Armed with gloves and masks, more than 400 volunteers visited Juhu beach on Friday morning to take part in DNA's Eco Ganesha clean up drive.

Among the volunteers were many enthusiastic school and college students who lent a hand to the BMC workers and help them clean the beach. Ashwini Nandish Sandhu got his hands dirty in order to clean up garbage along Juhu along.

"I have volunteered for beach clean up drive earlier, but this is my first time to participate in a drive after Ganapati Visarjan. A few friends of mine who have been part of such activities, they inspired me to join a cleanup drive after the immersion day.
