CFX is a 250 hours course in which the students are trained in theoretical and practical aspects of financial markets such as capital markets, mutual funds, life insurance, health insurance, financial planning etc. along with behavioural skills and selling skills to make them job ready.

Each concept is explained with the help of case studies and real-life examples to facilitate an application-based learning.

The course is intended to provide 100% placement assistance to the students with corporate alliance partners of FinX viz Aegon Life Insurance, Andromeda Sales & Distribution, Bajaj Capital, Future Generali India Insurance, IndiaFirst Life Insurance, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Max Bupa Health Insurance, Max Life Insurance, RBL Bank, Reliance General Insurance, Reliance Life Insurance, Reliance Securities, Religare Health Insurance, Star Union Dai-ichi Life Insurance & TATA AIG General Insurance etc.
