

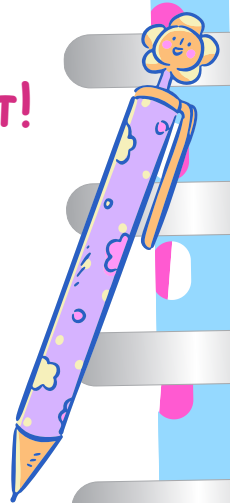


# RBHS NEWSLETTER

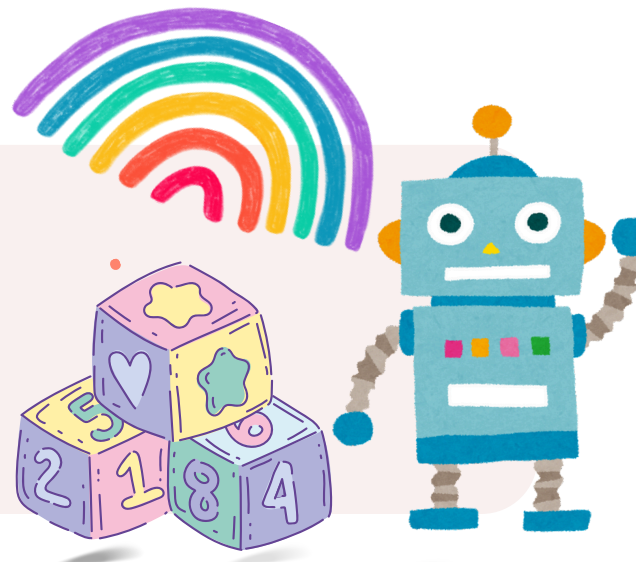
## STORYTELLING COMPETITION – BRINGING STORIES TO LIFE!

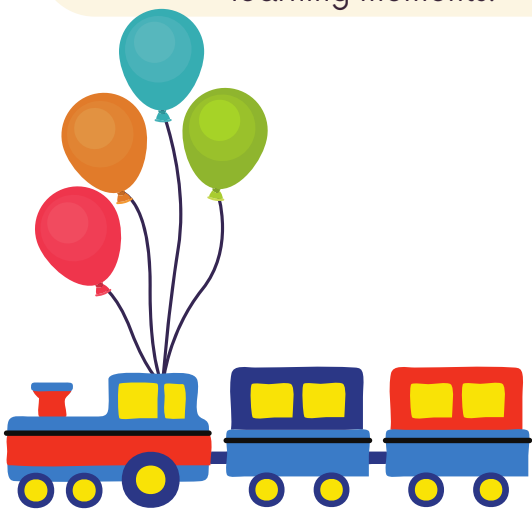


## EXCITING METRO RIDE – A FUN LEARNING EXPERIENCE!

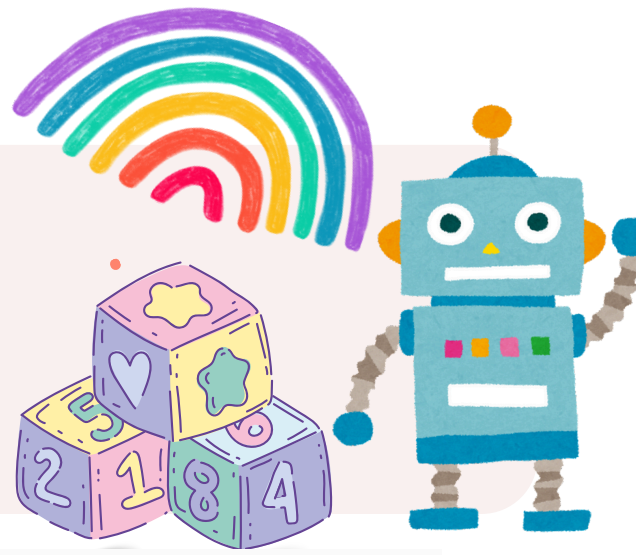
## GAME-BASED LEARNING: FUN WITH CARROM!

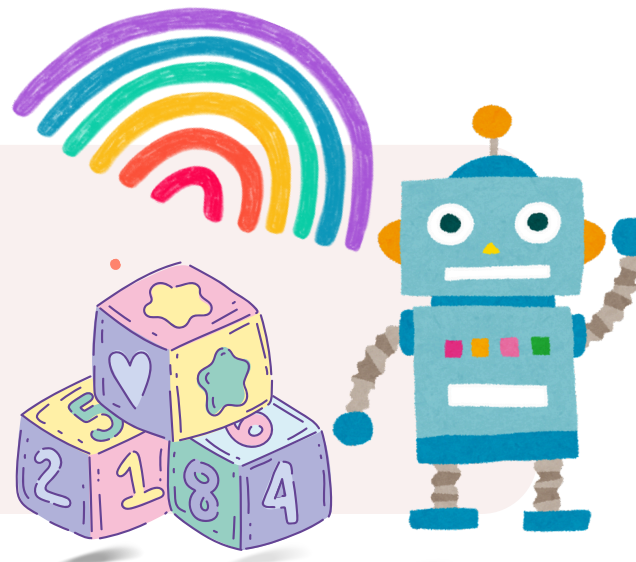
## FUN-FILLED FREE PLAY!

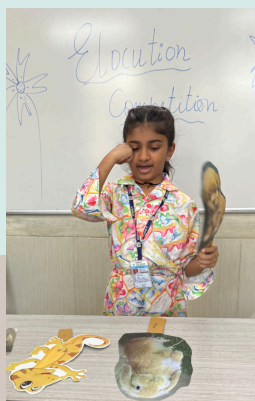
