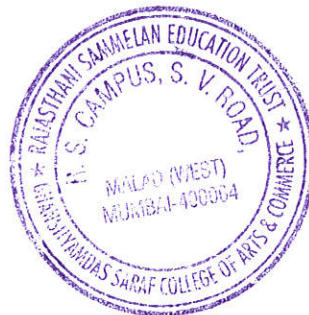
1. Remedial coaching for academically weak students.
