Am I a Perfect Parent?

Honestly being a Perfect Parent is an illusion. In the guise of being a 'perfect' parent we often compromise on our values and ideals.

Parenting is a continuous journey where you learn along the way and one which has no retirement age! Parents are empowered when they exchange tips with other parents or rest a dejected head on a comforting shoulder.

I have put together some points – a few from my 25 years parental experience and some borrowed from others.

1. Listen to your child's thoughts and feelings not just their words.
2. Celebrate effort, not just achievement. Why should social media posts be only about achievements and not about how much effort they have put in?
3. Be clear about the rules and be consistent about them.
4. Lead by Example - so maybe you stop scrolling first and pick up a book before you ask them to do so.
5. Encourage Independence – let them try, fail and learn
6. Foster Curiosity and Growth – encourage exploration and interests, even if they are different from yours.
7. Communicate openly and do not be judgemental
8. Practice Patience because children test our limits
9. Balance Screen Time and Real Time
10. Work on Yourself Too – be self-aware, calm and unafraid to apologise when you are wrong.

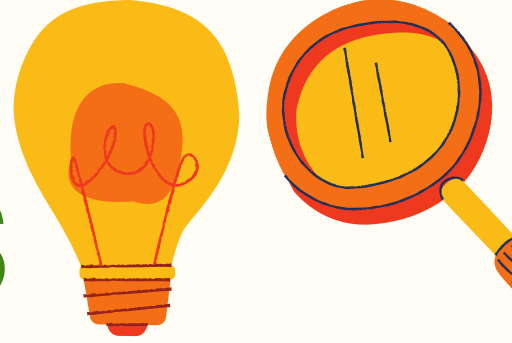

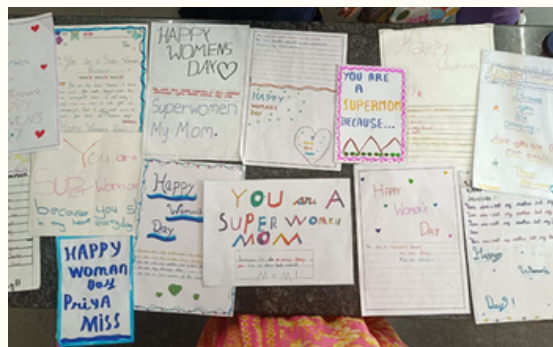
It was a colourful and enriching experience that fostered appreciation for our nation's diversity and heritage.

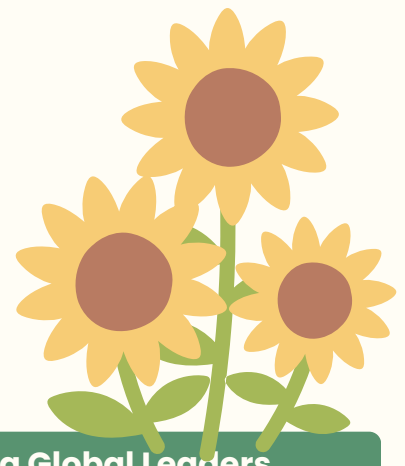
What we learnt

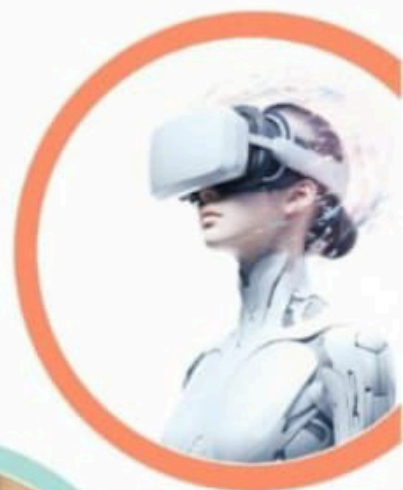
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
