# ANNUAL REPORT

The school re-opened after the summer vacations and the teachers joined from 9th June. Principal asked the teachers to plan the curriculum keeping in mind the NEP, especially in Std. I & she also said that special emphasis on academics has to be given to Std. V and Std. VIII. Std. X students joined the school on 9th June. Class- test was conducted for Std. X students for the portion done during the extra classes in April. A teacher enrichment session was conducted by Sr. Neerja, on 10th June. The topic was "Integrating values in workplace". The session focused on integrating values at workplace that involves embedding them into daily operations, communication, and decision-making to create a culture where values are not just words but a guiding principle. शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में टेक्नोलॉजी ने विद्यार्थियों को नई ऊँचाइयाँ दी हैं। ऑनलाइन कक्षाएँ, डिजिटल पुस्तकालय, और इंटरएक्टिव लर्निंग टूल्स ने ज्ञान को सुलभ और रोचक बना दिया है। अब गाँव का बच्चा भी विश्वस्तरीय शिक्षा प्राप्त कर सकता है- यह टेक्नोलॉजी की ही देन है।

चिकित्सा में भी इसका प्रभाव अद्भुत है। आधुनिक मशीनें, और डेटा विश्लेषण के माध्यम से रोगों का जल्दी पता लगाना और उनका उपचार संभव हो पाया है। टेक्नोलॉजी ने जीवन को सुरक्षित और दीर्घायु बनाने में अहम भूमिका निभाई है।

हालाँकि, टेक्नोलॉजी के साथ कुछ चुनौतियाँ भी जुड़ी हैं- जैसे साइबर अपराध, गोपनीयता का हनन, और सामाजिक दूरी। लेकिन यदि इसका उपयोग विवेकपूर्ण ढंग से किया जाए, तो यह मानवता के लिए वरदान सिद्ध हो सकती है।

अंततः, टेक्नोलॉजी केवल मशीनों का संग्रह नहीं, यह मानव बुद्धि की उड़ान है। यह वह शक्ति है जो हमें भविष्य की ओर ले जाती है - जहाँ हर समस्या का समाधान विज्ञान के आलोक में संभव है। हमें इसे समझदारी से अपनाना चाहिए, ताकि यह विकास का साधन बने, विनाश का कारण नहीं।
