

- 7. Start quick and fail fast


He also spoke about known risk and unknown risk. He shared some great books for the students to add value to their knowledge.



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





- The speaker of the webinar was Mr. Navneet Anand a retail banker, currently the MBA head of Career launcher.



- Brig. Ajit Srivastava Sir also shared a few experiences and videos to help us understand better.



All the students received participation certificate, and one online quiz was also scheduled after the program on February 10, 2022. All the students who passed received passing certification also.








CMA Binoy Thomas explaining the opportunities of CMA course to the attendees






