#### Report On Multi-Disciplinary One-Day National Conference On

Survival, Resurgence and Sustainability in Digitalisation: A Global Perspective

#### Introduction

Digitalisation is booming in recent times. Digital technologies have the potential to boost more inclusive and sustainable growth by spurring innovation, generating efficiencies and improving services. They are also an important tool in helping countries to confront and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic that has disrupted economies and societies globally. The mass adoption of connected digital services by consumers' enterprises, and governments has emerged in recent years as a key economic driver that accelerates growth and facilitates job creation. In view of these changes the conference aimed to seek out Survival strategies, Resurgence of sectors if any and means of Sustainable development.

#### The Program

Ghanshyamdas Saraf College held a One Day Multidisciplinary National Conference on "Survival, Resurgence and Sustainibility in Digitalisation: A Global Perspective" on Wednesday, 15th February 2023 in Durgadevi Saraf Auditorium. The Objective of the Conference was:
