Code of Professional Ethics (UGC Regulations 2010 Rules No. 17)

1. Teachers and Their Responsibilities

Whoever adopts teaching as a profession' assumes the obligation to conduct him in accordance with the ideals of the profession. A teacher is constantly under the scrutiny of his students and the society at large. Therefore, every teacher should see that there is no incompatibility between his precepts and practice. The national ideals of education which; have already been set forth and which he/she should seek to inculcate among students must be his/her own ideals. The profession further requires that the teachers should be calm, patient and communicative by temperament and amiable indisposition.

Teachers should -

- (i) Adhere to a responsible pattern of conduct and demeanour expected of them by the community;
- (ii) Manage their private affairs in a manner consistent with the dignity of the profession;
- (iii) Seek to make professional growth continuous through study and research;
- (iv) Express free and grand opinion by participation at professional meetings, seminars, conference, etc. towards the contribution of knowledge;
- (v) Maintain active membership of professional organizations and strive to improve education and profession through them;
- (vi) Perform their duties in the form of teaching, tutorial, practical and seminar work conscientiously and with dedication;
- (vii) Co-operate and assist in carrying out functions relating to the educational responsibilities of the college and the university such as assisting in appraising applications for admission, advising and counseling students as well as assisting in the conduct of university and college examinations, including supervision, invigilation and evaluation; and
- (viii) Participate in extension, co-curricular and extra curricular activities including community service.

2. Teachers and the students

Teachers should -

- (i) Respect the right and dignity of the student in expressing his/her opinion;
- (ii) Deal justly and impartially with students regardless of their religion, caste, political, economic, social and physical characteristics;
- (iii) Recognize the difference inaptitude and capabilities among students and strive to meet their individual needs;
- (iv) Encourage students to improve their attainments, develop their personalities and at the same time contribute to community welfare;
- (v) Inculcate among students scientific outlook and respect for physical labour and ideals of democracy, patriotism and peace;
- (vi) Be affectionate to the students and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reasons;
- (vii) Pay attention to only the attainment of the student in the assessment of merit;

- (viii) Make themselves available to the student even beyond their class hours and help and guide students without any remuneration or reward;
- (ix) Aid students to develop an understanding of our national heritage and national goals and
- (x) Refrain from inciting students against other students, colleagues or administration.

3. Teachers and Colleagues

Teachers should

- (i) Treat other member of the profession in the same manner as they themselves wish to be treated;
- (ii) Speak respectfully to other teachers and render assistance for professional betterment;
- (iii) Refrain from loading unsubstantiated allegations against colleagues to higher authorities;
- (iv) Refrain from allowing consideration of caste, creed, religion, race or sex in their professional endeavour.

4. Teachers and authorities:

Teacher should

- (i) Discharge their professional responsibilities according to the existing rules and adhere to procedures and methods consistent with their profession in initiating steps through their own institutional bodies and/ or professional organizations for change of any such rule detrimental to the professional interest;
- (ii) Refrain from undertaking any other employment and commitment including private tuitions and coaching classes which are likely to interfere with their professional responsibilities;
- (iii) Co-operate in the formulation of policies of the institution by accepting various offices and discharge responsibilities which such offices may demand;
- (iv) Co-operate through their organizations in the formulation of policies of the other institutions and accept offices;
- (v) Co-operate with the authorities for the betterment of the institutions keeping in view the interest and in conformity with dignity of the profession;
- (vi) Should adhere to the conditions of contract;
- (vii) Give and expect due notice before a change of position is made and
- (viii) Refrain from availing themselves of leave except on unavoidable grounds and as far as practicable with prior intimation, keeping in view their particular responsibility for completion of academic schedule.

5. Teachers and Non-Teaching Staff:

- (i) Teachers should treat the non-teaching staff as colleagues and equal partners in a cooperative undertaking, within every educational institution. Development of Human Resource.
- (ii) Teachers should help in the function of joint staff-councils covering both teachers and the non-teaching staff

6. Teachers and Guardians:

Teachers should try to see through teachers' bodies and organizations that institutions maintain contact with the guardians of their students, and reports of their performance to the guardians

whenever necessary and meet the guardians in meetings convinced for the purpose for mutual exchange of ideas and for the benefit of the institution.

7. Teachers and Society:

Teachers should

- (i) Recognize that education is a public service and strive to keep the public informed of the educational programme which are being provided;
- (ii) Work to improve education in the community and strengthen the community's moral and intellectual life;
- (iii) Be aware of social problems and take part in such activities as would be conducive to the progress of the society and hence the country as a whole;
- (iv) Perform the duties of citizenship, participate in community activities and shoulder responsibilities of public offices;
- (v) Refrain from taking part in or subscribing to or assisting in any way activities which tend to promote feeling of hatred or enmity among different communities, religions or linguistic groups hut actively work for National Integration.
