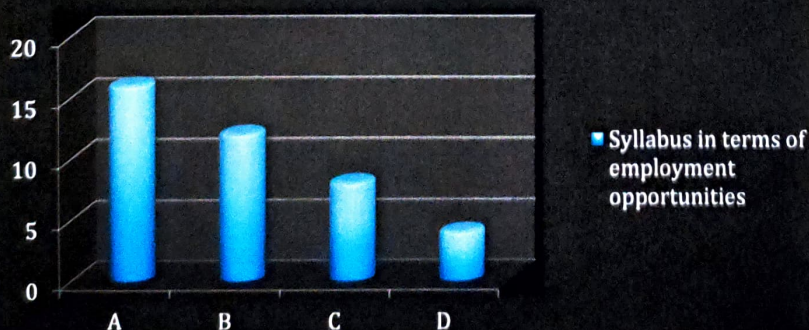

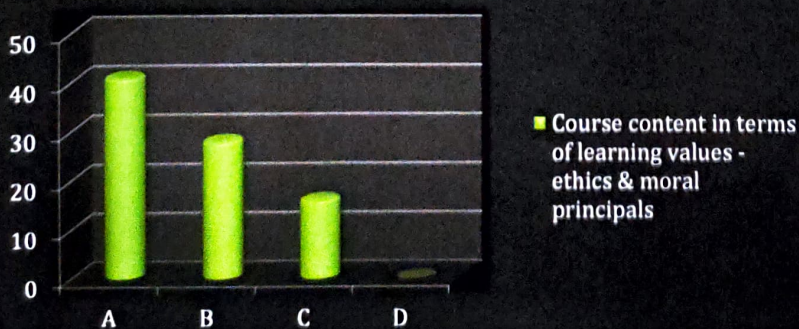

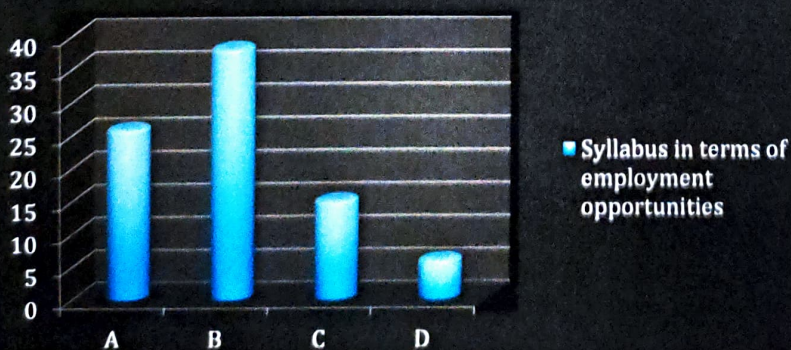

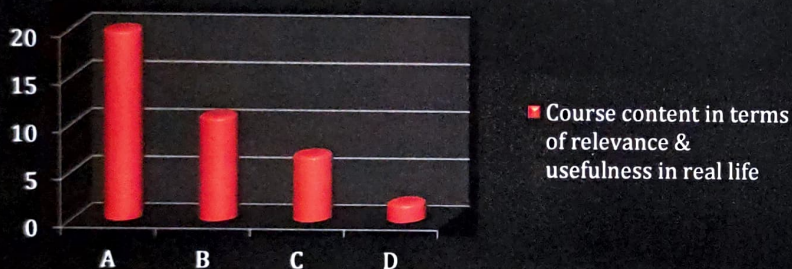

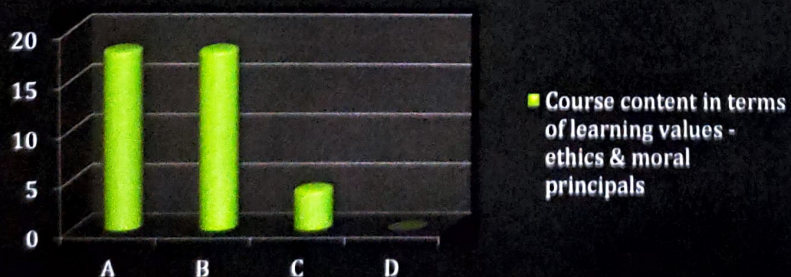

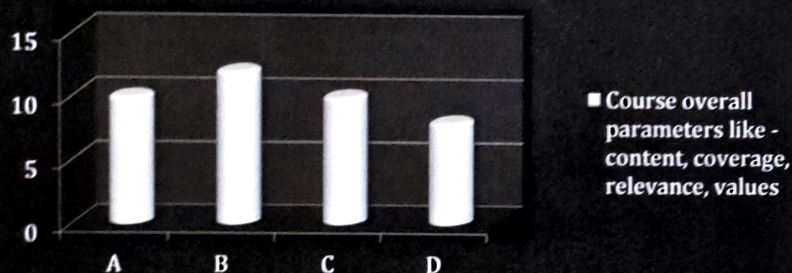


Quality of learning material in terms of clarity (prescribed books, supplementary reading list)



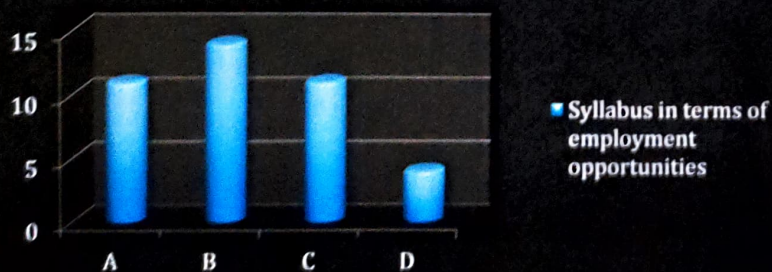

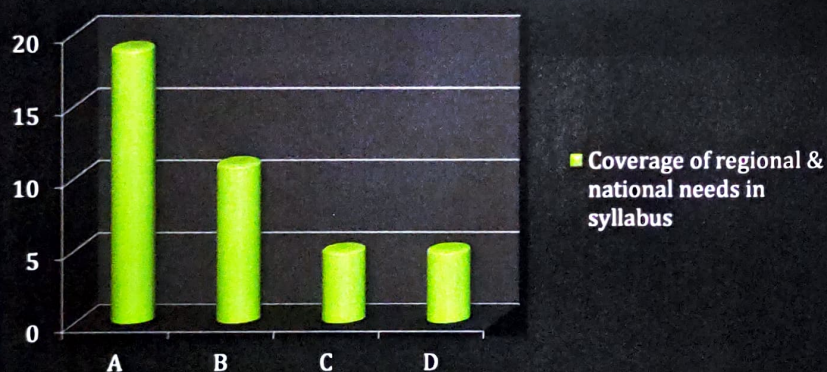


Syllabus with respect to global competence - communication skills, adaptability, etc.



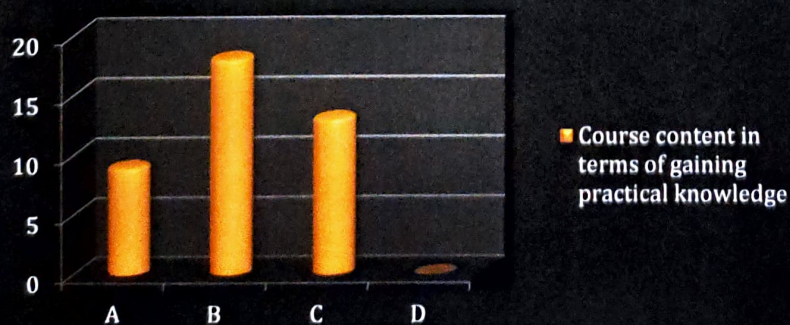

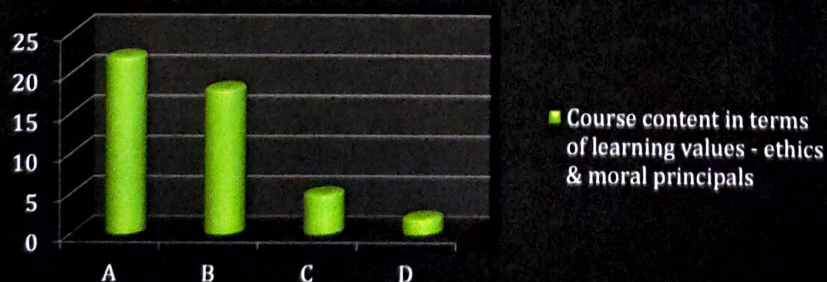

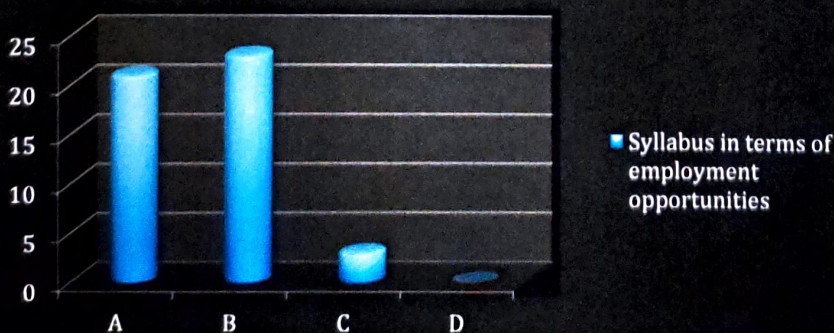

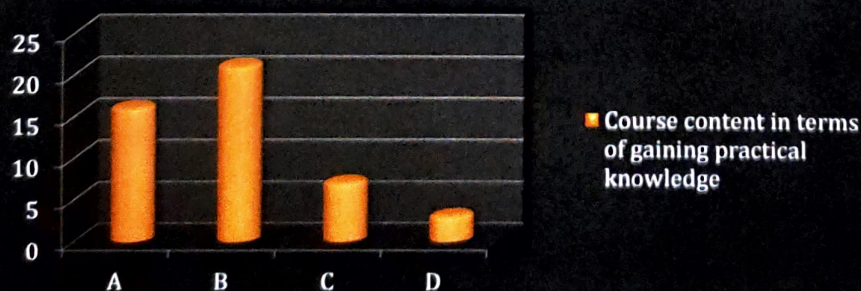

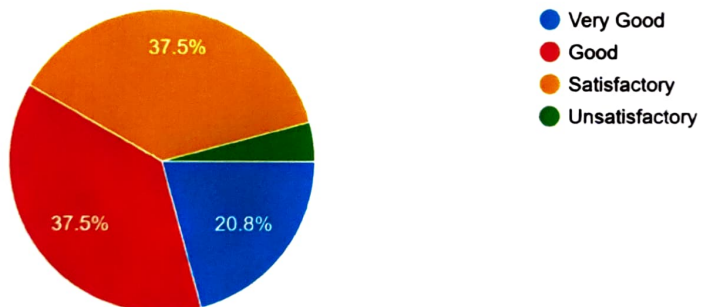

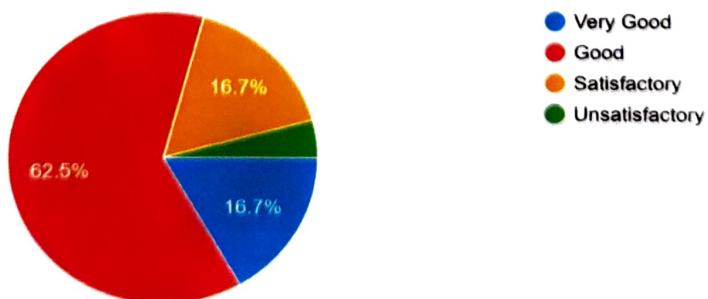

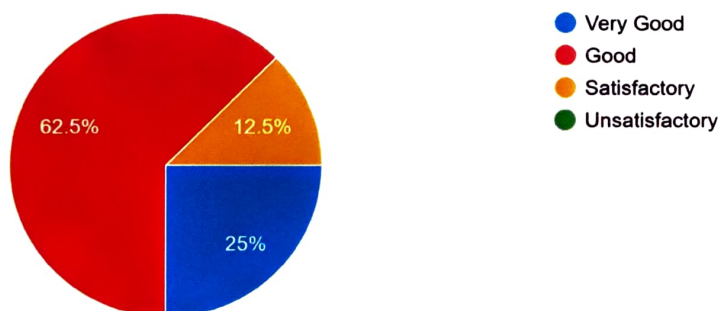

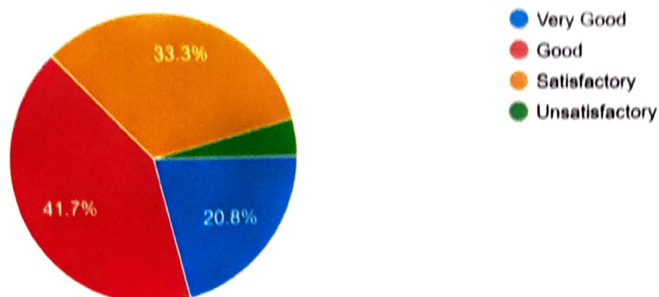

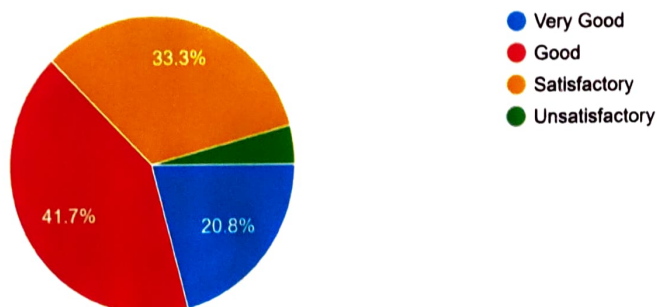

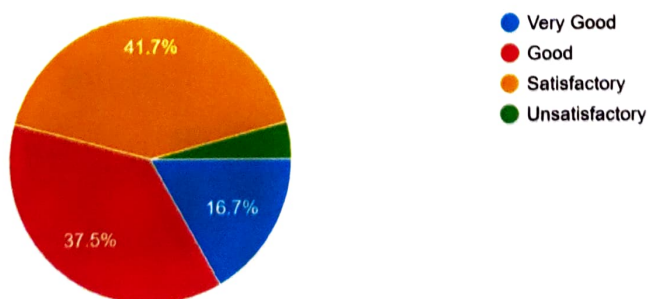

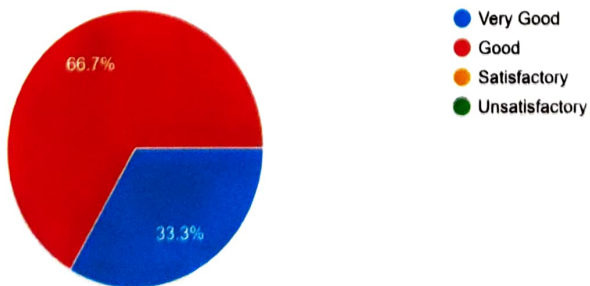

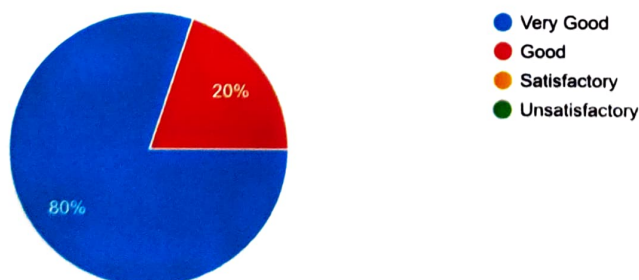

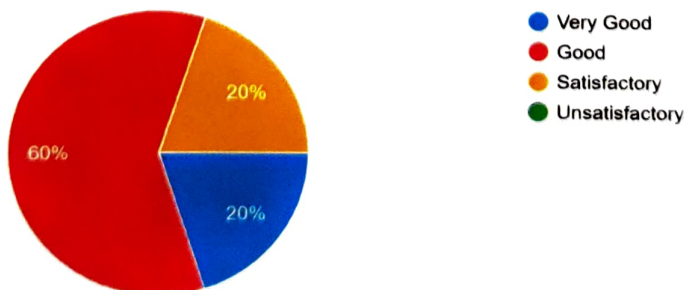

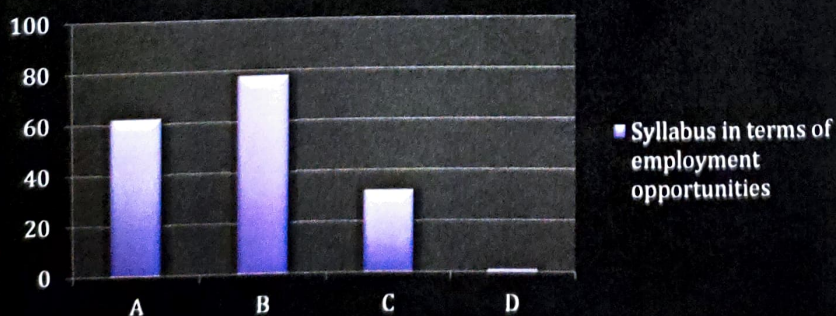

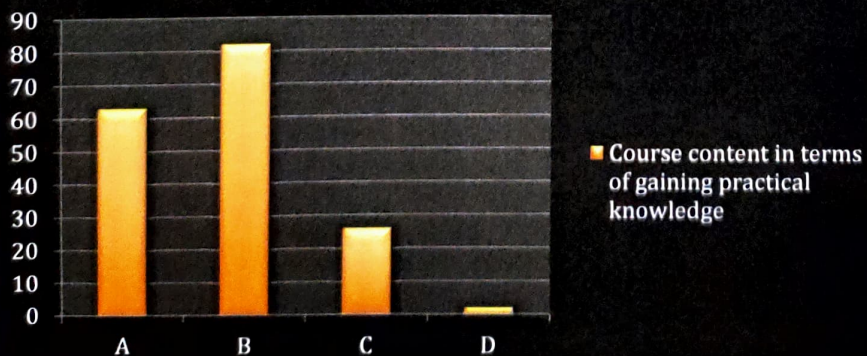

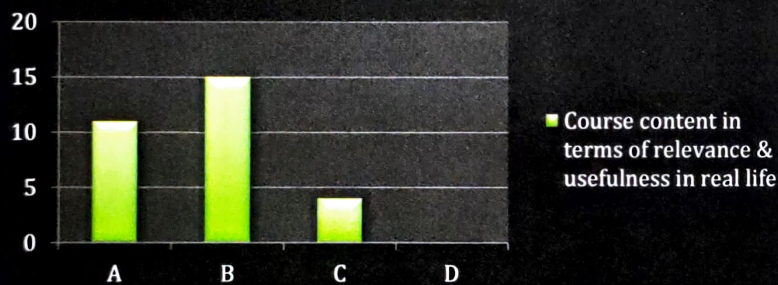

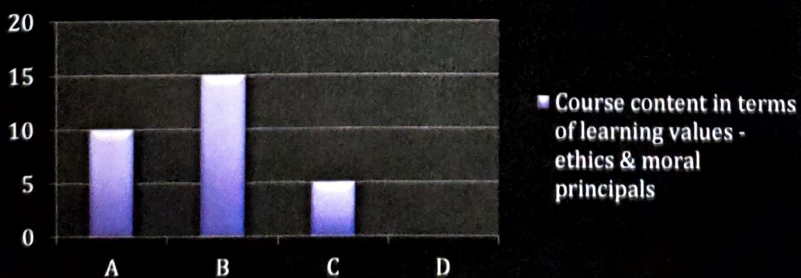

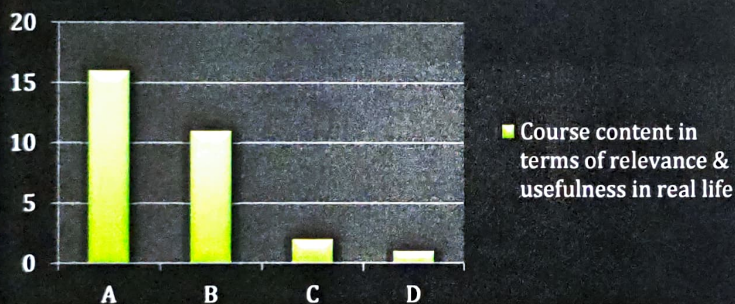

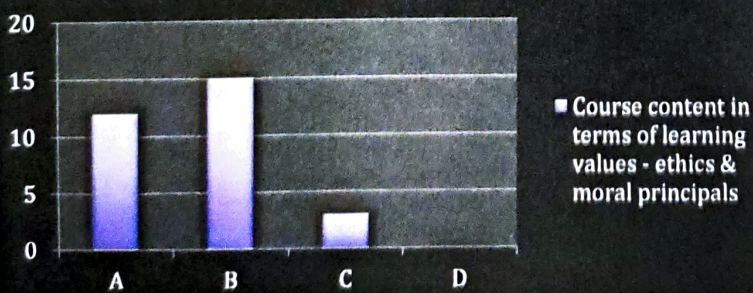

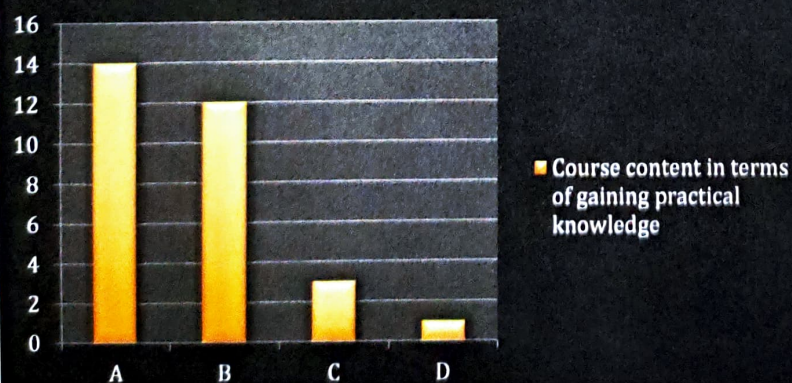

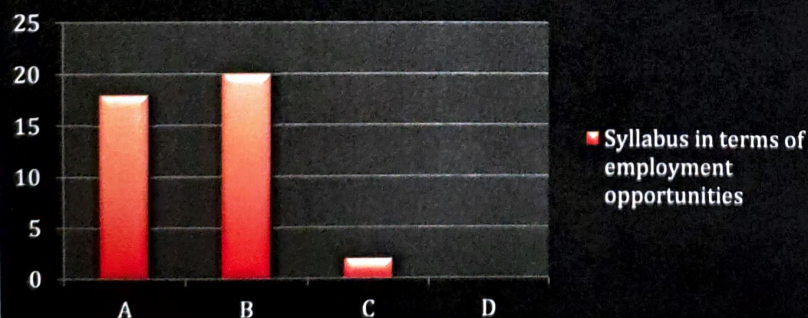

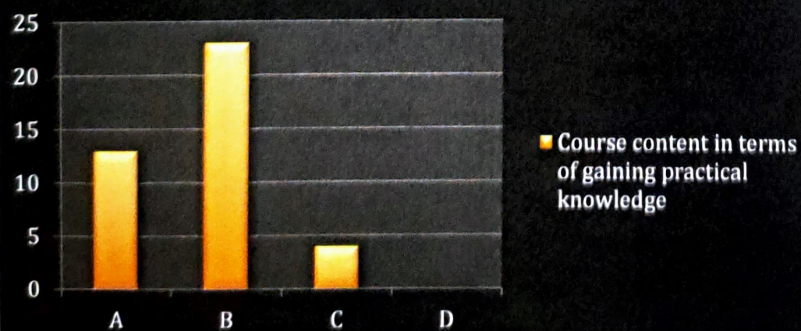
