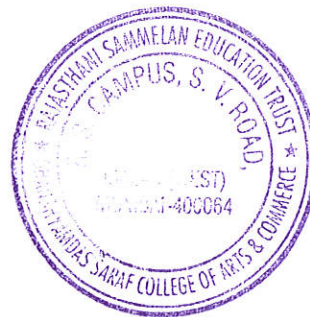
REPORT ON TREE PLANTATION ACTIVITY BY GREEN INITIATIVE COMMITTEE

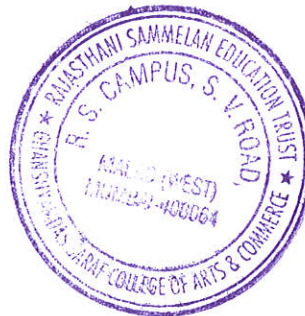
Rotaract Club of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College had successfully done Swachh Powai Lake project with Maharashtra State Angling Associations.
