REPORT ON PTVAIM'S COEI & GSCC MOU

This MoU, signed outlines a partnership between PTVAIM's Centre of Entrepreneurship & Innovation (COEI) and Ghanshyamdas Saraf College of Arts & Commerce (GSCC).

Key Points:

• Parties Involved:

- **COEI**: Promoted by PTVAIM's Institute of Management, focused on creating an ecosystem for innovation and entrepreneurship.
- o **GSCC**: An educational institution offering undergraduate and postgraduate courses affiliated with the University of Mumbai.

Purpose:

- GSCC will allow its students and faculty to participate in entrepreneurial activities organized by COEI, including programs like Pre-Incubation and the "Wings2Vision" business plan competition.
- GSCC will provide faculty members as mentors and allow participants access to COEI workshops and seminars.
- Winning teams from GSCC in the Wings2Vision competition may use COEI facilities to further develop their business plans.

· Terms:

- o GSCC will help promote COEI's entrepreneurial programs and share student contact details for activity participation (confidentiality will be maintained).
- o COEI will provide workshops and certificates to GSCC students and faculty.
- o COEI retains full control over any contracts signed by winning student teams.

• Duration:

The MoU was effective from the signing date until **November 24, 2022**, with possible extensions at COEI's discretion.

This MoU solidifies the collaboration between COEI and GSCC to promote entrepreneurship and innovation through various programs and support mechanisms.

During the period of MOU various activities and workshops like orientation on Entrepreneurship, Market research in entrepreneurship, Participation in Business Plan organised by PTVA were handled.
