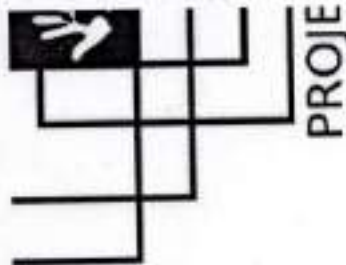

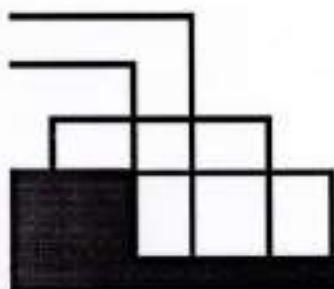

The Event :

9. A few of the statements were: Veg Briyani is not a real Briyani; Women always gossip, but men never gossip. It was truly a pleasure to listen to people proving the statements wrong.
10. The groups were judged on the basis of their active participation in all the activities and how they performed.
11. First place was won by Group 2 followed by Group 3 and Group 1.
12. Overall, the event was a successful one where members got the opportunity to boost their speaking confidence along with having fun with their teammates.

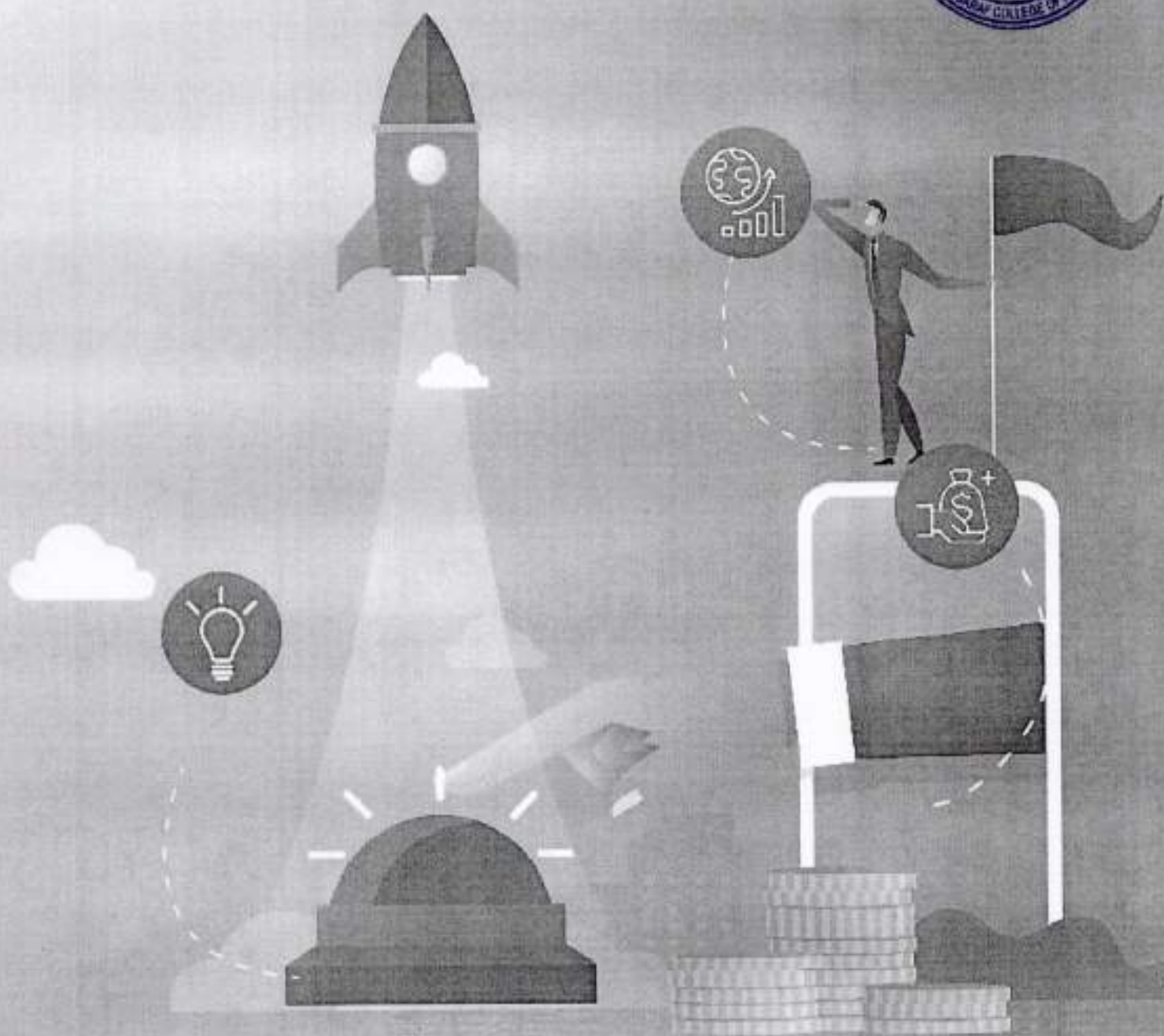

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impact.

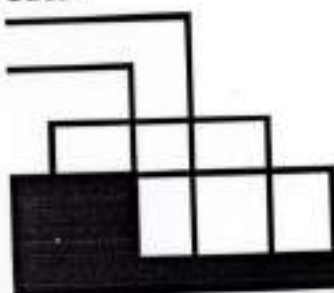



