



Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Rabindranath Tagore University, Bhopal (MP)

And

**Ladhidevi Ramdhar Maheshwari Night College of Commerce, Mumbai
Maharashtra**

This memorandum of understanding (here in after called as the 'MOU') is entered in to on this the (Date.....), by and between Rabindranath Tagore University, Bhopal (Here in after first party) and Ladhidevi Ramdhar Maheshwari Night College of Commerce, Mumbai (Here in after is called second party).

Whereas

Rabindranath Tagore University (formerly known as AISECT University) Madhya Pradesh's first private University, established in 2010, is a leading skill-based university of central India. The University was established by India's leading education and skills organization, ALL INDIA SOCIETY FOR ELECTRONICS AND COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY (AISECT), which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors in office and assigns, herein after referred to as Second Party. The University is running programmes in faculties in the field of Engineering, Education, Management, Law, Information Technology, Arts, Science, Commerce, Nursing and Paramedical. The University is recognized by UGC and member of AIU and ACU. The University institutes got approvals from AICTE, NCTE, BCI, INC and Paramedical Council of Madhya Pradesh, accredited by NAAC and secured position in NIRF ranking.

And

Ladhidevi Ramdhar Maheshwari Night College of Commerce was established in June 2014, is affiliated to the University of Mumbai. The evening college for commerce houses more than 1100 students. It has qualified and experienced faculty. It is located on 6th floor of Ghanshyamdas Saraf College of Arts and Commerce. The institution offers three-year Bachelor of Commerce Degree program. The objective of the institution is to provide good education to all the students who are working during daytime and want to study in the evening. The institution is making an attempt to live up to its Motto – "Enlightening Future" by not only providing them with good Academic Environment, but also by providing them with ample number of platforms in the form of various Competitions to showcase their Co-Curricular Talent, which helps in shaping of a student's personality.

Objective-

The purpose of this MoU is to undertake training programs, Skill development programs, to conduct short term courses and joint research, site visits and development of all such programs which will benefit students and teachers of both the Universities.

Note- For all the below mentioned points whenever required a formal document will be draft after a mutual understanding and permission from the authorities.

Article 1. Scope of MOU

Faculty Exchange –

- The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutions.
- Collaboration in Teaching, research and development and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic materials and publications.
- Conducting Lectures.
- Undertaking joint research.
- Attachment of staff purpose of curriculum/content development and review, upgrading of teaching and research skills.
- Participating in seminars, workshops, conferences, symposiums and other types of academic discussions.
- Conducting joint consultancy work

Specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or such exchange including those concerning monetary implications will be worked out between the institutes. A Separate agreement will be entered as per requirements.

Student Exchange

A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host intuition refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study and research (mutually agreed upon in advance).

Rabindranath Tagore University and Ladhidevi Ramdhar Maheshwari Night College of Commerce agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below:

- Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- Since the host and home institution is within the same city, travel and food arrangements during the events can be made by the host institution on prior information.

c. Placements

- To exchange information on fairs pertaining to placement, training on placements and placement drives.
- To jointly organize placement drives.

d. Skill Development Programs

- I. To exchange information on Skill development programmes.
- II. To jointly organize short term Skill Development Programmes and to invite each other's students to participate therein.

e. Entrepreneurial Activities

- I. To exchange information on **Entrepreneurial Activities**
- II. To jointly organize **Entrepreneurial workshops** and training activities and to invite each other's students to participate therein.
- III. To promote and encourage students' entrepreneurs.

f. Other areas

- I. To propose and engage jointly in research or training program sponsored by funding agencies and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- II. The provision of culture and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes.
- III. To use laboratory facilities in specific cases with prior information.
- IV. To permit students, staff and faculty members to use library facility.

Article 2. Representation and Coordination:

Each Party shall appoint a duly authorized representative to act on its behalf for the purposes of this Agreement. The Parties shall promptly notify each other of the appointment of their respective representatives/coordinators. The representatives shall be responsible for coordinating and communicating between the Parties regarding all matters relating to this MOU.

Article 3. Validity

The memorandum shall remain in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

Article 4. Termination

- This MOU may be terminated by the First Party or by the Second Party giving to the other not less than 30 days' notice in writing.
- The Second Party will not at any time after the Termination Date represent her or himself as being in any way still connected with the First Party.

Article 5. Amendments/Modification

This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutions.

Article 6. Adherence to Laws

Participating faculties, Staff and students involved in any activities under this memorandum must adhere to the law of the country and rules and regulations of the institutions.

Article 7. Legal Effects

Nothing in this memorandum shall be constructed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.
