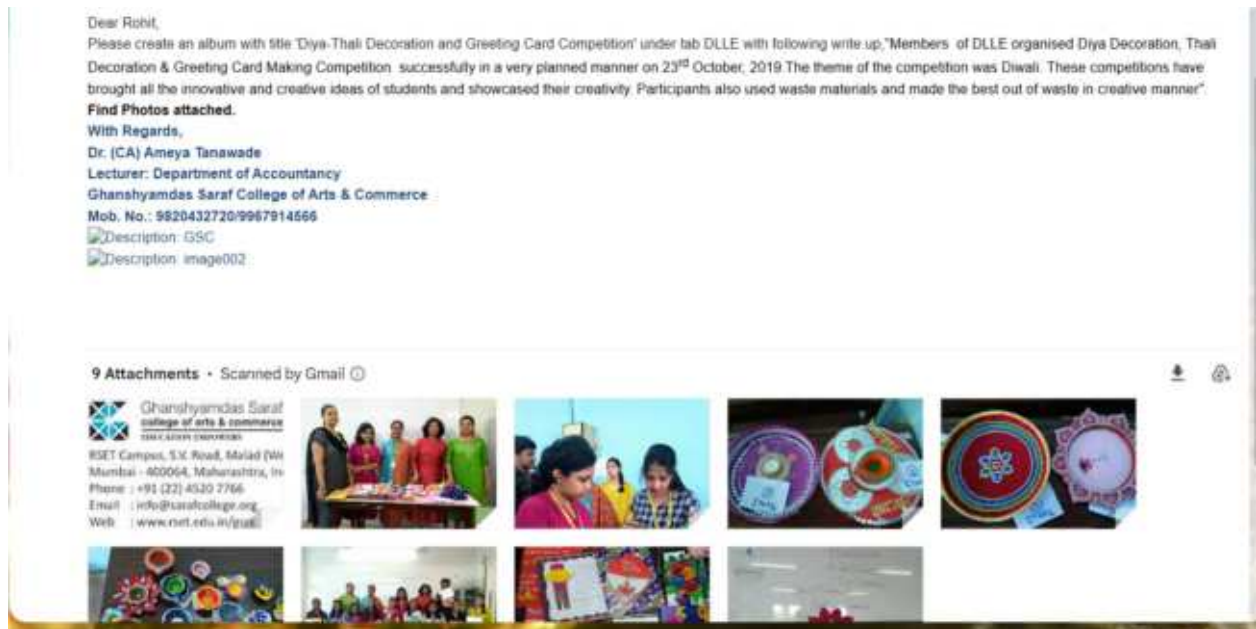

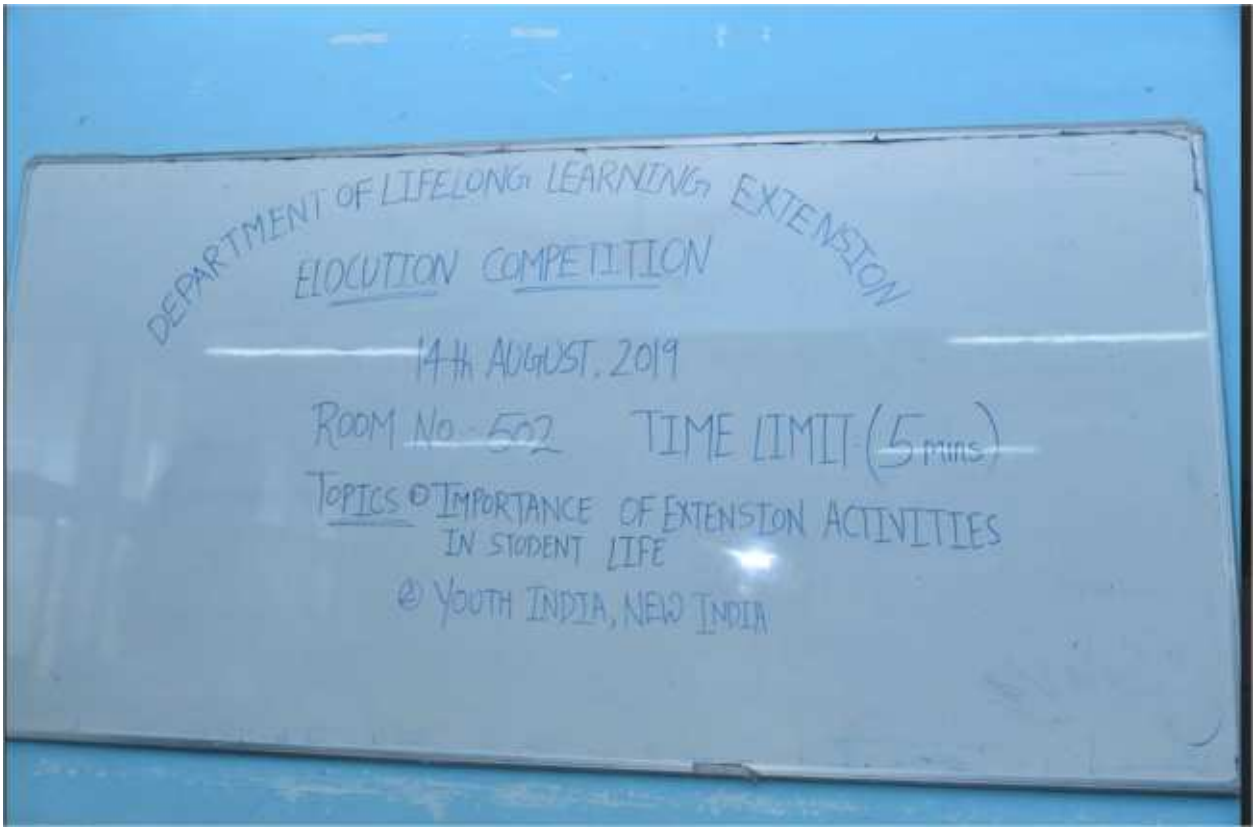






## Elocution Competition

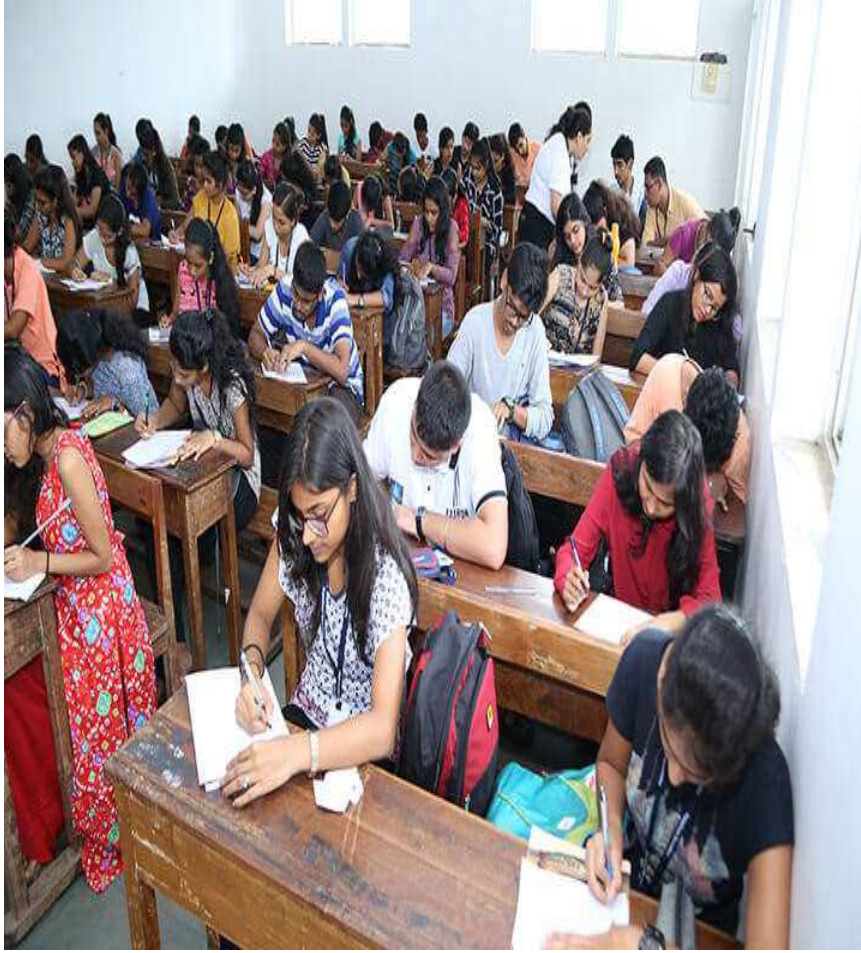




## Essay Writing Competition

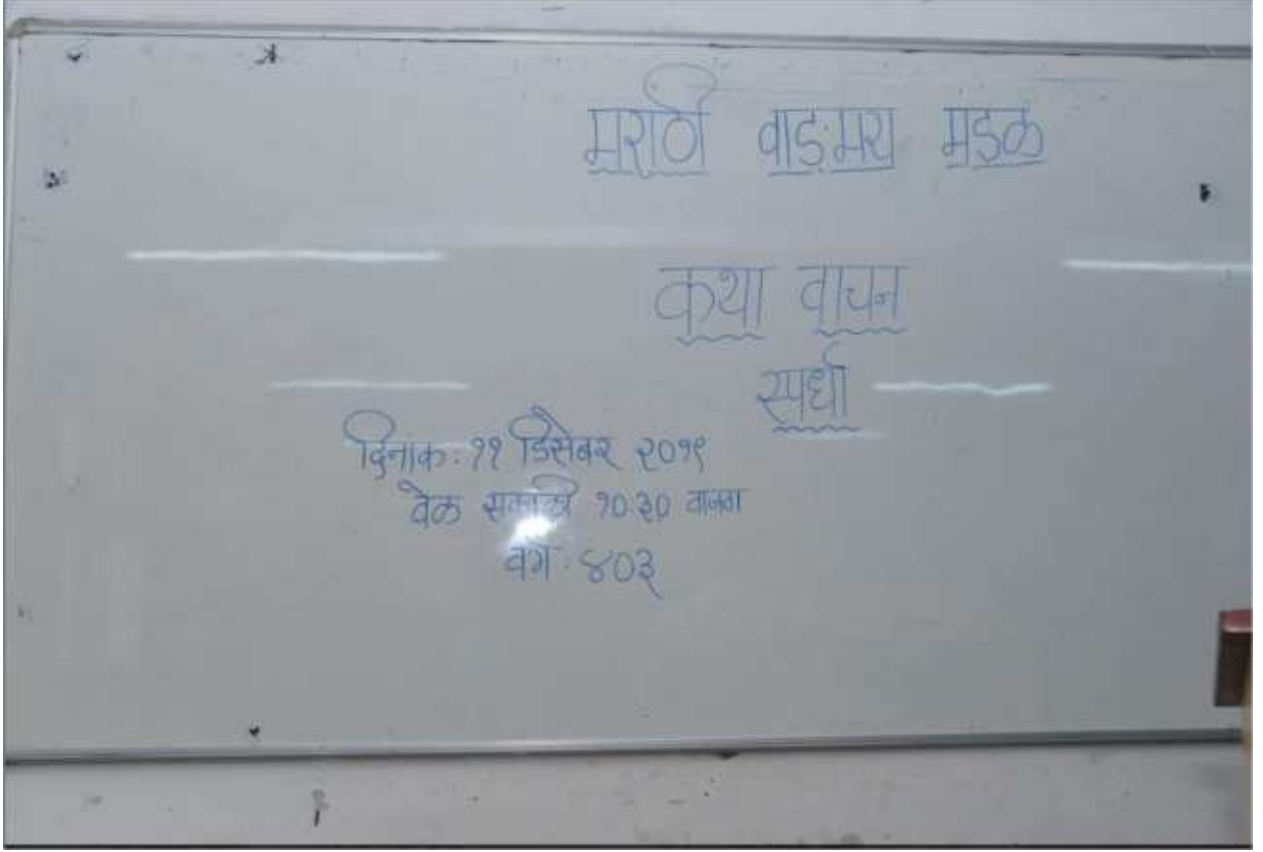

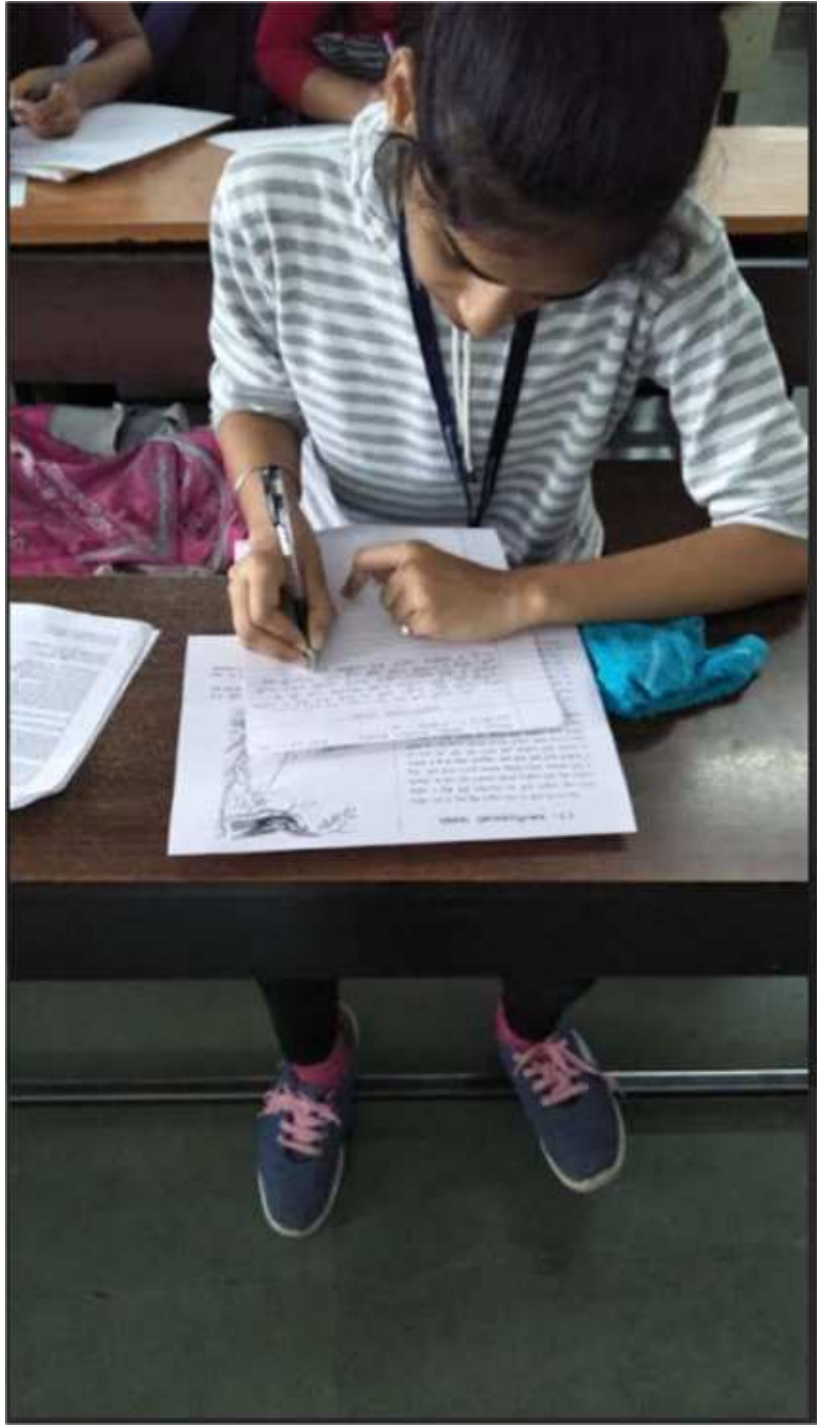

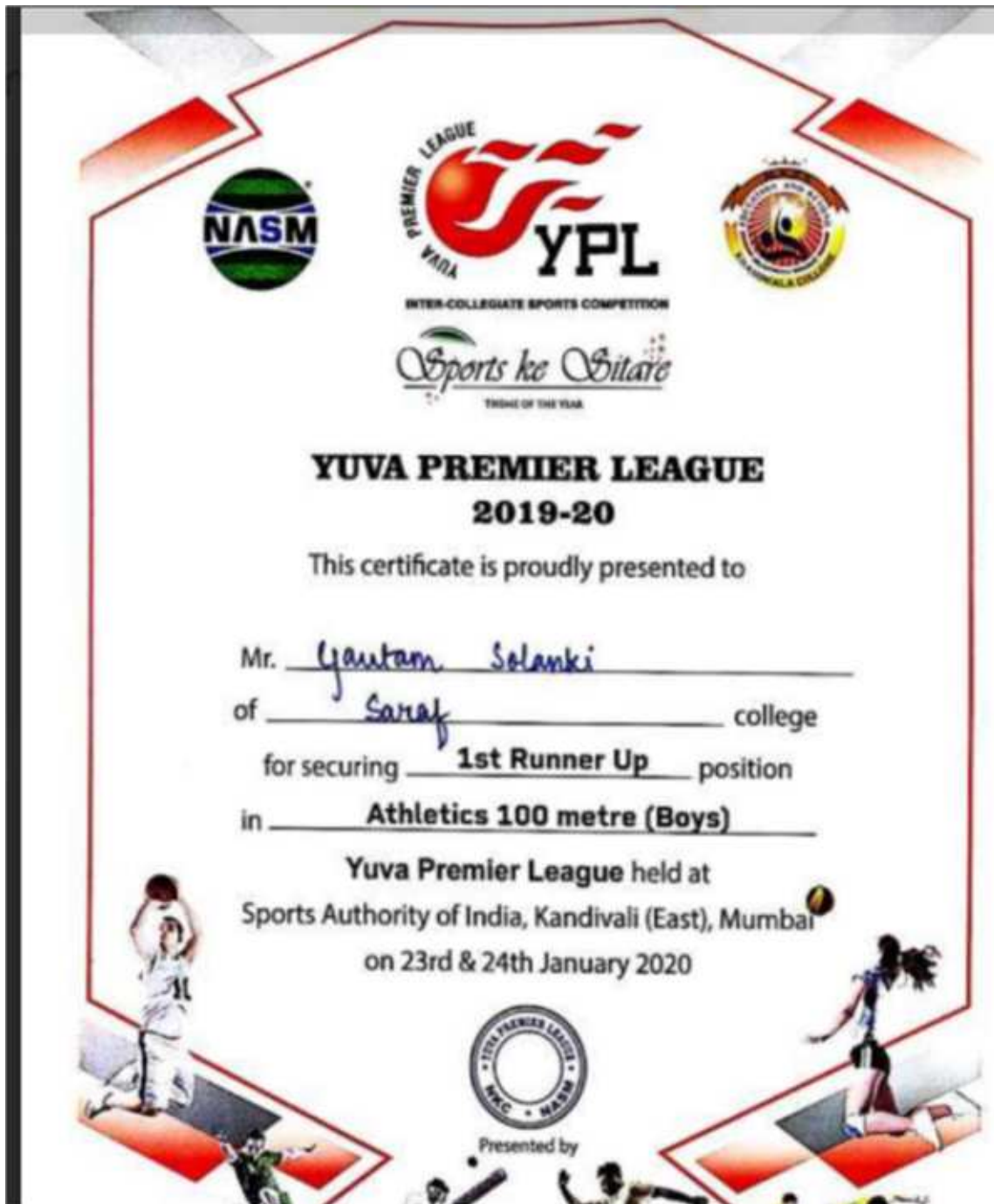
