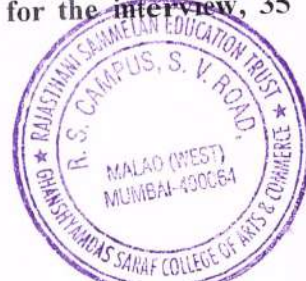
CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT COMMITTEE

ACADEMIC YEAR 2016-2017

The career guidance and placement committee of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College organises various activities like Seminars, Workshops, Interviews for various job Opportunities etc for the benefit of the students. This year too under the able guidance of Dr. Jayant Apte, Convener of Career Guidance and Placement Committee, team members of the committee: Dr. Anju Bohra, Prof. Kamala Shriram, Prof. Mamta Chhajer, Prof. Mansi Daingarwala, Prof. Preeti Matharu, Prof. Prasad Anareddy left no stone unturned in organising various activities successfully. Details of various activities conducted during the A.Y 2016-2017 is as follows:

1. **UPSC/MPSC Preliminary Exam:** University of Mumbai Organised an entrance test on 13/08/2016 to select students for providing Coaching for preparing them for UPSC/ MPSC Preliminary Exam. **5 Students** appeared for the entrance test conducted by the university.

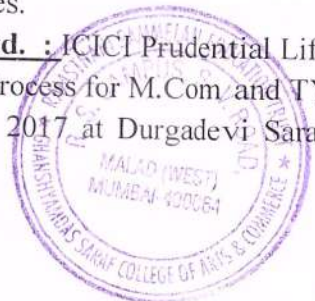

ACTIVITY REPORT

A.Y. 2017-18

The career guidance and placement committee of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College of Arts and Commerce organises various activities like Seminars, Workshops, Interviews for various job Opportunities etc. for the benefit of the students. The committee is headed by Dr. Jayant Apte, Vice Principal and other team members of the committee are: Dr. Anju Bohra, Prof. Preeti Jha, Prof. Mamta Chhajjar, Prof. Mansi Dangarwala, Prof. Preeti Matharu, and Prof. Prasad Anareddy. **In the year 2017 -18, more than 30 institutions/companies approached Placement Cell** for offering full time, part time, and internship opportunities and for organising workshops and sessions.

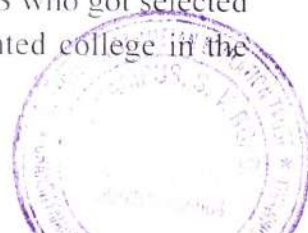
By the end of March 2018, around 22 students were selected for part time job opportunities, 74 students were offered internship opportunities, 36 students received offers for full time job opportunity and 80 students were selected for placement drive by NIIT. 05 students have received scholarships for Global Financial Markets Program offered by BSE. Around 200 students participated in quiz competitions conducted by Career launcher and NIIT. Moreover, around 500 students have attended various seminars organised by Placement Cell.

Details of various activities conducted during the A.Y 2017-2018 is as follows:

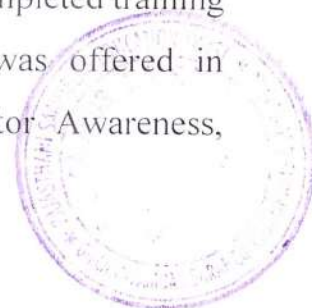
Career Guidance and Placement Committee

Annual Report - 2018-19

Career Guidance and Placement Cell plays a pivotal role in providing job opportunities to the students. **This year, so far around 140 students** have been selected for full time job opportunities with companies like Kotak Mahindra Bank, Reliance Group, Axis Securities, Datamatics, Capital First, Capgemini, L&T, Infosys, Wipro, HR Reflections, ICICI Prudential, Sutherland Global Services, Epicenter Technologies, Asit C Mehta Investment Intermediaries Ltd., HDB Financial Services, Redreamz, Reliance Smart, P3 Architectural Solutions, Karvy, TCS etc.

Moreover, around 75 students have been selected for Internship opportunities with companies like Aditya Birla Capital, IIFL, HR Reflections, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Future Generali India, etc.

This year we offered various add on courses and conducted workshops for developing the skills of the students. We are happy to share that **75 students** completed **Certificate Course in E Taxation**, **68 students** completed **Certificate Course in GST Practices and Procedures** which are offered in association with SDVTII. Moreover, **42 students** took **Preparatory Classes for Banking Sector Exams** organised in association with SSB Educational Trust. **101 students** completed **Youth Employability Skills Program** by **Technoserve**. **60 students** did 3 days training on Appearance, Body Language and Communication Skills (ABC) by At Patshala. **23 students** pursued **CASI Global Certificate Course**. **Two days workshop on GST** in association with ICAI was attended by **90 students**. **47 students** completed **Certificate Program in Financial Markets – Sales and Operations** offered by **BSE Institute**. **24 students** completed training for NISM Module VA related with Mutual Funds which was offered in association with FPA. Moreover, various sessions on Investor Awareness,



Financial Literacy, Mutual Funds etc., Career Guidance were also conducted in the year. **The highlight of the year was Job fair wherein 343 students participated.**

Details of the activities conducted during the year is as follows:

1) Workshop on GST

Career Guidance and Placement Cell of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College in association with Career Counselling Cell of ICAI organized two days workshop on GST for the TY students of B.Com and BCAAF on July 7 and 8, 2018.

On July 7, 2018 CA Archit Agarwal and CA Manoj Chauhan addressed the students. CA Archit's talk helped students in understanding need for GST, Constitutional Amendment, Features of GST, Implications of GST, Transition to GST from existing practices, Tax Rates under GST and Return Filing under GST.

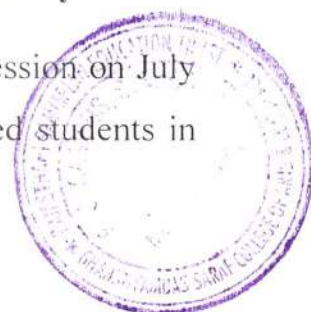
CA Manoj Chauhan explained Payments under GST.

On July 8, 2018 CA Vishnu explained the definitions under GST, the concept of supply (time, place, valuation), interstate supply, intrastate supply, structuring the transactions (IGST, CGST), Input Tax Credit, Reverse Charge, Registration procedure and Penalties under GST.

All the three speakers explained the concepts in simple and interactive manner with real life practical examples to make students understand in a better way. The workshop was attended by around 90 students. The workshop helped students to have a better knowledge about the core concepts of GST and opportunities which have arisen due to implementation of this new tax regime

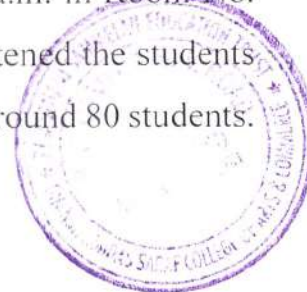

REPORT FOR A.Y 2019-20

Career Guidance & Placement Cell & Skill Academy plays a pivotal role in providing add on courses for enhancing employability skills of the students, arranging for career guidance sessions and partnering with corporates so that students receive full time, part time and internship job opportunities. Career Guidance & Placement Cell & Skill Academy of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College has been actively involved in organizing different activities for the benefit of the students.

The highlight of this year's activities was collaboration with Tata Institute of Social Sciences for starting various employability courses under NUSSD Programme. We also organized Job Fair seeking participation from more than 25 companies. The job fair attracted participation from 245 students of the college and around 200 outside candidates who appeared in the first round of selection process of these companies.

In the academic year 2019-20, 46 students were selected for internship opportunities and 116 students were selected for full time job opportunities with companies like ICICI Prudential, P3 Architectural Solutions, Motilal Oswal Investment Services, HDB Financial Services, Andromeda, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Axis Bank, TCS, Capgemini, Infosys, Wipro, Teleperformance, Just Dial etc. 67 students have been shortlisted for second round of interviews but due to COVID 19, second round had not been conducted till the preparation of this report.

Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) is a self-paced e-learning course at Sharda Crocherm Bloomberg Lab that provides an interactive introduction to the financial markets. BMC consists of 5 modules – Economic Indicators, Currencies, Fixed Income, Equities, and Getting Started on the Terminal – woven together from Bloomberg data, news, analytics and television.

The program includes classroom teaching and approx 70 plus Bloomberg functions with overview of Portfolio Management. The course runs for 20 hours that can be split according to the requirement.

The first batch for the academic year 2019-20 started from July 1, 2019 and so far 89 students spread in 10 batches have completed the BMC Course in the year 2019-20. All the sessions were taken by Ms. Krupa Desai.


