- During the year 2021-2022, 152 students completed the training and 121 out of these are placed.

- A total of 128 students completed the training and 52 students were placed

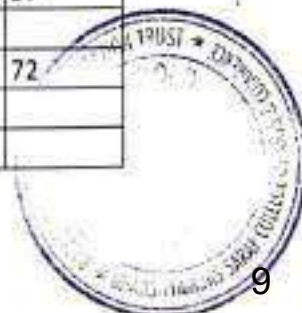

Certificate Course by Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) – Pragati – Building Capacities

- Placement Cell tied up with Tata Institute of Social Sciences for offering Certificate Course – **Pragati – Building Capacities to the FY students.**
- The course is aimed at improving employability skills of the students and will be taught by corporate volunteers from JP Morgan, TISS Faculty etc.
- Course duration is 30 hours.
- The course trained the students on the following areas - Effective Communication, Career Planning and Goal setting, Positive attitude and Self-confidence, Creative thinking & Problem Solving, Resume and Interview Preparation, Stay Ahead in Group Discussions, Writing Effective Emails, Learn Corporate Telephone Etiquette, Importance of logical thinking, Introduction to the digital world, Benefits and Dangers of Social Networking Platform, Understanding Artificial Intelligence, Orientation to 6 Thinking Hats – Tool for group thinking, creative and decision making, Personal Health, Hygiene, and Grooming etc.
- Session will be conducted alternatively on Zoom on Monday, Wednesday from 4 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
- The orientation session was conducted on September 29, 2021 on Zoom. Students were informed about the orientation session through official whats app groups on September 28, 2021.
- Prof. Mamta Chhajjar along with other members of Placement Cell Dr. Anju Bohra, Prof. Swati Chandak, Prof. Mehrab Khan and Prof. Sangeeta Sahoo conducted the orientation and explained the details of the course and the procedure of enrolment. It was attended by 288 students.
- After the Orientation, interested students were asked to register by filling google form and joining a separate whats app group.

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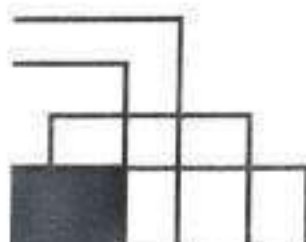

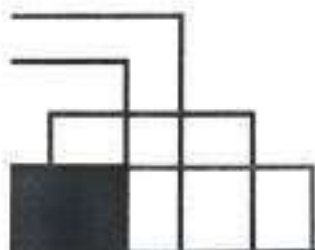

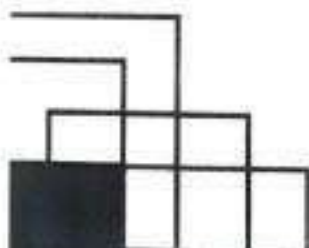

- The session was attended by 81 students.



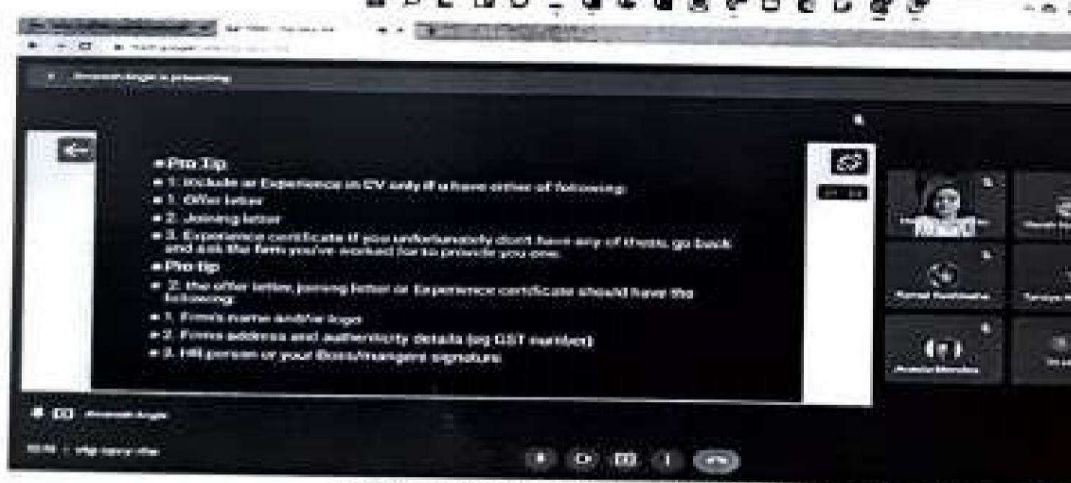

The speakers made the session very interactive by involving the participants and giving some facts of interview in between.

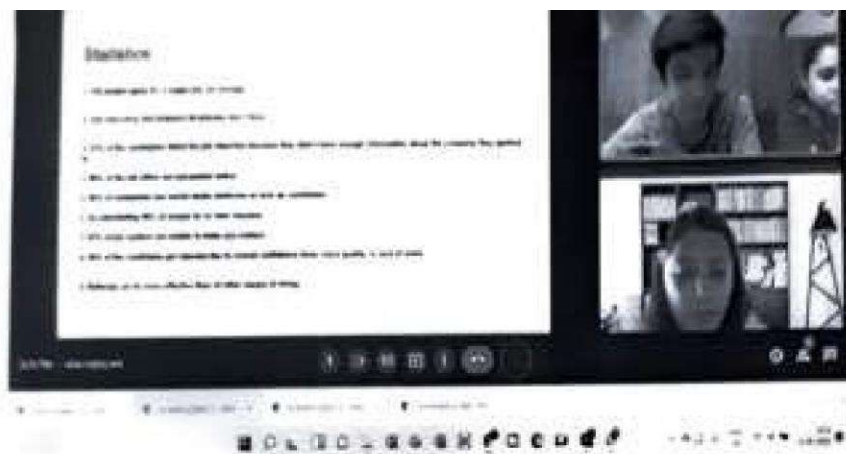

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Course on Employability Skills for SY and TY students by a leading corporate

Placement Cell tied up with a leading corporate house to offer 22 days employability skills building course to the SY and TY students of special income category.

The course trained the students on following aspects: Sharpening your speaking skills, Sharpening your reading skills, Sharpening your writing skills/ generic email, Goal Setting, Embracing Failures, Building Confidence, Time Management, Managing Workplace Stress (including virtual), "The Logical mind / Creative / Out of Box thinking", Cyber Security, Climate Change and its impact, Human rights / Rights at work place, Good Saving Habits + Managing Debts, Insurance, Diversity / Inclusion, Social, Behavioral, Workplace Etiquettes, Bio data / Resume, Tips for Interviews, Tips on starting your own Enterprise etc.

All the sessions were conducted by industry experts once a week every Friday for TY students and every Thursday for SY students.

How was the Project carried out?

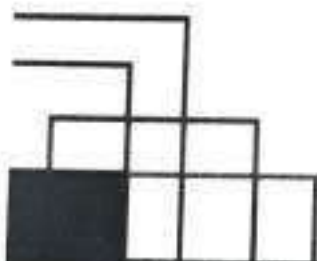


Pre Event:

Ms.Kiran Shah gave hands-on training on yoga asanas, pranayam, breathing and concentration techniques for students and faculty.


Ms.RashiModi explained about meditation techniques that can help in achieving a clear mind and attain inner peace and calm.

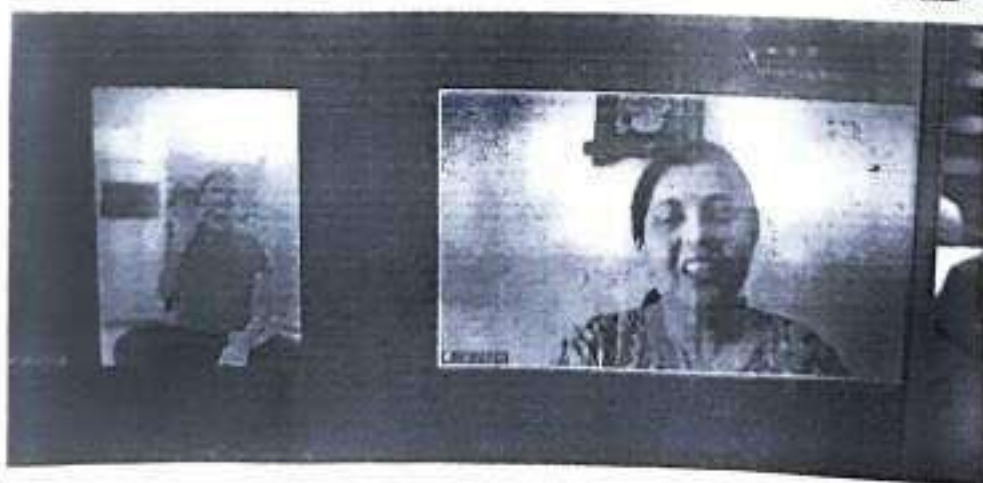

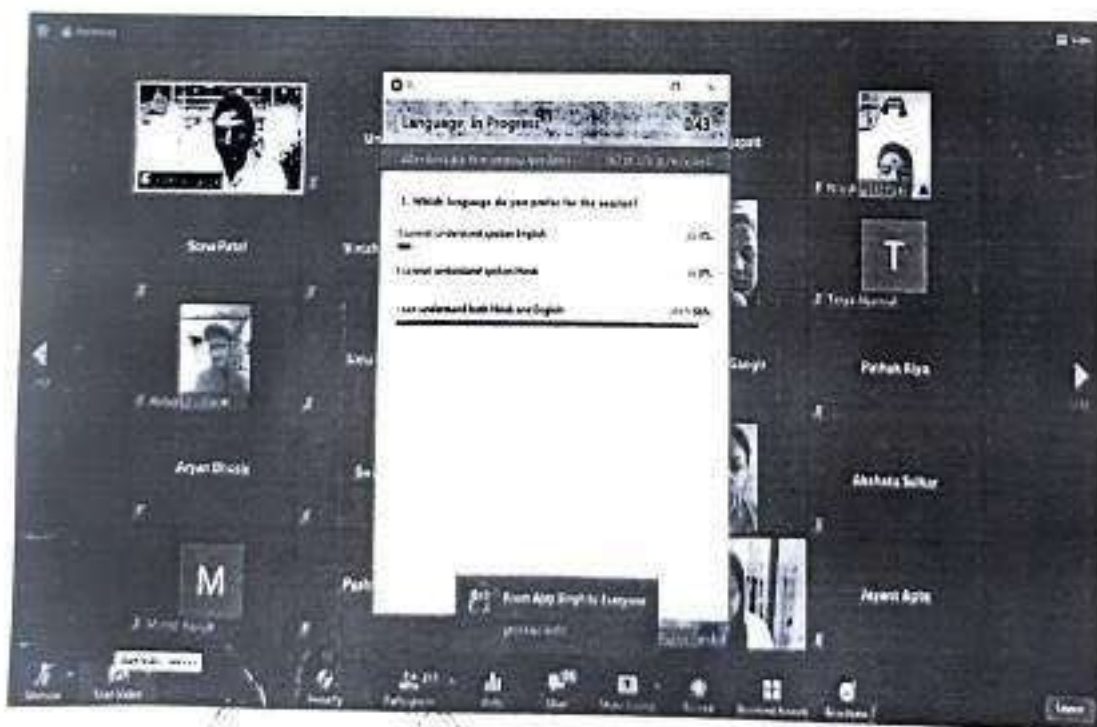

Good nutrition and hygiene are the markers of a healthy body and mind. In the time of a global pandemic as this, it is necessary that we all realize the significant role of diet, exercise and proper hygiene in ensuring our wellbeing. The theme of the webinar was chosen, keeping in mind the need of the hour- to spread awareness about healthy regimens, and to educate girls about menstrual hygiene.

The webinar began with an introduction by Prof. Charmie Dalal who welcomed the speaker and the attendees. The formal welcome address and introduction of the speaker was given by Dr. Mmahek Chhabria, Convenor of the Women Development Cell of the College who remarked on the need to educate young girls about healthy diet and hygiene practices. The resource person for the webinar was Dr. Anuja Vaidya, a practicing nutritionist and family physician from Mumbai.

Dr. Anuja, in her brief presentation, elaborated on the importance of maintaining a healthy diet and exercise regimen for overall mental and physical wellbeing. She emphasized on following a scientific diet plan issued by a practitioner rather than falling prey to eating disorders like anorexia and bulimia. These eating anomalies, she highlighted, pose a greater, long-term risk to health and one's self esteem. As a nutritionist, Dr. Vaidya gave handy tips like choosing organic, home-cooked food over ready-to-eat, packet foods, and to include fresh fruits, vegetables, and nuts to make a wholesome meal.

Dr. Vaidya focused on the importance of maintaining good personal hygiene, especially during menstruation. She briefed the students on choosing hygiene products that are eco-friendly, and authorized by doctors. Being a family physician, she also stressed that good hygiene and nutrition together, go a long way in determining a person's overall health.

The speaker's presentation was followed by interactive session where students asked different queries regarding ovarian disorders, cervical cancer, diet, exercise practices. Dr. Vaidya addressed these questions and highlighted on the need to discipline one's mind and body by following healthy diet regimens.

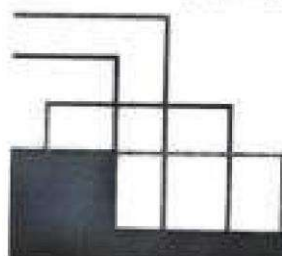

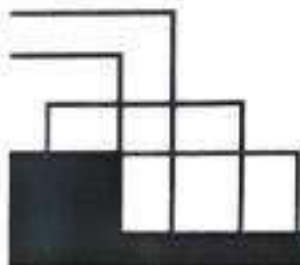

3. All the participants loved the session and were able to know how to deal with mental illness.



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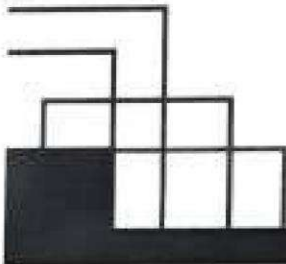

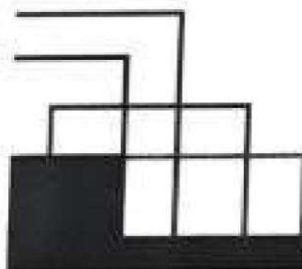
Summary:

- The collaboration was confirmed, and the dates were suggested by the organization.
- The creatives, PR Message and MOU was sent by the organization, which was later approved and signed by Rtr. Heet Sardhara, President 20-21 after giving a thorough glance at the planning of the boot camp

Execution

- A call for a collaborator message was sent out to different Rotaract Clubs to collaborate for this event.
- Around a total of 6 clubs agreed for the collaboration.

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introducing and thanking the collaborators of RCMHV followed by a brief introduction about RCMHV by Rtr. Aayushi Shah.

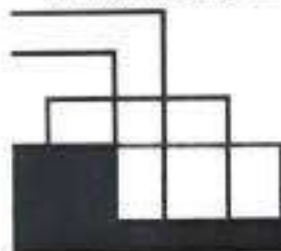

We are living in an age where information and communication technology is vastly influencing our daily interaction with the people around us. Understanding this, the webinar was organized for students to make them aware of various threats and malpractices that prevail in the virtual world when they use various social media platforms for day-to-day communication.

On account of International Women's Day, a special initiative was taken to organize a webinar on the responsible use of information and communication technology for all students. The highlight of the webinar was to introduce different ways in which internet and social media are central to communication, but also vulnerable to cybercrimes. It is this point that prevailed the one-hour session where students were made aware of various ways in which their security can be compromised in the virtual space.

We were glad to have Mr. Tushar Bhagat as the resource person for the webinar. Mr. Tushar belongs to the nation's first non-profit project 'Responsible Netism' that undertakes workshops and talks with educational institutions on ethical use of internet and technology.

The webinar began with a formal welcome of the speaker, all the panelists and the participants by Dr. Mriahel Chhabria, Convenor, Women Development Cell of the College.



ushar began his session by giving a brief introduction of their project 'Responsible Netism' and the relevance of the webinar topic in times of rising instances of cybercrimes.

The speaker emphasized on the need for transparent communication between students and trusted adults (parents, teachers) to ensure the safety of all young users of technology, both online and offline. Mr. Bhagat gave an elaborate description along with case studies on various cybercrimes like- creation of fake profiles, hacking of social media accounts, cyber stalking, morphing of photographs, cyber bullying, trolling, financial frauds, and cyber terrorism.

In his comprehensive presentation, Mr. Bhagat covered all the malpractices that jeopardize the safety of users' pictures, videos, and other personal details uploaded on social media. The speaker also spoke on digital addiction which may result in the rise of anxiety, self-doubt, a sense of low self-esteem, and a constant need of external validation.

The topics discussed came out to be very relatable, especially given the rise in the use of digital platforms for education and communication during the pandemic. Mr. Bhagat also highlighted the dangers of youth getting socially disconnected owing to the overuse and overdependence of social media for communication instead of personal, face-to-face interaction with their family and peers.

The speaker concluded his session by emphasizing the need to realize the threats along with the uses of being on social media platforms. The threats, he said can be neutralized by upgrading privacy settings and knowing responsible use of information and communication technology. This was followed by the questions and answer session where the speaker addressed various concerns of the participants from cyber bullying to cyber stalking.

The speaker's comprehensive presentation and enthusiastic oration made the webinar a great success among the participants. The formal vote of thanks was proposed by Prof. Namrata Pathak for shedding light on the topic that is so relevant and useful for today's youth. The feedback received from the participants was very encouraging and appreciative.
