Certificate and Diploma Courses by Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) under National University Students Skill Development (NUSSD)

Placement Cell tied up with Tata Institute of Social Sciences for running various certificate and diploma courses for students under National University Students Skill Development (NUSSD). These Programs are aimed at improving employability skills of the students and have been declared as "Skill Development Best Practice" in the country by United Nations Steering Committee on Children and Youth. These courses are offered free of cost to the students belonging to weaker financial background. Diploma Courses meant for TY and M.Com students will have 300 to 360 hours of Domain Specialization Training. 100 hours of Soft Skill Training, 60 hours of Pre Placement Training and 480 to 600 hours of Internship or Project Work. Certificate Course meant for SY students will have 300 hours of classroom training and 100 hours of Fieldwork/Project.

<u>Batch 1 - TY and M.Com Students - Diploma in Banking and Financial Services</u>/ <u>Diploma in Digital Marketing</u>

Orientation Session by TISS to inform the students about Free of Cost Trainings under National University Students' Skill Development Programme (NUSSD) was conducted virtually on Zoom on September 29, 2020 from 3:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The message to inform the students about Orientation was sent in Whats App Group of SY and TY Students on September 28, 2020. Mr. Tanmay Naik, Director NUSSD addressed the students and highlighted the importance of such Training Programs. He also oriented the students about details of the Programme and the enrolment procedure for the same. After the orientation, group of interested students was created on October 8, 2020. Around 90 students joined the group. Employability skills test to enroll the students for NUSSD Programme was conducted on October 24 at 4 p.m. and October 26, 2020 at 3 p.m. virtually on Zoom. The same was informed to the interested students in the Whats App group. After the Orientation and Employability Test, First Batch was formed and training sessions started from October 27, 2020 for Diploma in Banking and Financial Services and Diploma in Digital Marketing. 50 students enrolled for Diploma in Banking and Financial Services and 2 students enrolled for Diploma in Digital Marketing.

Placement Cell collaborated with Anudip Foundation to offer free of cost training program named Certificate in English Communication and Digital Education with Excel Specialization to the graduate and M.COM students of AY 2019-20. This Project was funded by Bank of America and implemented by Anudip Foundation. The duration of the course was around 170 hours and it trained the students on Workplace Readiness, Communicative English, Digital Literacy, MOS Excel Specialization, Financial Literacy. The training was conducted online on Google Meet and access was given of LMS App for self-study. After the completion of training program, students were offered placement opportunities. Placement Team circulated the message in Whats App Group of TY and M. Com students of AY 2019-20 on August 20, 2020 to inform them about the Free of Program offered by Anudio Foundation. Interested students were asked to join a separate whats app group for this purpose. More than 300 students joined the group. Orientation Session was conducted on August 25, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. on Google Meet. The session was addressed by Mr. Joshua D Souza from Anudip Foundation. He guided the students to identify their interests and what they are good at. He also advised them to plan multiple activities during their vacations to identify their skills and informed how the training program offered by Anudip Foundation can help them. The orientation was attended by 102 students. After the orientation, interested students were asked to register for the program by submission of documents between August 26, 2020 till September 3, 2020. A total of 151 students registered for the program and they were split into four batches as mentioned below:

Batch 1 – B. Com Students – Training started on October 18, 2020 and completed on January 20, 2021. 40 students enrolled and 34 students completed the training.

Batch 2 – B. Com Students – Training started on October 10, 2020 and completed on February 26, 2021. 39 students enrolled and 31 students completed the training.

Batch 3 – Self Finance Students - Training started on October 27, 2020 and Completed on January 28, 2021. 38 students enrolled and 24 completed the training.

Batch 4 – M. Com Students - Training started on October 31, 2020 and completed on February 2, 2021. 34 students enrolled and 27 completed the training.







The best part of the event was in spite of being an online there were no technical glitches experienced.





India is witnessing a steady rise in the start-up culture as people are willing to consider occupations other than traditional professions. Keeping this in mind, the webinar focused on providing knowledge about entrepreneurship as the new business culture in India. On the occasion of International Women's Day, the webinar highlighted the success stories of several women entrepreneurs who have managed to create a path for themselves.

We were glad to have Mrs. Meenal Mohadikar as the resource person for the webinar. Mrs. Mohadikar is a first-generation entrepreneur herself, and the founder of 'Aamhi Udyogini Pratishthan' (We Entrepreneurs)- a forum that guides and supports the ideas of women entrepreneurs of Maharashtra with centers in the State, Goa and the UAE. She also started 'Anand Trade Development Services' which organizes trade exhibitions by the name 'Consumers' Shoppee' all over Maharashtra.

The webinar began with welcoming of all the panelists and participants and a formal welcome by Principal, Dr. Jayant Apte. Dr. Mmahek Chhabria introduced the topic of the day and Prof. Prajna Shetty introduced the speaker.

Mrs. Mohadikar began her talk by giving a brief introduction of her Forum, 'Aamhi Udyogini' and its journey in mentoring women entrepreneurs over the years in the form of capital, collaborations through people and workshops, and using government policies. A veteran in the field of entrepreneurship, she also shared her

experiences, successes and challenges faced as a first-generation entrepreneur in the family.

The speaker emphasized on the role of government schemes in realizing one's career as an entrepreneur. She aimed at the importance of understanding these schemes and the benefits that can be reaped from them. Mrs. Mohadikar focused on the 'Mudra Scheme' under 'Chief Minister Rozgaar Yojana' that has benefitted many budding entrepreneurs. After discussing in detail about the workings of the scheme and its benefits for entrepreneurs, she highlighted the importance of uniqueness of an idea. With her quote that 'idea is currency', she expressed that an idea would only sell if it were unique. The distinctiveness of an idea and its relevance in a particular place and culture, would ensure its sales and success.

Mrs. Meenal, then discussed success stories of several women entrepreneurs who came up with unique ideas and innovation in various fields like technology, pharmaceutical industry, and food industry. She stressed on the importance of exploring uniqueness in an idea, and systematically working on materializing it. Lastly, the speaker laid importance on timely expert guidance and support, and right mentoring especially for students who aspire to step into the start-up culture. Mrs. Mohadikar also runs a YouTube channel, the link of which she was willing to share with our students for guidance.

The concluding remarks on the talk were given by Dr. Lipi Mukherjee who thanked Mrs. Mohadikar for discussing her first-hand experience in the field of entrepreneurship and steering budding entrepreneurs in the right direction. 




