Following is the summary of the activities conducted during the Academic Year 2022-2023: BMS Department of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College organized the Annual Departmental activity-INNOVISION in three phases:

INNOVISION 1.0 had the theme "The Ad-Mad Show" with the objective to enhance advertising skills of students and encourage them to show their talent. It was conducted at the Inter-Collegiate level on 19th September 2022 in D. S. Auditorium. The Ad-Mad Show saw a turnout of 14 teams across different colleges in Mumbai. There were 3 rounds - The first round was judged by Prof. Mamta Chhajer & Dr. Rupa Shah. In the final 2 rounds, two highly experienced and knowledgeable guests of honors belonging to the Ad world - Ms. Neha Sharma and Mr. Sanjay Satapathy judged the competition.



INNOVISION 2.0 had the theme "Gen Z Talent Mania" with the objective to sharpen the conceptual & critical thinking skills of students. It was conducted at the Intra-Collegiate level on 4th March 2023 in Room No. 106 followed by D. S. Auditorium. The program was divided into three mega events namely:

 out their level of awareness on brands and their functioning. There were a turnout of 20 teams
 consisting of 2 members each.
- 2. <u>Knowledge Podium: A Talk by Expert –</u> A prominent guest speaker Dr. Shobha Mathewfrom K.J. Somaiya College was invited to share her expert knowledge on "Contemporary Trends in Advertising" highlighting the latest market developments at the global scenario.
