### Aim/Concept:-

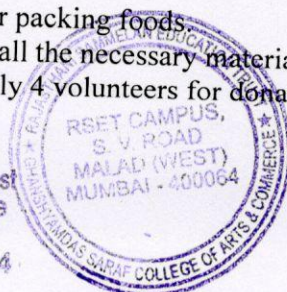
1. The aim of the project was to distribute to those people who are living on footpaths and suffered to have one time meal.

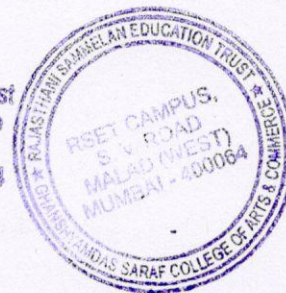

4. To make the festival of lights more special for everyone, by sharing some colorful moments & create memories to cherish.

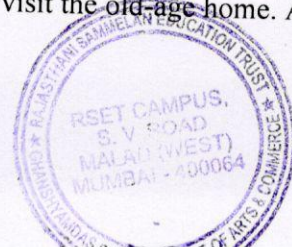
### **Ground Work:-**


7. Chairperson circulate the guidelines and asked Participants to follow the same:

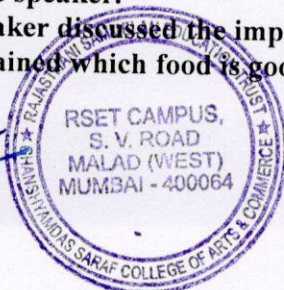
### Ground Work:-

### Ground Work:-



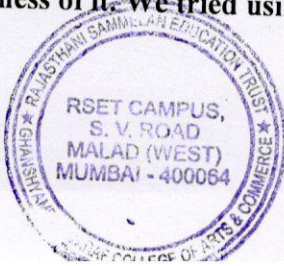
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1. So this events idea came to us through social media.
2. Basically when we went through this idea we thought it would be helpful for these idol makers as they don't have much social reach.
3. It was just 3 days from ganpati festival that, we thought of doing this project.
4. Firstly we asked and confirmed if any of our directors could go out and help us. Since many of them were ready to do so, we asked them to go and check out those karkhanas who are really in need.
6. Once we got confirmation, we ask the directors to go and take video, and ask them the problem's they are facing due to pandemic. It was more of a survey.
7. Then once we received all the video's we asked someone to just edit them as per the need, and make a good video with basic information of those idol makers.
8. In all we were able to collect 8 genuine video. Then we managed to do all this in just a span of 24hrs.
9. Once everything was done we asked our digicom to prepare the awareness jpegs as people should get to know what exactly had happened in the video.
10. Then next day itself we posted those videos on all our social media handles as well as spread it to all our contacts.

#### Summary:-

- 1: On the day of event, we posted all the videos of all idols maker ,which we took. In caption we mentioned that idols maker name, address, shop name, so people can also contact them directly of through us.
2. We posted a 3 Awareness related jpeg also on our instagram page of @rcgsc.
3. In first jpeg we mentioned that what are the problems faced by idols makers like, 1. Low sale of idols as due to pandemic  
2 Shortages of basic households needs due to big family size. Not ready for this situation (covid19) as it was truly unexpected.
4. In second jpeg, we talked about solution of this problem like 1. Do not take too much discount from them, rather buy at the price they sale as already those are low. Secondly all you need to do is when you go to bring ganesh murti on 22nd Feb morning try providing some sort of assistance like either give extra money or some daily food items required by them
- 3 aware others also about this initiative and take a pledge to be a part of this initiative
5. In third jpeg we mentioned the donation kit details-Atta 10 kg, rice 2.5 kg,dal 2kg ,oil 1liter, just because those who are not able to go out and donate so contact us and we mentioned the google pay number also.
6. We share the pr msg in various rotaract group, and told them to visit our club page of @rcgsc and make awareness of it. We tried using all our social media handles as well as our contacts to spread awareness.

**Aim/Concept:-**

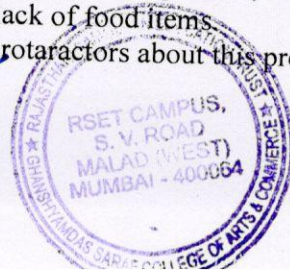
1. The Aim of this project was to spend some time with the Orphanage children's & celebrate this Independence Day together with maintaining social distance.

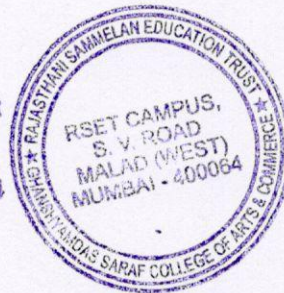


8. We circulated the PR message and JPEG in rotaract groups and created a WhatsApp group.
9. On the day of Independence we forwarded a Zoom link in the WhatsApp group that we have created so that Rotaractors can join and enjoy the event.

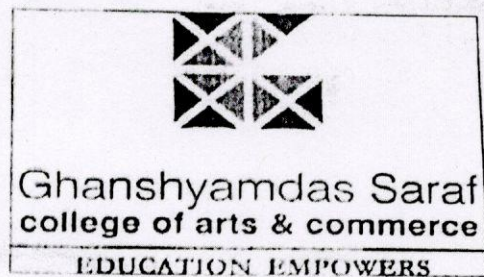
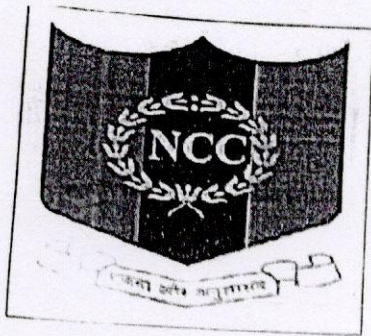
**Summary:-**



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
