GHANSHYAMDAS SARAF COLLEGE OF ARTS & COMMERCE CAREER GUIDANCE & PLACEMENT CELL & SKILL ACADEMY REPORT FOR A.Y 2019-20

Career Guidance & Placement Cell & Skill Academy plays a pivotal role in providing add on courses for enhancing employability skills of the students, arranging for career guidance sessions and partnering with corporates so that students receive full time, part time and internship job opportunities. Career Guidance & Placement Cell & Skill Academy of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College has been actively involved in organizing different activities for the benefit of the students.

The highlight of this year's activities was collaboration with Tata Institute of Social Sciences for starting various employability courses under NUSSD Programme. We also organized Job Fair seeking participation from more than 25 companies. The job fair attracted participation from 245 students of the college and around 200 outside candidates who appeared in the first round of selection process of these companies.

In the academic year 2019-20, 46 students were selected for internship opportunities and 116 students were selected for full time job opportunities with companies like ICICI Prudential, P3 Architectural Solutions, Motilal Oswal Investment Services, HDB Financial Services, Andromeda, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Axis Bank, TCS, Capgemini, Infosys, Wipro, Teleperformance, Just Dial etc. 67 students have been shortlisted for second round of interviews but due to COVID 19, second round had not been conducted till the preparation of this report.

Like every year, we offered various add on courses and conducted workshops for developing the skills of the students. We are happy to share that:



- 104 students completed Placement Oriented Youth Employability Skills Training Program conducted by Technoserve.
- 95 students completed Certificate Course in E-Taxation conducted in association with SDVTII.
- 89 students completed Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) Course
- 46 students completed Certificate Course in GST Practices and Procedures conducted in association with SDVTII.
- 10 students are pursuing Diploma in Entrepreneurship offered by Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) under National University Students Skill Development (NUSSD) Project.
- 43 students are pursuing Diploma in Banking and Financial Services offered by TISS
 NUSSD.
- 54 students are pursuing Certificate Course in Management and Soft Skills offered by TISS – NUSSD.
- 23 students completed Preparatory Course for Banking Sector Exams conducted in association with SSB Educational Trust,
- 21 students completed CASI Global Certificate Course offered by CASI Global.
- 40 students completed the 10 Days Workshop on Capital Markets conducted in association with IIFL.
- 15 students completed the Microsoft Technology Associate Certification in Java conducted in association with Technowings.
- 86 students participated in Workshop on Machine Learning with Python organised in association with Imarticus Learning.

Details of the activities conducted during the year is divided into three broad categories as mentioned below:

- A) Add on Certificate Courses,
- B) Career Guidance Sessions,
- C) Job Opportunities

A) Add on Certificate Courses:

1. Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) Course

Ghanshyamdas Saraf College is the first and the only undergraduate college in University of Mumbai to introduce Bloomberg Terminals to its students.

Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) is a self-paced e-learning course at Sharda Cropchem Bloomberg Lab that provides an interactive introduction to the financial markets. BMC consists of 5 modules – Economic Indicators, Currencies, Fixed Income, Equities, and Getting Started on the Terminal – woven together from Bloomberg data, news, analytics and television.

The program includes classroom teaching and approx 70 plus Bloomberg functions with overview of Portfolio Management. The course runs for 20 hours that can be split according to the requirement.

The first batch for the academic year 2019-20 started from July 1, 2019 and so far 89 students spread in 10 batches have completed the BMC Course in the year 2019-20. All the sessions were taken by Ms. Krupa Desai.

2. Youth Employability Skills Training Program By Technoserve

a) Orientation Session by Technoserve for TY B.Com Students - Batch 1

Placement cell organized an Orientation Session to inform the TY B.Com students about Free of Cost Placement Training Program offered by Technoserve on June 24, 2019 at 10:30 a.m. in Room No 205. A total of 132 students attended the program. The session was addressed by Ms. Kangan from Technoserve. She briefed the students about Career-Training Linkage, Structure of Training Program and the benefits students will reap after completion of the program.

b) Interviews by Technoserve for TY B.Com Students - Batch 1

Placement Cell invited team of Technoserve to conduct the interviews of interested students from TY B.Com to select them for Free of Cost Placement Training Program offered by Technoserve. The interviews were conducted on July 9, 2019 and 44 students appeared in the interview process

c) Orientation Session and Interviews by Technoserve for TY Students of Self Finance – Batch 1

Placement Cell organized an Orientation Session to inform the TY students of Self Finance Department about Free of Cost Placement Training Program offered by Technoserve on July 19, 2019 at 10:30 a.m. in Room No 305. A total of 70 students attended the session. The session

was addressed by Ms. Sneha from Technoserve. She briefed the students about Career-Training Linkage, Structure of Training Program and the benefits students will reap after completion of the program. After the session, interview was conducted, and 47 students appeared in the interview process.

d) Commencement of Training Program by Technoserve - Batch 1

After the orientation sessions and interviews, 54 students of TY from B.Com and Self Finance Department have been selected for pursuing Free of Cost Training program offered by Technoserve. The training Program started from July 22,2019 and was completed on October 18, 2020. Out of the 54 students selected, 50 students completed the training. The students have completed 80-hour program including Personal effectiveness, Communication Readiness, Career Readiness and Work Readiness. 80 hours of training was delivered in class and 40 hours of mandatory training is made available to students on TechnoServe's proprietary online learning platform. The students have also undergone individual counselling during the program, post-training, pre-placement and also post placements.

e) Parents Engagement session by Technoserve - Batch 1

The parents of 54 students who have completed Employability Training by Technoserve were called for a session on October 17, 2019 at 9 a.m. in Room No. 105. Ms. Sneha Ratnani, Trainer from Technoserve counseled the parents and requested them to support the students during their journey from becoming graduate to entering the corporate world.

f) Farewell by Batch 1

The first batch of Employability Training Program by Technoserve was completed on October 18, 2019 and on this last day, students and placement cell organized for a farewell program to appreciate the efforts put in by Team of Technoserve for the development of students. Students shared their feedback and the memories they have built during the entire duration of this training Program. They also thanked the Trainer Ms. Sneha Ratnani for her constant support and untiring efforts.

g) Placement Report of Batch 1:

Entrepreneurial Fair 2019



Report of the activities undertaken by DLLE during the Academic Year 2019-20

Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension aims to instill a 'Sense of Community' to connect with others and share a sense of belonging through various activities. The department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) enrolled 303 members during the academic year 2019-20. The projects taken by our students under DLLE are Career Project (CP), Anna Poorna Yojna (APY), Population Education Club(PEC), Survey of Women's Status (SWS). These are Career Oriented and community-oriented projects. The Moto of these Projects are as follows:
