

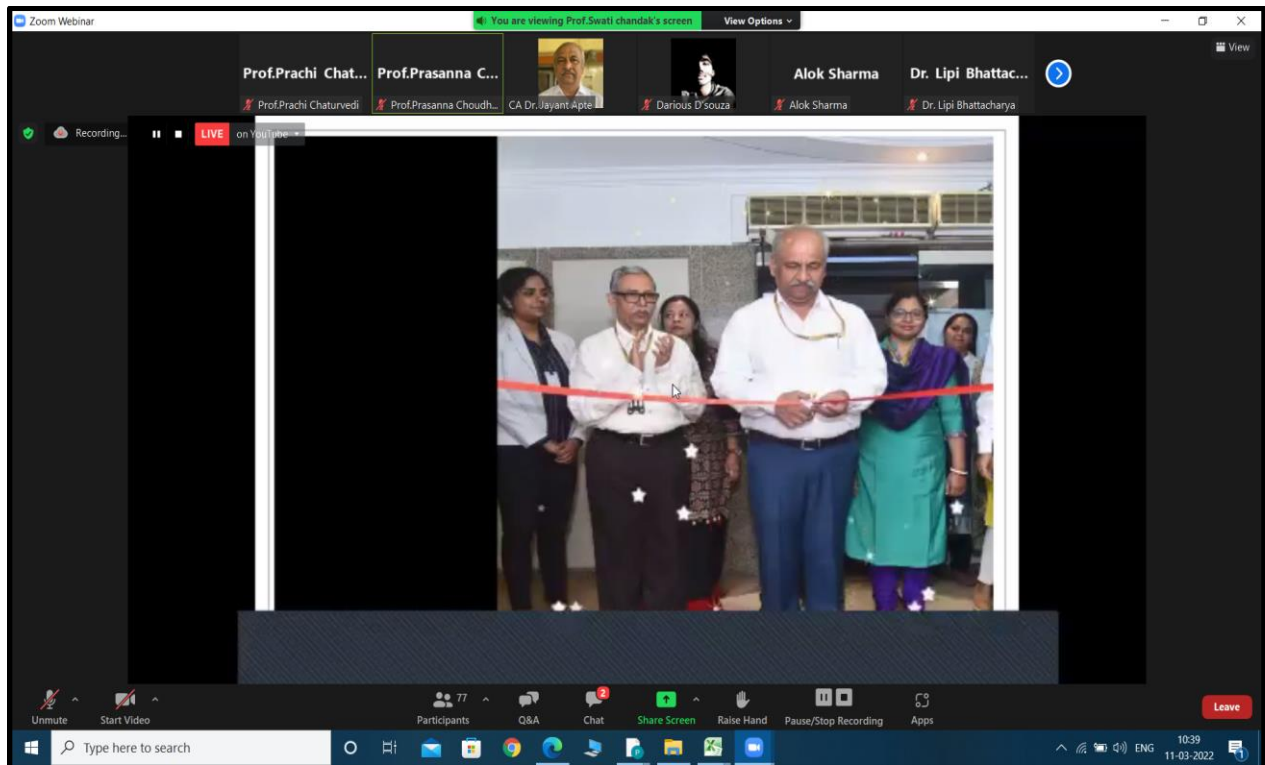

**Pic1:-Inauguration Done by Principal Dr.Jayant Apte**

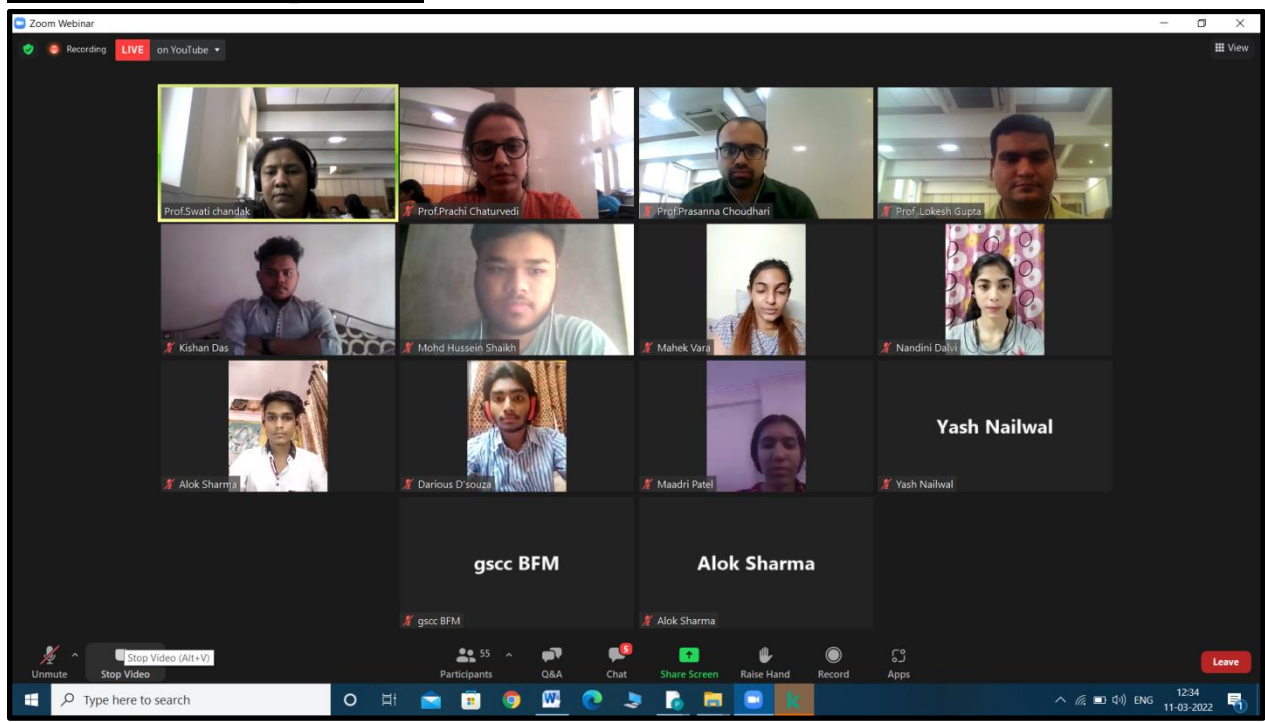


**Pic 2:-Presentation by Group**

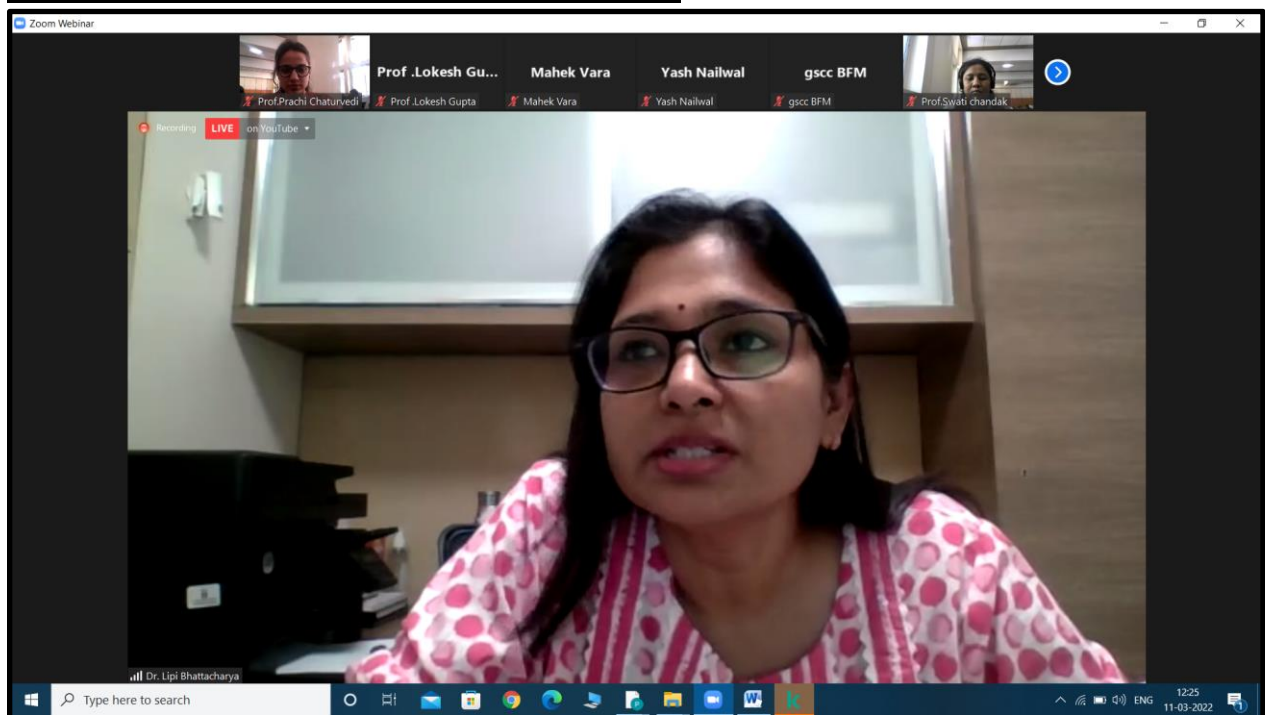

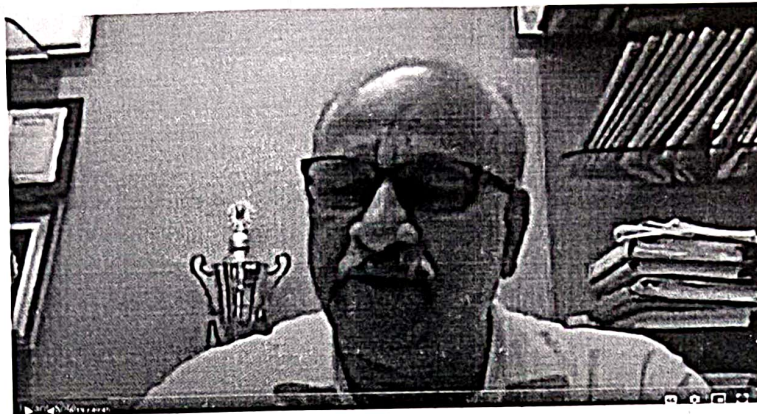
### **Conclusion**

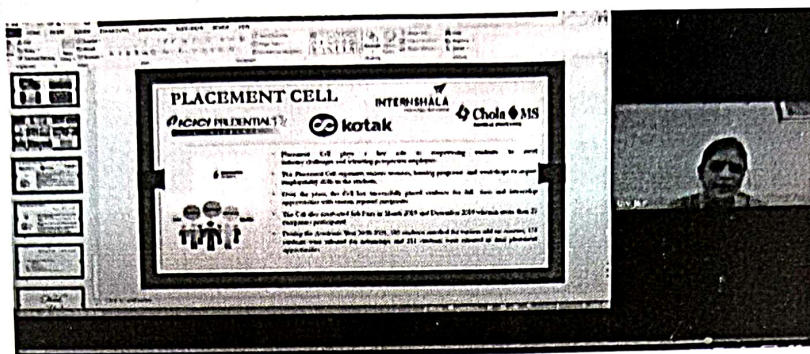
