The Career Guidance & Placement Cell & Skill Academy aims to provide desirous students an opportunity to start their career by inviting top companies for campus placements. The Cell also makes endeavors to sharpen employability skills of the students by conducting various counseling sessions, seminars, workshops, aptitude tests and mock interviews etc. Over the years, the cell has successfully placed students for full time and internship opportunities with various companies like WNS Global, ICICI Prudential Life Insurance, P3 Architectural Solutions, Harjai Computers Pvt. Ltd., Angel Broking Ltd, Capital First Ltd., India-bulls Ltd., BSE, Barclays Bank, Ace Technologies, Acquest, Kotak Life Insurance to name a few. The Cell has also collaborated with BSE Institute Ltd., Visara Technologies Services LLP, Pearl Academy, Arihant Academy etc. to run job-oriented training programs in the past.

The Skill development centre aims to advance the skill sets of the students to compete in a global environment. The objective is to provide necessary information and training to develop the skills sets of the students and make them industry ready. The Skill Development Centre will help bridge the industry-academia gap for employability.

Year 2015 - 2016:

In year 2015-2016, the cell has successfully placed students for full time and internship opportunities with various companies ICFAI, Gen XT (P3 Architecture), My Croyance, Lafit Company, Integra Unisource Pvt. Ltd, Prima Nexus Pvt. Ltd and many workshops was conducted by Navchetna Charitable Trust (regarding UPSC courses), Pearl Academy and a study visit was taken to the BSE and skill development course is conducted by BSE and Ambition Learning.

Year 2016 - 2017:

In year 2016-2017, the cell has successfully placed students for full time and internship opportunities with various companies like Angel Broking, Capital First Ltd, Acquest WNS Global, ICICI Prudential Life Insurance Co. Ltd, Barclays Bank, P3 Architectural Solutions, Ace Technology, Indiabulls. Off campus job interviews conducted by Catking, Quantum Global Securities Ltd., Siemens Ltd., Real HR Ltd., RK Puri and Associates, HDB Financial services, Kotak Life Insurance, Facts Today News, DC India, Harjai Computers, Human Capitalist and Skill development program conducted by Visara Technologies Services LLP, BSE Institute Ltd. Seminars were conducted by start ups, Pearl Academy, BSE LIT Fest, PTVA Talk, Drishant JOB Fair, Job Fair at Khandwala, Career Counselling Seminar, National Institute of Securities Markets

Year 2017 - 2018:

In the year 2017 -18, more than 30 institutions/companies approached Placement Cell for offering full time, part time, and internship opportunities and for organizing workshops and sessions. By the end of March 2018, around 22 students were selected for part time job opportunities, 74 students were offered internship opportunities, 36 students received offers for full time job opportunity and 80 students were selected for placement drive by NIIT. 05 students have received scholarships for Global Financial Markets Program offered by BSE. Around 200 students participated in quiz competitions conducted by Career launcher and NIIT. Moreover, around 500 students have attended various seminars organized by Placement Cell.

Full time Interview offered Harjai Computers Pvt. Ltd, Tech Mahindra Business Services, Just Dial, Capital First Ltd, Birla Sunlife Insurance Company, Birla Sunlife Insurance Company, My Insurance Club, ICICI Prudential Life Insurance Co. Ltd. Internship by RBI and many more.

Year 2018 - 2019:

In year 2018-2019, 140 students have been selected for full time job opportunities with companies like Kotak Mahindra Bank, Reliance Group, Axis Securities, Datamatics, Capital First, Capgemini, L&T, Infosys, Wipro, HR Reflections, ICICI Prudential, Sutherland Global Services, Epicenter Technologies, Asit C Mehta Investment Intermediaries Ltd., HDB Financial Services, Redreamz, Reliance Smart, P3 Architectural Solutions, Karvy, TCS etc. Moreover, around 75 students have been selected for Internship opportunities with companies like Aditya Birla Capital, IIFL, HR Reflections, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Future Generali India, etc.

In 2018, Career Guidance and Placement Committee offered various add on courses and conducted workshops for developing the skills of the students. We are happy to share that 75 students completed Certificate Course in E Taxation, 68 students completed Certificate Course in GST Practices and Procedures which are offered in association with SDVTII. Moreover, 42 students took Preparatory Classes for Banking Sector Exams organized in association with SSB Educational Trust. 101 students completed Youth Employability Skills Program by Technoserve. 60 students did 3 days training on Appearance, Body Language and Communication Skills (ABC) by At Patshala. 23 students pursued CASI Global Certificate Course. Two days workshop on GST in association with ICAI was attended by 90 students. 47 students completed Certificate Program in Financial Markets – Sales and Operations offered by BSE Institute. 24 students completed training for NISM Module VA related with Mutual Funds which was offered in association with FPA. Moreover, various sessions on Investor Awareness, Financial Literacy, Mutual Funds etc., Career Guidance were also conducted in the year. The highlight of the year was Job fair wherein 343 students participated.

Year 2019 - 2020:

In the academic year 2019-20, 46 students were selected for internship opportunities and 116 students were selected for full time job opportunities with companies like ICICI Prudential, P3 Architectural Solutions, Motilal Oswal Investment Services, HDB Financial Services, Andromeda, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Axis Bank, TCS, Capgemini, Infosys, Wipro, Teleperformance, Just Dial etc. 67 students have been shortlisted for second round of interviews but due to COVID 19, second round had not been conducted till the preparation of this report.

The highlight of this year's activities was collaboration with Tata Institute of Social Sciences for starting various employability courses under NUSSD Programme. We also organized Job Fair seeking participation from more than 25 companies. The job fair attracted participation from 245 students of the college and around 200 outside candidates who appeared in the first round of selection process of these companies.

Placement Cell also keeps on floating details about various Job Drives occurring at different institutes for the benefit of the students.

Career Guidance & Placement Cell & Skill Academy would take this year of legacy forward with zeal and rigor for better future of our students.
