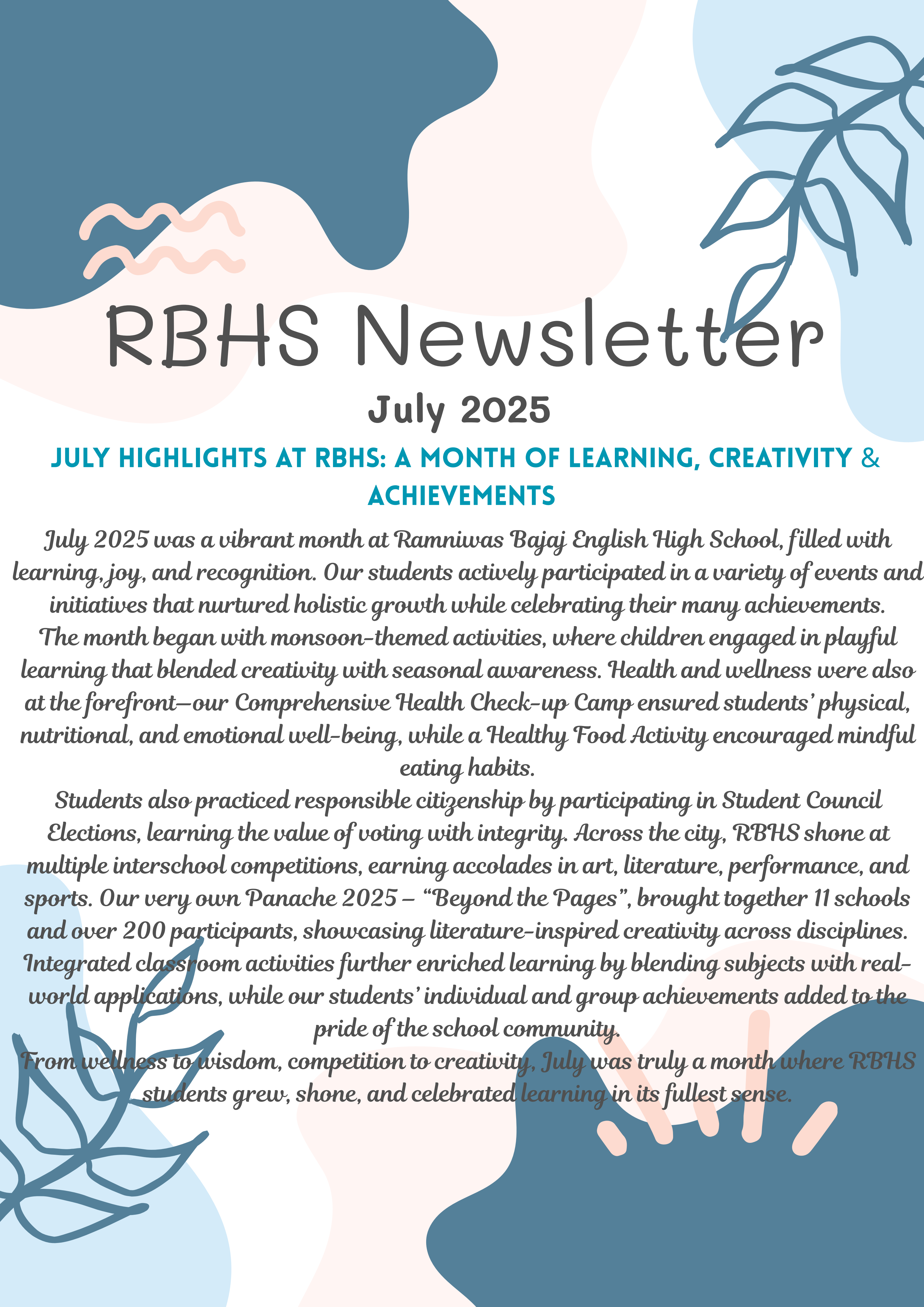

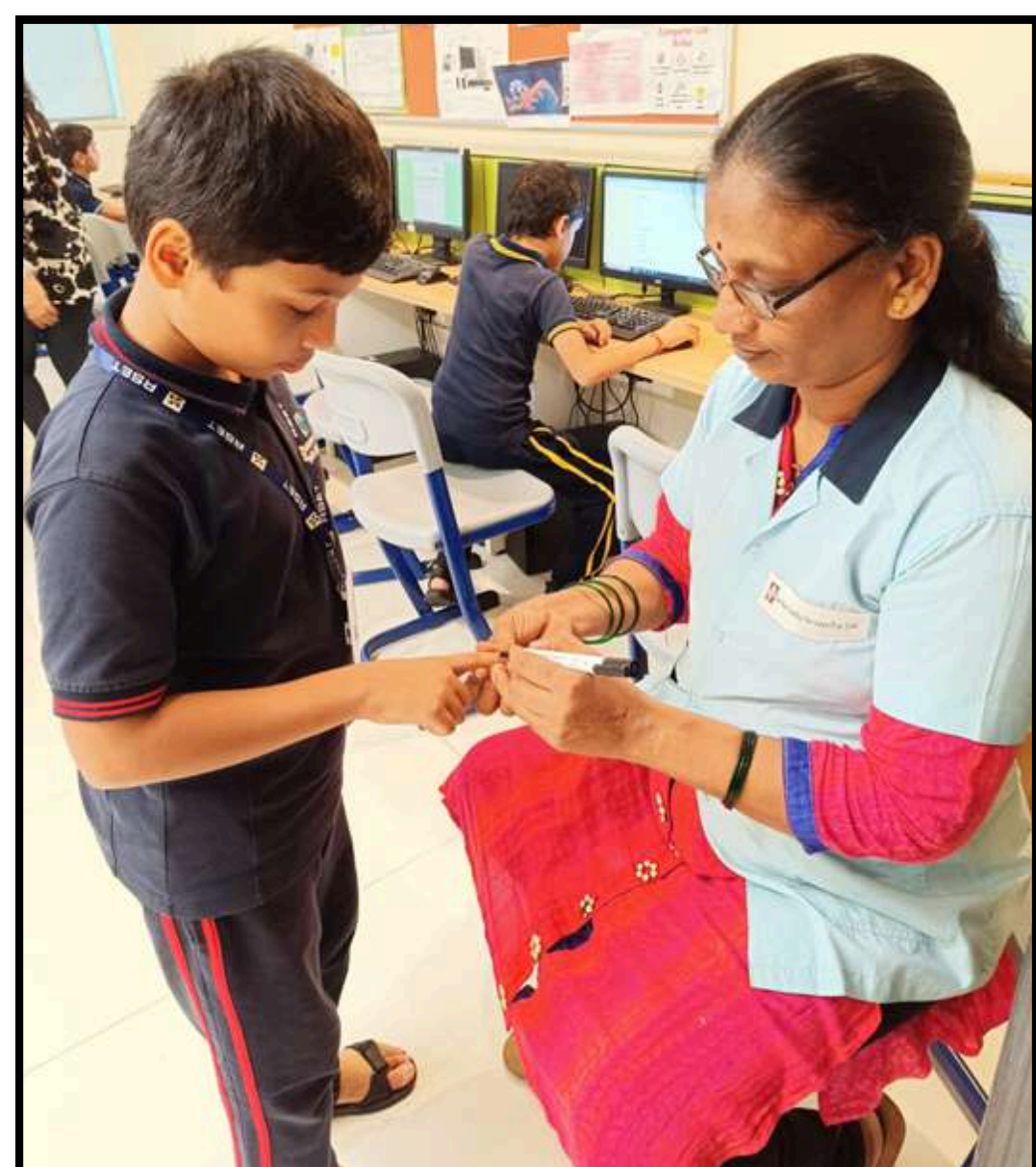
MONSOON FOOD FIESTA: A SPLASH OF FLAVOUR & FUN!

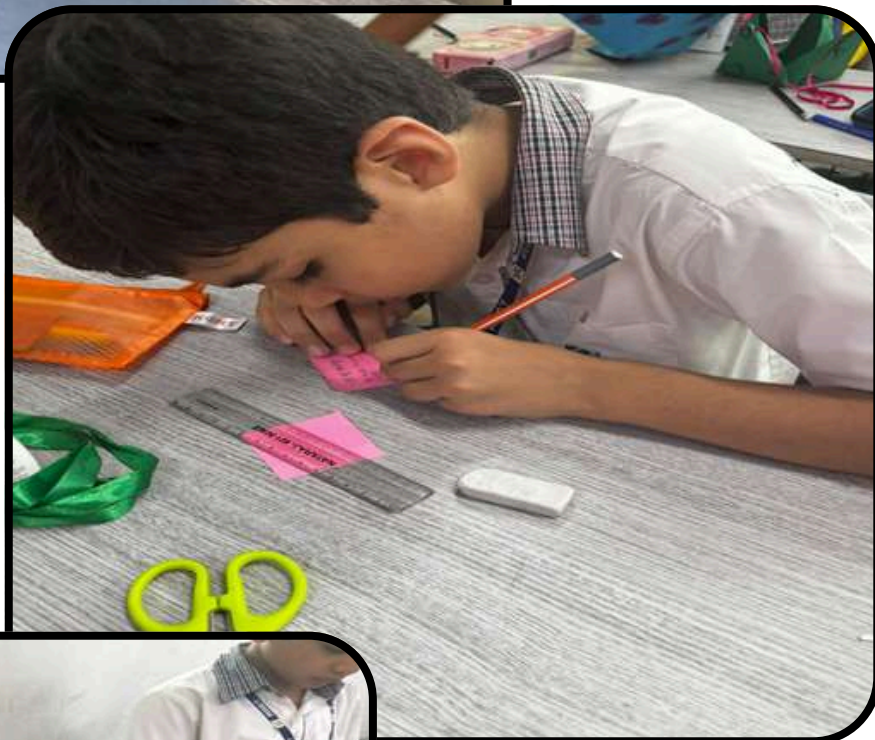
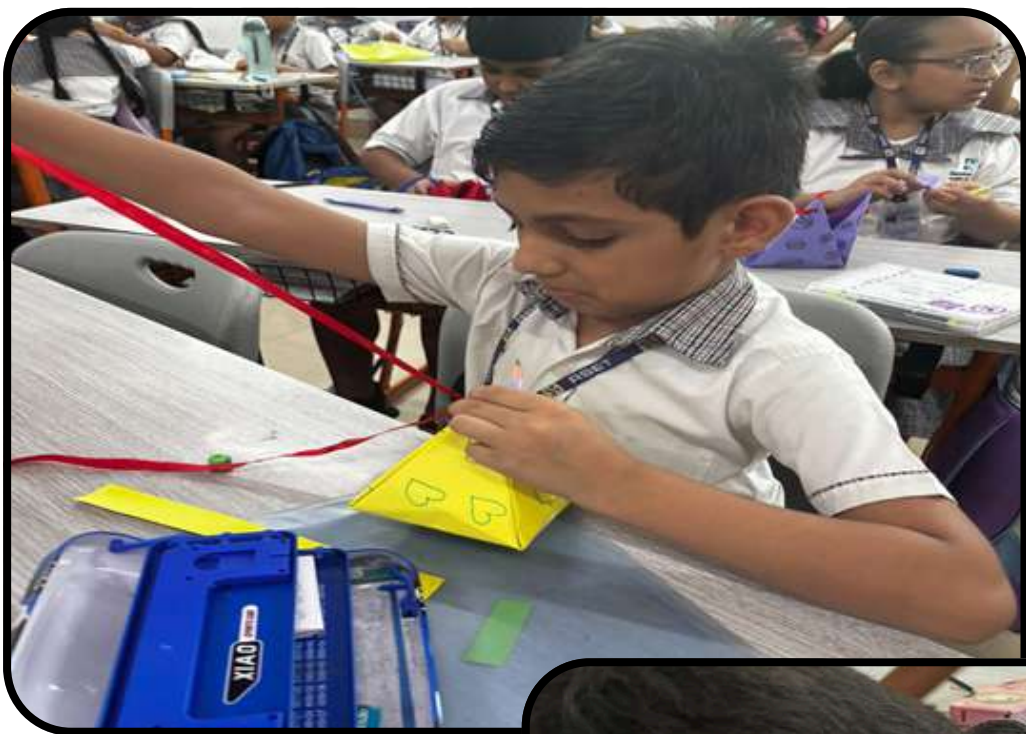


INSPIRING NUMBERS, INSPIRING STORIES

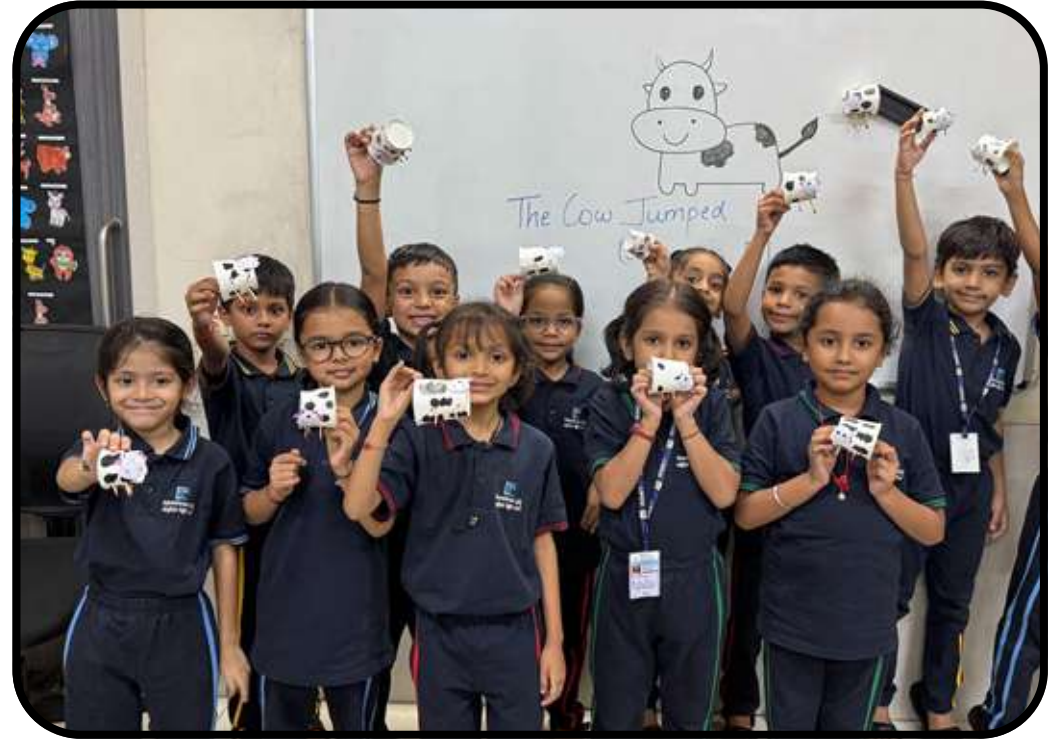
CREATIVITY WITH A CAUSE: NOBEL CARD MAKING COMPETITION
