SEEKING GRANTS FROM GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.

Minutes of the workshop conducted by the IQAC & Research Cell of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College in the Learning Centre on Saturday, 04th November, 2023 at 11.30 am to discuss the following:

AGENDA

- 1. To get two ideas minimum patented.
- 2. To apply for grants for projects from each department every month.
- 3. Every department should apply for grants for conducting seminars/ Conferences.
- 4. Receiving grants from Government agencies and more importantly the certificates is highly significant for NAAC.
- 5. The Agencies providing grants for projects based Social Sciences was highlighted.
- 6. Internships for students was given due focus.
- 7. Placement of students in foreign countries was also given due attention.

MINUTES

- Introduction and Welcome: The session began with a warm welcome to Dr. Anant Ram, the resource person, and all the participants.
- Types of Grants: Dr. Anant Ram explained various types of grants, such as Research
 Grants, Travel Grants, Seminar/Conference Grants, and International Grants. He also
 discussed the significance of awards and recognition, as well as the importance of
 obtaining patents.

- Role of Government Grants: Government grants play a vital role in funding scientific
 and academic research in various fields. They offer financial support to individuals,
 institutions, and organizations involved in research.
- Awareness of Grant Process: The session aimed to make faculty members aware of the
 complexities involved in securing grants, including the details about different agencies
 offering grants and the amount of funding available.
 - Eligibility Criteria and Process: Dr. Anant Ram emphasized the importance of faculty
 members actively contributing to their personal growth. This included involvement in
 professional organizations, publishing research papers/books, participating in seminars
 and conferences, and applying for patents to demonstrate their commitment to research.
 - Preparing for a Grant Application: Participants were advised to define the scope and
 objectives of their research project before applying for a grant. They were encouraged to
 develop a well-structured research proposal that included a research plan, methodology,
 budget, and expected outcomes. Detailed budgeting for research equipment, personnel,
 and other project-related expenses was also stressed.
 - Future Assistance: Dr. Anant Ram offered to help teachers identify suitable grant opportunities for their research proposals in the next meeting.
 - Q&A Session: The session concluded with participants having the opportunity to ask
 questions and seek clarification on various aspects of securing government grants.
 - Follow-Up Meetings: Dr. Anant Ram suggested conducting Zoom meetings to further discuss improvements in research areas, indicating ongoing support and collaboration.
 - Interactive and Enlightening Workshop: Overall, the workshop was described as
 interactive and enlightening, helping faculty members understand the competitive nature
 of acquiring government grants for research.

The session provided a comprehensive overview of the grant-seeking process and the importance of active involvement in the research community, setting participants on a path toward successful grant applications and academic growth.



Modern Trends and Approaches in Education & Research Viz- A- Viz the Changing Landscape in Global Economy

Introduction

With the globe growing more interconnected and technologically advanced, educational systems are adjusting to meet the opportunities and difficulties of the twenty-first century. Technology integration in the classroom is now essential. Particularly during the epidemic, the popularity of virtual classrooms, educational software, and online learning platforms has increased.

Global citizenship and cultural competency are becoming more and more important subjects in education as businesses and organizations become more global in scope. The focus of the global economy is shifting to environmental issues and sustainability. In response, the educational system is encouraging pupils to be environmentally sensitive and incorporating sustainability into the curriculum. The conference aimed to determine the necessity for sustainable development as well as any modern trends or approaches in the education sector in light of this most recent shift.

The Program
