JUSTICE IS THE RIGHT NOT A PRIVILEGE.

तुझे अधिकार दिया, सत्कार दिया, प्यार दिया, सम्मान दिया। लेकिन इन सबके साथ एक अनकहा 'डर' भी दिया। यह डर दूसरों से नहीं, बल्कि अपनों से, समाज से, और उन भूखे भेड़ियों से है जो न जाने कब, कैसे, तुझे नोच खाए और फिर दुनिया को ये दिखाया जाए कि गलती तेरी ही थी। दोष उन भेड़ियों का नहीं, उस जिस्म का है जो भगवान ने तुझे अंश और वंश बढ़ाने के लिए दिया। दोष उन पापियों का नहीं, बल्कि तेरे वस्त्रों का है, तेरी मुस्कान का है, तेरे मित्रता भरे व्यवहार का है, देर रात तक काम करने का है, अकेले सड़कों पर चलने का है, सपनों के लिए मेहनत करने का है, और सबसे ज्यादा, पुरुषों से मित्रता रखने का है। ये सवाल नहीं हैं, बल्कि दर्द से निकले हुए तीखे जवाब हैं। समाज जब भी पुरुष और महिला के दर्द का विश्लेषण करता है, तो हर बार एक नया दृष्टिकोण दिखाता है—और दुखद सच यही है कि इन घटनाओं में दोष पीड़िता पर ही मढ़ दिया जाता है।

जब दो या ढाई साल की मासूम बच्ची के शरीर को नोचा जाता है, तो सवाल उठता है कि क्या उसके कपड़े छोटे थे? जब दिनदहाड़े ऐसी घिनोनी घटनाएं होती हैं, तो लोग अंधेरी रातों को दोष देते हैं। जब अस्सी साल की वृद्धा शिकार बनती है, तो कहते हैं कि उसने इशारे किए होंगे। लेकिन कोलकाता की एक डॉक्टर ने न छोटे कपड़े पहने, न इशारे किए, न ही कोई ऐसा काम किया जिससे इन भेड़ियों का मन मचल जाए—फिर भी, उसकी ज़िंदगी छीन ली गई।



इस समाज में न्याय का कोई ठिकाना नहीं। न्याय के नाम पर राजनीति के हज़ार रंग देखने को मिलते हैं। बड़े-बड़े भाषण, "हम लड़ेंगे, हम सुधारेंगे। हमारे राज में ऐसा नहीं होगा।" देश दो दिनों के लिए आंदोलन करेंगे, मोमबत्तियां जलाएंगे, और तीसरे दिन सब भुला देंगे। फिर एक नई कहानी, फिर वही पुरानी दास्तान, बार-बार, हज़ार बार, लेकिन कुछ बदलेगा नहीं।

यदि सच में बदलाव लाना है, तो बेटियों को इस कड़वी हकीकत से आंखें बंद करने से रोकें नहीं। उन्हें इस असली दुनिया को देखने और समझने का हौसला दें। उन्हें समझने दें कि इस समाज के पापियों से कैसे निपटना है। वरना, हर दिन एक नई कहानी जन्म लेगी और बिना किसी न्याय के खत्म हो जाएगी। "बेटियों को सुरक्षित करने से ज्यादा बेहतर होगा, बेटों को उनकी सीमाओं और दायरों का बोध कराना।" एक स्त्री सिर्फ लक्ष्मी नहीं है, वह चंडी भी है—वह मौं है, बहन है, बेटो है, पत्नी है, किसी घर का सम्मान है, न कि किसी के लिए केवल एक वस्तु। #JUSTICEFORHER लिखने से बेहतर होगा कि समाज ऐसे कुकर्म करने वालों को खुद ही जीते जी मार डाले।

समाधान: समाज को अब सिर्फ समस्याओं का वर्णन नहीं, बल्कि उनका समाधान ढूंढना होगा। सबसे पहले, महिलाओं के प्रति अपने दृष्टिकोण में बदलाव लाना होगा। यह बदलाव केवल कानून से नहीं, बल्कि शिक्षा और संस्कारों से आएगा। हमें अपने बेटों को सिखाना होगा कि महिलाओं का सम्मान करना उनका कर्तव्य है, कोई विकल्प नहीं। ऐसे अपराधियों को सख्त से सख्त सज़ा मिलनी चाहिए, ताकि दूसरों के लिए यह एक कड़ा संदेश बने। साथ ही, महिलाओं को आत्मरक्षा के तरीकों की शिक्षा दी जानी चाहिए, ताकि वे किसी भी विपरीत परिस्थिति में खुद को सुरक्षित रख सकें।

समाज को समझना होगा कि सुरक्षा सिर्फ एक शब्द नहीं, बल्कि हर नागरिक की ज़िम्मेदारी है। यही असली न्याय होगा, यही असली बदलाव होगा।

NIPAH VIRUS OUTBREAK: KERALA - Sakina Ezyz (FY BSCIT-08)



After a recent death from the Nipah virus, 175 people have been put on a contact list says Kerala health minister Veena George Out of the 175 who were in contact with the recent Nipah case, 74 are healthcare workers. 126 people are on the primary contact list, out of which 104 are considered to be high-risk. 49 others are categorised under secondary contact. According to a PTI report, Nipah virus antibodies had been found in bats in Kozhikode, Wayanad, Idukki, Malappuram and

Ernakulam districts. Fruit bats are natural hosts of the virus and can spread it to humans after which person-to-person transmission is possible. This has been the second death this year due to the Nipah virus, which the World Health Organisation defines as a priority pathogen because of its potential to cause an epidemic. There is no vaccine and no specialised treatment to cure it.

GUAVAS IN U.P OVER 50% INFECTED

Over 50% of the guavas in the state are infected with root-knot nematode. This is alarming when guava is one of the most important fruit crops of the region. Director, Indian Council for Agricultural Research - Central Institute of Subtropical Horticulture (ICAR-CISH), T Damodaran, said that studies indicated that nematode infection was rare till 2015 in India. "With the introduction of exotic cultivars like Thai Pink, Taiwan Pink, the infection has spread extensively by infected planting material".

DISCOVERING INDIA'S TOP HAUNTED SITES

BHANGARH FORT (RAJASTHAN)

Bhangarh Fort (Rajasthan) - At the top of the list of haunted places in India has to be Bhangarh fort. Built in the 16th century, Bhangarh still stands tall to this day. Deserted after the famine of 1783, the fort has many ghost stories tied to it. Legend has it that the beautiful princess Ratnavati sentenced a man to death because he tried to trick the princess into marrying him; he cursed the whole town before he eventually passed away. Some locals believe that those who enter the fort after dark might never return, and although there is no evidence supporting this claim, Bhangarh has always topped the list of one of the most haunted places in India



KULDHARA (JAISALMER, RAJASTHAN)

Kuldhara (Jaisalmer, Rajasthan) - Popularly known as the Ghost Town, Kuldhara has rightfully earned its place on this list after being the second most haunted place in all of Asia. The story begins with the corrupt minister of the state, Salim Singh, forcefully wishing to marry the daughter of the village head in 1825. Unwilling to let Salim dishonor them, the villagers disappeared one night and never returned. To this day, the fate of all those villagers remains a mystery. Whether the village is truly haunted or not is a topic for discussion, but it does convey the strength and resilience of the common man in India and narrates the painfully sad story of all those people who had to flee their homes due to the injustice they endured.



SHANIWARWADA FORT, (PUNE, MAHARASHTRA)

Shaniwarwada Fort, (Pune, Maharashtra) - Perhaps the least allegedly haunted place on this list is the Shaniwarwada fort. This beautiful 13-storey palace of the Peshwas was built by Bajirao- I in 1736. The palace unfortunately witnessed the fall of the Peshwas. A tale of a jealous uncle going as far as killing his own nephew to inherit the throne echoes among the walls of the fort. The fort was ruined in the fire of 1928 and has since been deserted and abandoned. Travelers have reported hearing strange noises, but that has not stopped them from exploring the grand Shaniwarwada fort and seeing the beauty and architecture of the Peshwa's palace.
